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# London: dazzling display rings in the New Year

**FIREWORKS** lit up the capital's skyline this week as the New Year was greeted with a stunning display at the iconic London Eye.

An estimated 50,000 revellers watched the 11 minute display where 12,000 individual fireworks were set off to a musical medley soundtrack.

Organisers spent £1.8 million on the display which saw flavoured confetti and scented bubbles descend on the thousands of people in attendance.

The New Year's celebrations were described as "the world's first multi-sensory fireworks display".

London Mayor Boris Johnson said: "There is no better way to celebrate the highs of 2013 and the start of an exciting new year than by seeing one of the world's most dazzling

firework displays, now augmented in more ways than one.

"Watched by millions around the world, and hundreds of thousands of people from the banks of the Thames, it highlights our capital's fantastic community spirit and its premier position on the global stage."

In Scotland around 80,000 people attended Edinburgh's famous Hogmanay street party.

Pop legends The Pet Shop Boys performed live while 20 tons of fireworks were set off from Edinburgh Castle.

Simultaneous fireworks displays took place in the Scottish capital, Inverness and Stirling to mark the start

of 2014.

The British celebrations come after people across the globe celebrated the beginning of the New Year.

The island of Kiribati in the Pacific Ocean was the first country to celebrate the new year, closely followed by Australia and New Zealand.

The Australia display saw fireworks set off from the Sydney Opera House while Dubai tried to break the world record for the biggest fireworks

display ever.

Around 500,000 fireworks were launched from 400 locations during an extravagant six minute display.

## New Year bingers get sloshed and soaked

NEW YEAR was welcomed in Britain in traditional fashion in many cities – with throngs of young people binge-drinking, stretching emergency services to the limit as many celebrations spiralled out of control.

Paramedics reported taking emergency calls at the rate of one every six seconds as they battled to cope with booze-related incidents.

With an estimated 250,000 people on the capital's streets for the fireworks spectacular, London's ambulance service received 2,588 calls between midnight and 5am – almost four times the usual number.

At its peak – between 1am and 3am – calls were coming in at more than 600 an hour.

Spokeswoman Katy Millard said: "It's the busiest night of the year for us and unfortunately not everyone was using us wisely.

"Many of our medics were tied up helping people with drink-related illnesses and injuries, preventing them from responding to other patients."

Medical crews, aided by St John Ambulance volunteers, cared for 438 patients at more than a dozen treatment sites in central London. They

sent 88 injured people to hospital.

Scotland Yard, which had 3,800 officers on duty for the fireworks alone, made 100 arrests – 39 for being drunk and disorderly and 21 for assault, with others held for drugs offences, affray, sexual offences, theft and carrying weapons.

West Yorkshire Police described New Year's Eve as 'one of the busiest in recent times' with more than 1,500 calls in just five hours

Chief Inspector Robyn Williams said: "Visitors were not put off by the threat of wind and rain and the viewing areas filled up quicker than ever before.

"Officers worked hard, alongside stewards, to keep people safe during the event and ensure that everyone who came into central London was able to make their way home at the end of the night."

Devon and Cornwall Police made nearly 120 arrests on New Year's Eve including a drunk driver who crashed into a patrol car.

In the North-west, the ambulance service dealt with a call every seven seconds early on New Year's Day. In one incident, paramedics were attacked.

## House prices surge in 2013 - with Manchester leading the increase

THE WEATHER may have been terrible in Britain in 2013, but it was sunny days for homeowners as the nation's house prices charged upwards, with Manchester leading the way.

Values surged by 8.4 per cent over 2013 across the UK as the market revival became increasingly broad-based, Nationwide has reported.

Prices rose by 1.4 per cent month-on-month in December to reach £175,826 on average, although they remain around 5 per cent below all-time highs recorded in late 2007, the building society said.

The annual increase in prices across the country is the biggest jump seen since June 2010. Every region across the UK saw prices increase year-on-year, ranging from a 14.9 per cent annual increase in London to a 1.9 per cent uplift in the North.

Among the major towns and cities, Manchester was named by the study as the best-performing area for house price rises in 2013, with prices there up by 21 per cent typically over the last year to reach £209,627 typically.

Carlisle was named as

the worst performer, with a 1 per cent annual increase in prices taking the average value of a home there to £136,128.

