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Tony Blackburn: BBC 'hung me out to dry'

■ Veteran DJ blasts Beeb after he is fired for role in Savile inquiry

Tony Blackburn has said the BBC "hung me out to dry" over the Jimmy Savile inquiry and he will sue the corporation where he worked for nearly 50 years.

Director general Tony Hall said the BBC had "parted company" with the Radio 2 DJ after he failed to fully co-operate with Dame Janet Smith's inquiry.

The veteran DJ said the report included an accusation he was among celebrities who "seduced" a 15-year-old girl.

Mr Blackburn, 73, denies the allegation and says he was cleared of wrongdoing.

One of Britain's best known DJs, his Saturday afternoon Radio 2 show Pick of the Pops attracted several million listeners every week. He was the first DJ to broadcast on Radio 1 when it launched in 1967.

In his latest statement, he accused the inquiry of being a "whitewash" and said he had been

"scapegoated for giving my honest account and best recollections of those events 45 years ago".

Dame Janet's report said it had rejected the evidence given by Mr Blackburn that he had not been questioned at the time about the allegation involving the teenage girl.

In an earlier statement, Mr Blackburn said the allegation made in 1971 was quickly withdrawn. The girl at the centre of the allegation took her own life later that year.

Mr Blackburn said that neither Dame Janet's report into Savile, nor the BBC, made any suggestion he was guilty of misconduct with the girl, nor did a coroner's inquest or a subsequent police inquiry.

After the publication of Dame Janet's report -

which looked into abuse by the late DJ Jimmy Savile and broadcaster Stuart Hall - Lord Hall said: "My interpretation is that Tony Blackburn fell short of the standards of evidence that such an inquiry demanded."

He said it was "one of the most important

inquiries in the BBC's history and that has put an even greater responsibility on everyone who took part in that inquiry to co-operate fully and to be open".

honestly and openly co-operated fully - and at great personal cost to themselves.

"As Dame Janet has said, she's rejected his evidence and she's explained very clearly why. I have to take that extremely seriously.

Speaking to the BBC News Channel, Dame Janet said both senior BBC executive Bill Cotton and a senior lawyer said they had had conversations with the DJ.

"[He] told me that no such conversation had taken place and this was not a lapse of memory on his part. They simply had not taken place and I rejected that evidence," she said.

Her report into DJ Jimmy Savile and broadcaster Stuart Hall had found the BBC repeatedly failed to stop the pair's "monstrous" abuse because of a "culture of fear".

'Black day'

Mr Blackburn referred to this conclusion in his own statement, saying: "Given Dame Janet Smith's concerns of a culture of fear in coming forward at the BBC, what whistle-blower at the BBC would ever come forward when they see the way they have hung me out to dry?"

"Sadly, today's news agenda should have been about the survivors of abuse carried out within the BBC but, by sacking

me, they have managed to take the focus off those who have suffered so much," he added.

"My lawyers are now considering all statements made by the BBC about me today and we will be taking action."

Fellow TV and radio broadcasters, including Piers Morgan and Eamonn Holmes, have been sending supportive tweets to the DJ throughout the day.

Broadcaster Nina Myskow told Jeremy Vine on BBC Radio 2: "It should be a black day for the BBC because of the revelations about the whole Savile episode, but in fact that's been buried very cleverly by the BBC as usual by sacking Tony Blackburn."

The son of a doctor from Guildford, Blackburn was the first DJ to broadcast on Radio 1 when it launched in September 1967.

He spent 17 years at the station and also presented Top of the Pops and was a weekly fixture on Noel's House Party. Prior to all that, he had broadcast on Radio Caroline South and then Radio London.

After Radio 1, he was one of the launch presenters on Capital Gold. He has also hosted Radio 2's Pick of the Pops as well as regular bank holiday specials for the stations.

He has also had shows on BBC London 94.9, BBC Radio Berkshire, the Magic network, BBC3CR and KMFM.

Tories in turmoil!

■ Cameron struggles to keep party together as two heavyweights come out in favor of Brexit
■ In/out vote set for June 23rd after PM secures 'special status' for UK in Europe

David Cameron's hopes of selling his EU 'special status' deal to his own party got off to a bad start this week when two Tory heavyweights, Boris Johnson and Michael Gove, declared they were throwing their support behind the 'Leave' campaign ahead of the June referendum.