Prices in London are now 14 per cent above their annual peak, with the price of the typical home in the English capital having reached £345,186.

House prices in Northern Ireland are still around half their 2007 levels, although they have climbed by 7.0 per cent year-on-year to reach £111,612 on average. London has the most expensive house prices in the UK while Northern Ireland has the cheapest, according to Nationwide's figures.

Scotland recorded a 3.7 per cent annual increase

in house prices, pushing them to £136,729 typically, while Wales saw prices pick up by 6.1 per cent over the same period, taking the average price there to £139,722.

In England, prices have increased by 8.6 per cent year-on-year to £205,084 typically.

And on Thursday Prime Minister David Cameron dismissed fears that the Government is pumping up a housing bubble as he hailed the success of its flagship Help to Buy scheme. A new phase of Help to Buy was launched in October to offer state-backed mortgages to credit-worthy people struggling to get onto the property ladder or move

up it because they only have a small deposit saved up.

The Prime Minister branded sceptics of the mortgage guarantees – such as Liberal Democrat business secretary Vince Cable – "London-centric".

In many parts of the country prices were "barely moving at all", he insisted.

More than 6,000 people have put offers in on homes and applied for mortgages using Help to Buy since it was launched about three months ago.

Nearly 750 homeowners have completed their purchases and hundreds were able to spend Christmas in their new homes, according to the Government.



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# New Year brings killer storms, floods and gales

■ and there's more on the way, forecasters warn

**THE NEW YEAR** has started much the same as the old for storm-battered Britons, who continue to brave floods, gales force winds and torrential rain.

And there's more to come, Environment Secretary Owen Paterson has warned, telling the nation to expect a period of "exceptional weather" bringing rain, wind and high tides.

The Environment Agency issued several severe flood warnings on Friday - indicating a danger to life - for south-west England, Gloucestershire and Wales.

Tidal flooding was expected in "numerous locations" on Friday due to large waves, high tides and strong winds.

Mr Paterson said ministers were working to ensure all agencies were prepared.

## flood warnings

He was speaking after chairing a meeting of the Cobra emergency committee, in which the UK's flood response was discussed.

Dozens of flood warnings are in place in England, Wales and Scotland.

The Met Office has issued yellow weather warnings - the lowest of its three levels - for rain and high winds on Friday in Northern Ireland and western parts of Scotland, Wales and England.

Further warnings have also been issued for Sunday.

The Police Service of Northern Ireland has said there is potential for flooding in a number of areas across the country, including Belfast, as a result of a tidal surge expected at midday on Friday, after the British Weekly went to press.

And Devon and Cornwall Police and the Isles of Scilly Council have declared a major incident as waves of more than 30ft were predicted to hit the coasts in those areas.

## high tides

Cornwall's emergency management centre will be opened in Truro to co-ordinate the response in the county.

Many of the severe flood warnings relate to the north and south coasts of Cornwall and Devon, with the highest risk of flooding expected for two to four hours either side of Friday morning's high tides.

In Wales, the Environment Agency issued a severe flood warning for area of Barmouth on the west coast, saying widespread flooding of properties was likely and that stones and other debris in the waves could seriously injure people.

The agency also issued severe warnings for Greenfield to Bagillt and the Point of Ayr in north Wales and the Usk Estuary at Crindau in the south.

Three severe warnings are also in place around the River Severn downstream from

Gloucester.

The agency's head of strategy, Pete Fox, said the expected flooding was due to "a combination of strong winds, large waves and high tides, from the early hours of Friday and into the weekend".

"Coastal paths and promenades could be highly dangerous as there is an increased risk of being swept out to sea. People are warned to stay away from the shoreline," he said.

Geoff Matthews, from HM Coastguard, said people should avoid visiting coastal areas.

"Even a relatively small wave has the power to knock a large man off his feet and take them out to sea in the undertow," he said.

## power cuts

The motoring organisation said it had been to 1,500 call-outs from stranded drivers since 23 December.

Darron Burness, head of the AA's flood rescue team, said: "Our patrols have seen it all in that time - including people ignoring road closure signs, blindly following their sat nav or other drivers into deep water, and 4x4 drivers naively thinking their car has amphibious qualities."

Flooding disrupted a number of train services on Thursday.

Thousands of homes have suffered power cuts due to the recent storms, with some cut off for several days, while numerous properties

have been flooded.

In other developments a caravan park in the Kent village of Yalding, which David Cameron visited during floods last week, has been evacuated due to more flooding, and the Thames Barrier in London has

been closed to protect people and property along the river, the Environment Agency announced.

The bad weather led to power cuts for 319 properties in Surrey and Hampshire, energy supplier SSE said.

In Porthleven, Cornwall, a search for a 27-year-old man washed out to sea has been called off after a body was found on the beach. And a woman was confirmed drowned in heavy seas near Croyde, north Devon, on Tuesday.

She was praised for her deft characterizations of alienated people and her sensitivity to the nuances of family relationships.

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

# Lady Thatcher voted 'most successful' PM since the war

She was known for being a divisive figure when she was in power, and her death last year provoked as much sadness as it did celebration, but amongst MPs Margaret Thatcher's popularity is a little clearer.

The woman known as the "Iron Lady" has been voted by politicians of all parties as the most successful prime minister since the Second World War – scoring particularly highly for her decisiveness.

Conservative Thatcher just managed to pip Labour's Clement Attlee – one of the driving forces behind the creation of the NHS – into second place in the poll, which spoke to 158 MPs, and was conducted by politics and international relations undergraduates at Royal Holloway University in London.

**bad news for Brown**

The survey covered prime ministers from Clement Attlee to

Gordon Brown, with most MPs citing decisiveness as a more important characteristic in a leader than intelligence, principles, energy, ruthlessness or honesty.

Respondents were asked to score past PMs on a 10-point scale across 12 traits. Thatcher had an average score of 7.4, a single percentage point more than Attlee on 7.3, and ahead of Tony Blair (6.8) and Winston Churchill, judged for his postwar stint in the job, on 6.5.

It was bad news for Gordon Brown, however, who was judged to be the worst of Britain's 13 modern leaders, scoring just 3.3.

Dr Nicholas Allen, Royal Holloway's senior lecturer in politics, who oversaw the survey, said that "Thatcher has a unique place in the minds of British MPs".

"As well as being judged the most successful prime minister, she also elicited

the widest range of responses. In death as in life the Iron Lady remains a divisive figure, idolised by some, condemned by others."

Unsurprisingly, it was part affiliation that was the strongest predictor of perceived success, though Edward Heath bucked this trend. The man who took Britain into Europe was rated more highly by Labour and Liberal Democrat MPs than Conservatives.

"It's not surprising that MPs perceive Thatcher, Attlee and Blair to be the most successful prime ministers. Attlee and Thatcher both presided over fundamental shifts in British politics, while Blair, like Thatcher, was a proven election winner. When it comes to winning big majorities, David Cameron still has much to prove," added Dr Allen.



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# New papers prove Scargill was right over mine 'hit list'

Newly released cabinet papers from 1984 reveal mineworkers' union leader Arthur Scargill may have been right to claim there was a "secret hit-list" of more than 70

pits marked for closure.

The government and National Coal Board said at the time they wanted to close 20. But the documents reveal a plan to shut 75 mines over

three years.

And the previously confidential files released on Friday by the National Archives also show the effect of the Brighton

bomb on Mrs Thatcher's thinking about Ireland.

The year-long miners' strike, which started in March 1984, was characterized by often violent confrontations between police and massed picketing miners. At one stage the government hoped it might catch red-handed someone from the National Union of Mineworkers (NUM) trying to smuggle a suitcase full of banknotes into Britain.

The union's assets had been seized after the NUM refused to pay fines. But the government thought miners might get financial support from Moscow or eastern Europe, and was trying to prevent the funds getting through.

Cabinet Secretary Sir Robert Armstrong wrote: "If a representative of the NUM could be detected entering this country with a suitcase full of banknotes, it might be possible for him to be stopped and searched at customs."

"Those concerned" (by which he presumably meant Special Branch and MI5) were "exercising vigilance" and on the look-out for anyone from the union going abroad "for the purpose of collecting consignments of notes".

This was, he admitted, something of a long shot, "but is the best we can do".

The document, marked "Not to be photocopied or circulated outside the private office", records a meeting attended by just seven people, including the prime minister, chancellor, energy secretary and employment secretary, at No 10.