London Mayor Johnson announced his decision in his newspaper column on Monday arguing that: "there is only one way to get the change we need, and that is to vote to go, because all EU history shows that they only really listen to a population when it says No. The fundamental problem remains: that they have an ideal that we do not share. They want to create a truly federal union, e pluribus unum, when most British people do not."

proxy fight

Johnson addressed the pros and cons of leaving the EU in characteristically robust fashion, ridiculing the claims that the UK will have less influence in the EU, adding: "Above all, we will be told that whatever the democratic deficiencies, we would be better off remaining in because

of the "influence" we have. This is less and less persuasive to me. Only 4 per cent of people running the Commission are UK nationals, when Britain contains 12 per cent of the EU population. It is not clear why the Commission should be best placed to know the needs of UK business and industry, rather than the myriad officials at UK Trade & Investment or the Department for Business, Innovation and Skills.

"If the "Leave" side wins, it will indeed be necessary to negotiate

a large number of trade deals at great speed. But why should that be impossible? We have become so used to Nanny in Brussels that we have become infantilised, incapable of imagining an independent future. We used to run the biggest empire the world has ever seen, and with a much smaller domestic population and a relatively tiny Civil Service. Are we really unable to do trade deals? We will have at least two years in which the existing treaties will be in force."

The prospect of a bruising heavyweight fight between Johnson and David Cameron had many commentators licking their lips and speculating that what was really happening was a proxy fight for control of the party.

what the papers said

"You can't accuse Downing Street "of complacency in this campaign", said James Forsyth in **The Spectator**. For David Cameron, this has been a career-defining moment. "How history will judge him" depends not only on whether he wins, but "whether he can put the Tory party back together again afterwards".

"It's not often you see a party of government splitting before your eyes," said John Rentoul in **The Independent on Sunday**. It happened in 2003, when 139 Labour MPs voted against Tony Blair over Iraq. Now it's happening with the Tories over Europe. I'd always thought all those Tory MPs who, like Cameron himself, had expressed impatience with the EU would, like him, vote to stay in when the chips were down. But it turns out many weren't like Cameron at all."



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BBC 'culture of fear' enabled Savile and Hall, says report

One last ride for the Flying Scotsman

One of the world's most iconic locomotives has completed its inaugural run after a decade-long, £4.2m refit.

The Flying Scotsman made the journey from London King's Cross to York on Thursday, where it will go on display at the National Railway Museum (NRM).

It arrived in York about 13.20 GMT, almost an hour later than expected, after it was twice held up by reports of trespassers.

The engine, which retired from service in 1963, has been restored for the NRM.

Former MP turned TV presenter Michael Portillo said: "This is certainly the most famous journey and most famous locomotive in Britain."

The first disruption happened at about 09:00 near St Neots when the train was brought to a standstill while British Transport Police cleared the lines after reports of around 60 people on the track. No arrests were made.

Network Rail said the number of people on the trackside had caused "safety concerns" and resulted in a number of services, including Flying Scotsman, having to slow down."

The train was halted a second time north of Doncaster following reports of trespassers on the track which were later found to be false.

Crowds gathered at King's Cross for its scheduled departure at 07:40 and thousands lined the route, while some of the 297 passengers paid up to £450 for a ticket to travel on the train.

Among the passengers was 83-year-old Ron Kennedy, from Leigh-on-Sea, in Essex, who drove Flying Scotsman from 1956 until it was retired in 1963.

He said "It's unbelievable. I never dreamt about being on it again. To be out with it is just fantastic."

The BBC repeatedly failed to stop "monstrous" abuse by DJ Jimmy Savile and broadcaster Stuart Hall because of a "culture of fear", a report said this week.

The Dame Janet Smith review identified 72 victims of Savile - including eight who were raped - and 21 victims of Hall, over four decades from the 1960s.

She said BBC culture "was deeply deferential" and staff were reluctant to speak to managers about complaints.

Director general Lord Hall said the BBC had failed to protect the victims.

The review found that senior managers were not told of complaints about Savile because of a culture of fear that still exists in the BBC.

However, a small number of BBC managers in Manchester had been aware of Hall's conduct, it said.

Hall, 86, who presented TV show It's a Knockout, was jailed in 2013 after admitting indecently assaulting 13 girls.

Dame Janet said Savile - who died in

2011 aged 84 without ever facing prosecution - and Hall were "serial sexual predators" and the BBC had missed five opportunities to stop their misconduct.

The report found that Savile would commit sexual assaults "whenever the opportunity arose" and incidents took place "in virtually every one of the BBC premises at which he worked".

His usual tactic with young girls - and in some cases boys - was to groom them by inviting them to watch him perform and then make a sexual approach on them in his dressing room, the report said.

'expensive whitewash'

It heard evidence from more than 700 people, including 117 witnesses from the BBC who said they had heard rumours about Savile.