# 'We're here to work, not for a handout...'

- First Romanians arrive in Britain after changes to EU migrant rules
- New arrivals welcomed at Gatwick by Labour MP Keith Vaz

One of the first Romanians to fly into Britain as restrictions on the UK labour market were lifted on New Year's Day was met off the plane by MP Keith Vaz and told him he is here to work not 'rob your country'.

Victor Spiresau landed at Luton Airport Wednesday morning and is set to start at a London car wash so he can send the cash he earns back to his family in a Transylvanian village.

Waiting for the 30-year-old in arrivals was the Leicester East MP, who asked him to stop for a cup of coffee after landing from Tirgu Mures in central Romania at 7.30am this morning.

After being asked why he was here, Mr Spiresau said: 'I don't come to rob your country. I come to work and then go home.

Here you pay a lot, in Romania it's very cheap'.

The 30-year-old, who said he earned 10 euros a day working in construction at home, said he hoped to make 10 euros an hour here.

'I don't want to stay here. I want to renovate my home and to make a good life in Romania because it's much easier to live in Romania because it's not expensive,' he added.

Mr Spiresau, who has left his wife at home in their small village, added: 'She hopes to see me with a lot of money.'

Also on the flight into Luton was 35-year-old Adrian Pop who said he was an emergency doctor back in Romania who had come to the UK to work in a hospital near London.

Dressed smartly in an overcoat, shirt and tie he

said his plan was to remain here for at least six months.

'I chose the UK because of the language. English is a much easier language.'

He said 'I don't know if I will be staying here permanently. My wife and five month old daughter are back in Romania.'

Twenty-year-old Benjamin Alexander said: 'I want to build a new life here. It's a new year and I have a new start. Here I can have a better life.'

Among those arriving looking for work was Nadia Geozgivea, 20, from Sofia.

She said: 'This is my first time here. I have come over to be with my boyfriend. He lives here. He is from Pakistan. I want to get a job as a

cleaner.'

Students Maya Betranova, 19, and Evelynna Georgivea, 19, both from Sofia, have been studying IT at South Bank University in London for a year.

They now plan to get part-time jobs to help pay for their course.

Maya said: 'It is good now because we can get part-time jobs to help pay for our studies.

'It would be nice to get a full time job here when I finish my studies.

She added: 'I like England. The food is terrible and I'm not so happy about the weather, but even that is ok. The people are nice to us.

Evelynna said: 'It is good that we work, we should be able to.

'But we shouldn't come here for your benefits, we don't need them.'

Rory then shared the same picture and added: 'Happy New Year everyone! I have a feeling it's going to be a great year!! My first victory of 2014 #shesaidyes!!'

The news will surprise sports fans after witnessing the pair's on-again/off-again relationship play out in public.

Sources close to the pair claimed the Irish golfer, 24, broke it off with the Danish tennis pro in April - days after she posted a mean picture of Twitter showing him asleep and open-mouthed with his glasses on.

## Cambridge don fights for life after being gored by Highlands stag

- She was on holiday in Highland when stag charged at her
- A local gamekeeper described the incident as 'one in a million'

A Cambridge academic is seriously ill in hospital after a giant stag charged out of the darkness and gored her through the neck.

Kate Stone was on holiday in the Scottish Highlands when the beast charged into her in a 'one-in-a-million' accident.

Friends watched in horror as the spooked red deer lowered its head and impaled her on its antlers before shaking itself free.

The antlers pierced Dr Stone's throat and she had to be airlifted to a Glasgow hospital for emergency treatment for neck and spinal injuries.

On Friday doctors said the scientist was in a 'serious but stable' condition.

Dr Stone, 44, and a

group of friends were on a three-day festive break and had been at a ceilidh on Sunday evening before being invited back to local musician Jim Hunter's home at Lochailort, near Fort William.

The group were laughing and chatting, said Mr Hunter. 'We had been to the pub up the road and were coming back to my house through the gate.

### 'straight through us'

'It was pitch black and we were using torches to navigate our way back and the big stag must have got trapped in the garden as we have deer fences around it.

'It must have panicked when it saw us and the only way out was through the gate that we

were standing at. It just ran at us and went straight through us.

'Kate was at the back of the group and its antlers must have caught her in the neck. The stag then made for the hills. It was a completely freakish accident, I've never seen the like of it before.

'I think I know the one it is, it's been hanging around. It's a three-year-old stag, around 150kg (330lbs). These are big fellas, you don't mess with them, they'll take your car out.'

The group initially thought Dr Stone had simply been knocked over but quickly realised that it was more serious.

### hill walking

She was rushed to hospital in Fort William but then flown by air ambulance for specialist treatment at Glasgow's Southern General Hospital, where she is understood to be in

intensive care.

Dr Stone, who was born a man and has two children but changed gender in 2007, is a research engineer in the Institute of Manufacturing at Cambridge and has set up her own technology company, Novalia.

She was part of a group of three men and four women visiting the area – hill walking and enjoying the scenery – and staying at the Mo-Dhachaidh Guest House.

Owner Gary Burton, 51, said: 'No one here has heard of anything like this in their lifetime, it has shocked the

community.

'It's a cornered stag with no alternative exit route, it would have just been in a panic. It had nowhere else to go but through the group and unfortunately it seems Kate was in the way.

### 'highly unusual'

'The force of the attack and impact must have been ferocious. I went to the scene later and found Kate's mobile phone smashed into tiny bits.

'I understand the type of injury Kate has suffered can cause quadriplegia or paraplegia.

She was telling me she enjoyed the outdoors in

the hills and camping on her own in remote places, so any form of paralysis to such an active person will be a disaster.'

One local gamekeeper with more than 40 years of experience with Highland stags said he had never heard of such an incident.

He added: 'For a stag to come out of the darkness like this and go for someone is highly unusual – a chance in a million.'

In November, a deer farmer died after being attacked by a stag. Kenneth Price, 75, was gored in Llandysul, Wales.

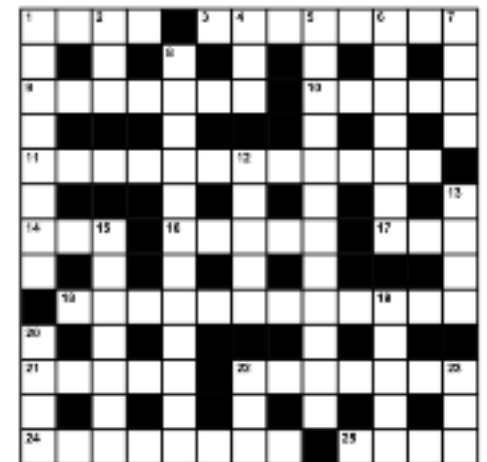

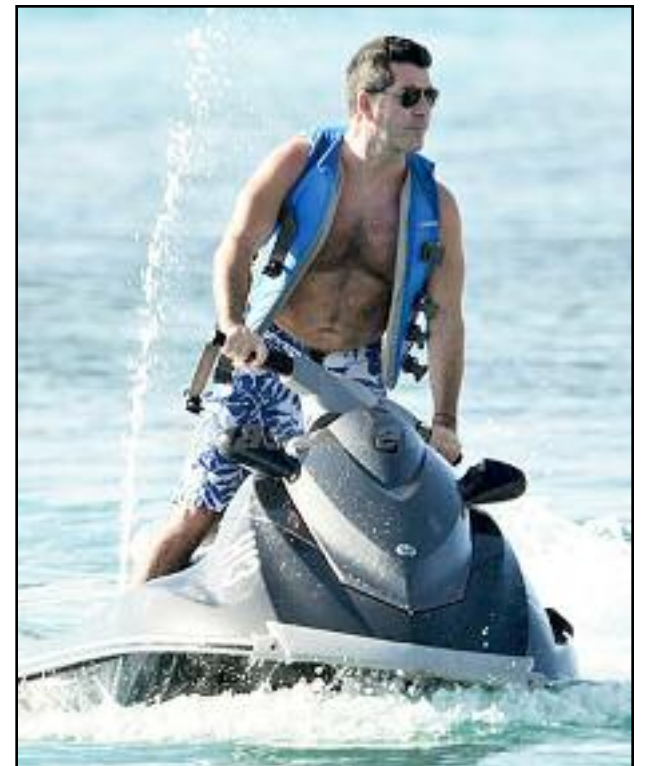

### Rules of the Land

Every January there is also a new set of rules that come out in California, So I thought it might be good to let you know about a few:

**Transgender rights:** Students will be allowed to participate in school sports and use the bathrooms consistent with their gender identity, regardless of what is listed on their birth certificate. However, the law could be suspended next week if a group called Privacy for All Students has enough signatures validated to put the issue

on the November ballot.