They included two BBC managers who had confronted Savile over claims he took teenagers home from Top of the Pops - claims which Savile admitted, but said he was simply giving the girls a bed for the night

THE REPORT'S KEY FINDINGS:

The impartial investigation was set up by the BBC in 2012 to look at the corporation's culture and practices during the years it employed Savile - thought to be from 1964 to 2007. It found:

- The victims of Savile in connection with his work at the BBC include eight people who were raped and one instance of an attempted rape. Others faced sexual assaults
 - The majority of the cases took place in the 1970s
- The largest number of victims was in connection with Savile's work on Top of the Pops
 - The youngest victim of a sexual assault by Savile was eight years old
 - Eight informal complaints were made
 - Hall assaulted 21 females, the youngest aged 10, between 1967 and 1991
 - Two senior managers were "aware" or "probably aware" of Hall's sexual assaults on BBC premises

because they had no where to stay.

The review cost £6.5m and its report is 1,000 pages and three volumes long.

But Liz Dux, a specialist abuse lawyer who represents 168 of Savile's victims, said the report was "disappointing", and many victims would feel it was "nothing more than an expensive whitewash".

She said Dame Janet did not have the power to compel people to give evidence and her clients

"will always be left with that feeling - is everything known about? Do we know the full picture?"

Meanwhile, Lord Hall said DJ Tony Blackburn had "parted company" with the BBC after failing to fully co-operate with the inquiry.

Mr Blackburn, 73, denies the allegation and says he was cleared of wrongdoing. In a statement, he accused the BBC of making him a "scapegoat" and threatened to sue the

corporation.

At a news conference to announce the details of the findings into the abuse of Savile and Hall, the director general apologised to their victims and said: "A serial rapist and a predatory sexual abuser both hid in plain sight at the BBC for decades.

"What this terrible episode teaches us is that fame is power, a very strong form of power and like any form of power it must be held to account... and it wasn't."



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Brexit: who's in, who's out?

Your essential primer on how the big vote is shaping up

How people will vote in the EU referendum has more to do with their job, their age and where they live than with party allegiance.

If current polls are anything to go by – and for last May's general election, they weren't – Britain will vote to stay in the EU in the June referendum. There isn't much in it, though. Support for staying in hovers between 45% and 55%; support for a Brexit between 35% and 45%; as many as 20% are undecided. One thing seems clear, however. Now that David Cameron has announced his "deal", most of the business establishment – 80 of the FTSE 100 firms, and, according to an Institute of Directors poll, six out of ten executives – favor staying in. Last week, Prince William seemed to give his verdict, praising the UK's "long and proud tradition of seeking out allies and partners".

Do the "leavers" stand a chance?

They look like the underdogs at the moment, not least because they're divided into three factions – Vote Leave, Leave.EU and Grassroots Out – all vying to be named the official campaign and to qualify for public funding. By contrast, the "remain" camp has the single Britain Stronger in Europe, or BSE, group, headed by former Marks and Spencer chairman Lord Rose. However, the commitment of two big hitters, Boris Johnson and Michael Gove, to their cause has given the leavers a boost, as has a YouGov poll which found that just 22% of voters thought the PM had secured a good deal with Brussels. To many, his much-vaunted "renegotiation" was a classic Brussels fudge, the kind of hedged, part delivered, part

somewhere-down-the-line agreement that has put many people off the EU in the first place.

How are the main parties lining up?

Both the Lib Dems and Labour, who opposed having a referendum, will be campaigning to stay in, as will the SNP. UKIP and the Greens, who got almost five million votes between them at the last election, both wanted the referendum, but will be urging their supporters to support opposite outcomes. But though the main parties will all largely be urging voters to stay, it won't be pretty viewing. Former Labour home secretary Alan Johnson, who will lead his party's campaign, says he won't share a platform with Cameron. And much media attention will be paid to likely splits in the Tory party. Yet these are in many ways a distraction, since how people in the UK feel towards Europe is seldom much affected by what politicians have to say on the matter.

Then what does affect attitudes?

Ever since the last referendum on whether to stay in the Common Market, in 1975 (when Labour was split and the Tories were solidly pro-Europe), Britain's role in the EU has defied easy definition as a Left/Right issue. As with immigration, people's frustration with the EU often stems from a feeling of being disconnected from politics as a whole. To some extent, regional feelings across the UK towards the EU reflect this: London and Scotland are the most pro-European; deindustrialised communities in the Midlands and towns in the Southeast, unnerved by large-scale immigration since 2004, are more likely to want to leave. The Northeast and

places such as Cornwall, which have benefited from billions in EU investment, tend to be evenly split; Yorkshire, which has received less, leans towards Brexit.

What else is a key determinant?

Age, for a start. Voters under 30 want to stay in the EU by a ratio of almost two-to-one (but then again, young voters are the least likely to turn out on the day). The picture changes as people get older: according to YouGov, voters over 60 choose Brexit by 56% to 44%. Education and social grade, the classification pollsters use to divide the population into "managerial" and "semi-skilled" households, also help predict how voters feel, with university graduates and professionals more likely to vote "in". Pollsters speak of leavers being an "uneasy coalition" of older, broadly well-off voters (61% of those who own their home outright want to leave) and "economically insecure, working-class" communities who tend to be anti-immigration and fed up with politics in general.