**Gun control:** Eleven new gun-control laws were signed into law in 2013, including a ban on the manufacturing or sale of large-capacity magazine conversion kits. Possession of large-capacity magazines will be banned under that law beginning July 1.

**Domestic workers:** Nannies and caregivers will receive overtime pay for working more than nine hours a day or 45 hours a week under a law billed as the Domestic Workers Bill of Rights.

**Minimum wage:** Minimum-wage workers will see their hourly pay rise from \$8 to \$9 beginning July 1, with another \$1-per-hour increase in 2016.

**Abortion access:** Nurse practitioners, certified nurse midwives and physician assistants will be allowed to perform first trimester abortions under a bill to expand access for women seeking the procedure.

**Juvenile offenders:** Minors prosecuted and convicted as adults for serious crimes will be given a second chance at freedom under a new parole hearing process that allows their cases to be reviewed after serving at least 15 years of their prison sentence.

**Past crimes:** State and local governments will no longer ask job applicants on initial applications about past criminal convictions until determining whether the person meets minimum qualifications. The law takes effect July 1 and exempts some agencies, such as law enforcement.

**Undocumented drivers:** The Department of Motor Vehicles is drafting new regulations and preparing to process applications from undocumented immigrants eligible to drive on California roadways sometime on

Liverpool manager Brendan Rodgers has been charged over post-match comments he made following his side's defeat at Manchester City on 26 December.

Rodgers criticised the "horrendous" performance of the match officials and questioned the appointment of Bolton referee Lee Mason after the 2-1 loss.

He said: "Hopefully we won't have a Greater Manchester referee with Liverpool-Manchester games in future."

Rodgers has until 1800 GMT on 8 January 2014 to respond to the charge.

The Football Association said: "It is alleged the comments by Rodgers called into question the integrity of the match referee, and/or implied that the match referee was motivated by bias; and/or brought the game into disrepute; and/or amounted to a failure to act in the best interests of the game."

Rodgers was particularly infuriated by a decision against Raheem Sterling, who put the ball in the net after being incorrectly flagged offside when the game was still goalless.

The Northern Irishman also claimed Luis Suarez had his shirt pulled by Manchester City defender Joleon Lescott inside the home penalty area in the late stages.

"An official insulting any player, no matter his intentions, is clearly not acceptable behaviour," spokesman Jordan Sibley said.

"For this reason, we do not accept the verdict in relation to this case and do not consider the matter to be over.

"Under the circumstances, we do not feel it appropriate for Mr Clattenburg to officiate in

any of our matches until this matter is properly resolved."

Southampton believe Lallana was subjected to a "personal insult" in the game on 29 December after Clattenburg waved away two appeals for a late penalty, with one incident involving the England midfielder.

The Professional Game Match Officials Ltd (PGMOL), said in a statement that Clattenburg had no case to answer.

## Ashes: Haddin torments England one last time...

BRAD HADDIN was again England's tormentor-in-chief on Friday, prompting England all-rounder Ben Stokes to admit his team were at a loss as to how to stop Australia wicketkeeper.

Haddin scored 75 off 90 balls as his side recovered from 97-5 to post 326 on the first day of the fifth Test to dash English hopes after yet another promising start from Alistair Cook's bowlers.

England, who trail 4-0 in the series, were 8-1 at stumps in Sydney.

"When he came in and started hitting it back over your head, you stand there scratching your head, thinking, 'this isn't meant to happen'," said Stokes.

"He's taken every chance to get runs."

Stokes, who took a Test-best 6-99, added: "It's just the way he comes out and plays his natural game straight away, whatever the situation is.

"We started really well. Then Haddin and Smith counter-attacked and I think they probably ended up getting about 50 or 60 too many, more than we'd have liked."

Haddin has scored at least a half-century in all five Ashes Tests - the first player to achieve the feat in an Ashes series since

Australia's Keith Stackpole in 1972.

His counter-attacking innings have been a feature of the series and Friday in Sydney was no different as he carried the fight to England's bowlers.

He added 128 for the sixth wicket with Steve Smith, who went on to score 115.

"Brad was great to bat with," said Smith. "I sort of just took a back seat and just watched him go and the way he played his shots today was brilliant."

"In tough circumstances, he just comes in and tries to switch the momentum of the game - and he's done it on numerous occasions this series. He's played beautifully."

England's situation was not helped by the fact Boyd Rankin, one of three debutants along with Gary Ballance and Scott Borthwick, twice limped out of the attack after feeling his left hamstring.

Rankin was sent for a scan, which revealed little, and according to Stokes was suffering from nothing more than cramp.

"He's fine," said Stokes. "It was just a bit of cramp, which is pretty normal in Australian heat - so I think he'll be good to go in the next bowling innings."

As the British Weekly went to press England were teetering at 67-6 after another first innings batting collapse.

# Arsene Wenger rules out move for Yohan Cabaye

Arsene Wenger says he will not make another move for Newcastle's Yohan Cabaye because he has enough midfielders at Arsenal.

Cabaye, 27, (above) was the subject of a £10m summer bid from Arsenal, and Newcastle have said he is not for sale.

Gunners manager Wenger said: "On Yohan Cabaye, we don't look for a midfielder. "We didn't have Mesut Ozil or Aaron Ramsey and we still had three good midfielders and Mikel Arteta on the bench [for the 1-0 win at Newcastle]."

Ramsey has a thigh injury while Ozil missed Sunday's victory at St James' Park with a shoulder problem that could rule him out of the New Year's Day game against Cardiff.

Arsenal's win, thanks to an Olivier Giroud goal, took them past Manchester City to top the Premier League at the New Year, the first time they have done so since the 2007-08 season.

Arsenal have earned the most points in the Premier League in 2013, chalking up 82

And after ending a run of three games without a win by beating West Ham at Upton Park on Boxing Day, Wenger said his side were showing the required

character to mount a title challenge.

The French manager told reporters: "We played two away games and got six points against West Ham and Newcastle and as you can see the team is ready for a fight. So it's a good base. Let's keep fighting and keep trying to develop the team."

Arsenal had to battle for the win at St James' Park with Newcastle hitting the bar in the first half and almost scoring late on when Wojciech Szczesny's clearance cannoned off Loic Remy and trickled wide of the goal.

But in a sometimes bruising encounter, Giroud scored his 11th goal of the season to end a run of 499 minutes without scoring in the Premier League.

And Wenger praised the balance that the striker brings to an Arsenal team chasing a first Premier League trophy in 10 seasons.

"He gives us a good structure up front as we are a short team," he said.

"We believe in ourselves and we are determined to give our best absolutely and to turn back on this season at the end and think we have given our best. I hope it will be enough but it's a long way to go."

# Adebayor 'unstoppable', says Sherwood

Tim Sherwood expects Emmanuel Adebayor to play a key role for the rest of the season after he kept up his impressive form in the win at Manchester United on New Year's Day.

Striker Adebayor, 29, made it four goals in five games with the opener in the 2-1 triumph at Old Trafford after being exiled under Andre Villas-Boas.

"When he performs as he is at the moment he's almost unstoppable," said 44-year-old Spurs boss Sherwood.

"I have no reason to believe he will not keep it going."

United began the brighter but went behind towards the end of the first half after Adebayor rose expertly to guide in a header.

The Togo international was then taken off on a stretcher in the aftermath of Christian Eriksen's close-range header for Spurs' second, which proved vital as they held off a late surge from the home side after Danny Welbeck's smart finish.

### 'small squad'

United manager David Moyes was left fuming after the game at a number of decisions from the referee and Sherwood admitted the hosts could well have had a penalty, but the Spurs manager now has to deal with another addition to his injury list.

"At the moment he [Emmanuel Adebayor] has ice on every part of his body so we can't tell what's wrong with him," Sherwood said.

"He just runs all day long, he tries hard for the team, but it's hard to single anyone out. We've got nine players injured so we're having to go at it with a very

small squad at the moment."

### replacement

Adebayor trained on his own under Villas-Boas, and has also subsequently accused the club of disrespecting him when he was not included in their official photograph this summer.

However, he has

featured prominently since the Portuguese was sacked a fortnight ago and Sherwood was named as his replacement.

Adebayor's form contrasts starkly with the return of his fellow Tottenham front men.

Summer signing Roberto Soldado has scored five goals in 18 Premier League games

but only one of those has been struck in open play, while Jermain Defoe is yet to register in the top flight this season in 12 appearances.

### 'long-term contracts'

Sherwood insisted he had "heard nothing" about reports linking Defoe with a move to play in Major League Soccer in North America, and the boss added he hoped to use younger players rather than buy new ones in the January transfer window to supplement his injury-affected squad.

"When we have got everyone fit, we don't need any players," he said. "You have to give these guys long-term contracts, so unless it was someone who was going to make the squad better, I'd rather go with the kids."

The win against United moved Tottenham into sixth place in the table. They next play north London rivals Arsenal in an FA Cup third-round tie on Saturday.

# Solskjaer into Cardiff hot seat

**Ole Gunnar Solskjaer has been appointed Cardiff City's new manager.**

The 40-year-old former Manchester United striker has agreed a 12-month rolling contract with the Bluebirds.

Solskjaer, who met his new squad at the club's training ground on Thursday, joins from Molde, whom he led to two Norwegian league titles and a cup win.

"It is a fantastic challenge. Cardiff are ready to take the next step up. I hope I can help them," said Solskjaer, who replaces the sacked Malky Mackay.

"I've always dreamt of being a manager in the Premier League and I'm delighted to get the opportunity.

"I am really looking forward to convincing the Cardiff fans that I am the right man to take them forward.

"I will try to convince the fans with my hard work, loyalty and my brand of football. I'm a very positive manager."

Cardiff, who were beaten 2-0 by Premier League leaders Arsenal on Wednesday, are 17th in the table and only one point clear of the relegation zone.

Solskjaer's first game in charge will be against Newcastle in the third round of the FA Cup on Saturday.

The Norwegian will be given significant funds by owner Vincent Tan to spend on new signings in the current transfer window.

He dismissed speculation that he would find it difficult working for an owner who reportedly meddled in team affairs during Mackay's reign.

Solskjaer added: "He wants the club to be

successful. I had a good meeting with him. Communication and dialogue will be key.

"Everything isn't exactly what it seems from the outside."

The Norwegian will return to Old Trafford on 28 January with his new club 10 days after playing Manchester City at Etihad Stadium.

"We've got some of the toughest trips in world football coming up this month. They're games we'll relish and look forward to."

He rejected reports his former boss at Manchester United, Sir Alex Ferguson, had told him to turn down the chance to become Cardiff's third manager in 32 months.

"That is absolute nonsense," said Solskjaer. "He has wished me the best and given me some good advice as he always does. I had a good conversation with him."

Cardiff chairman Mehmet Dalman insisted the Norwegian was the club's only target.

He said: "There was only one name in my head from the very beginning. We're delighted to welcome Ole.

"I've seen Ole play for many, many years. I like his style of football and his ideas on the game."

Former Manchester United and Sheffield United midfielder Mark Dempsey will work as his assistant - just as he did at Molde.

Solskjaer, who scored the winner in the Champions League final against Bayern Munich in 1999, made 366 appearances for Manchester United and scored 126 goals.

He also won six Premier League titles and two FA Cups during 11 years at Old Trafford from 1996.



**BOND VILLAIN HIRES BABY FACED ASSASSIN?** when asked about his relationship with Cardiff owner Vincent Tan, Solskjaer told reporters: "Everything isn't exactly what it seems from the outside."

After ending his playing career in 2007, Solskjaer took charge of United's reserve team for two-and-a-half years before guiding Molde to their first Norwegian league title in 100 years in 2011.

He successfully led Molde's defence of their title as his managerial success attracted the attention of Premier League clubs.

Molde could only finish sixth behind champions Stromgodset this season, but they did beat Rosenborg in November to take the Norwegian Football Cup for the third time in their history.

Solskjaer held talks with Aston Villa owner Randy Lerner in May 2012 following the sacking of Alex McLeish, but the man who earned the nickname "the baby-faced assassin" opted to remain with Molde because he was reluctant to uproot his wife Silje and three children from Norway.