Who are the undecideds?

Women are more likely than men to say they haven't yet made up their mind. There is an unusually high number of people still on the fence, and they tend to be those in the middle: middle aged, middle income, from outside London, and desperate for concrete "facts" that will decide the case one way or the other. Lord Ashcroft, the Tory peer and pollster, believes around 14% of voters are absolutely undecided, but he offers them little hope. They "want to know what the future holds if we stay and if we leave", he says, "but nobody is going to be able to tell them".

Cameron's EU deal: what the papers said

DAVID CAMERON had barely a day to enjoy the 'special status' he claimed to have secured for the country after several tough weeks of negotiations with his EU counterparts before his own party began to fracture over the forthcoming In/Out referendum.

Admitting that he felt no "love" for Brussels, the Prime Minister said the changes he had achieved did not address all the frustrations that he and others had with the EU, but were a big step in the right direction. "The choice is in your hands," he said, addressing the British people. "But my recommendation is clear. I believe that Britain will be safer, stronger and better off by remaining in a reformed European Union."

He's unquestionably right about that, said **Niall Ferguson** in *The Sunday Times*. It's bizarre that the future of this crucial relationship with our main trading partners may now turn on such trifling questions as for how many years "a Polish plumber will not be entitled to claim UK benefits". The past 500 or so years of British history

should have taught us by now that our fate will always be inextricably linked with that of continental Europe. To believe we can separate ourselves from Europe and prosper in glorious isolation is "utopian".

In the age of globalisation, the pooling of authority is more important than ever, said **Nigel Lawson** in *The Daily Telegraph*, **The Economist**. It's the only way to effectively tackle supranational issues such as pollution, migration, terrorism and market volatility. That's why we work with allies through other bodies such as Nato, the World Trade Organisation, the International Monetary Fund and the World Bank. "If sovereignty is the absence of mutual interference, the most sovereign country in the world is North Korea."

But is the EU really so effective, asked **Suzanne Moore** in *The Guardian*. The more we've seen of its workings in recent years – from its flat-footed response to the Greek debt crisis and the migrant issue to last week's tortuous negotiations over UK reforms – the less impressive it has looked as a decision-making

body. Besides, the EU just doesn't feel like a proper democracy. Voting to remain in this bloc – whose power rests largely "on a deadly combination of mystification, officiousness and being so boring that most people just switch off" – doesn't appeal. Were we to leave, said **Nigel Lawson** in *The Daily Telegraph*, we would of course continue cooperating and trading with Europe to our mutual benefit. We'd simply be opting out of a "political project" whose driving objective – the creation of a United States of Europe – we happen not to share.

Not so fast, said **Matthew Parris** in *The Times*. A vote for Brexit would rock the beleaguered EU to its foundations and probably lead to its "disintegration" – an event that would diminish us all. For all its "squabbles", "s o m n o l e n c e" and "clodhopping complacency", the EU is a torchbearer for progressive values such as reason, compromise and democracy at a time when these ideas are everywhere under assault."

Salisbury Cathedral giant hands artwork 'bumped into by texters'

A large artwork consisting of a massive pair of clasped hands has had to be moved away from a cathedral path due to people "bumping" into them.

The 20ft tall (6m) sculpture, called The Kiss, was positioned at Salisbury Cathedral, inviting people to walk in-between the wrists.

But it has been shifted off North Walk as a decision was taken that it was not well enough illuminated in the dark.

Artist Sophie Ryder wrote online that people were "walking through texting".

Some had "bumped their heads", she said.

The artwork is part of an exhibition by the British sculptor which began a week ago and runs until 3 July.

Other pieces in the Monumental exhibition

include life-sized Minotaurs and a Lady Hare as large as a house.

Ms Ryder posted on Facebook: "We had to move 'The Kiss' because people were walking through texting and said they bumped their heads! Oh well!!"

Canon Dr Robert Titley, the cathedral treasurer, said the clasped hands "form an arch which positively invites you to walk underneath".

"That was working fine, at least during the day," he said. "We then picked up a couple of signals that during the hours of darkness one or two people had bumped into it.

"We could see how, if you didn't see too well in the dark, this could be a hazard. So we've moved it a few metres onto the grass."

Walking and brawling

A game of walking football between two teams of over-50s had to be abandoned after two minutes when a brawl broke out. The greatest hero you've never heard of...

Eric "Winkle" Brown: WWII flying ace considered the greatest-ever test pilot

THIS WEEK saw the death of perhaps Britain's most unsung hero.

Captain Eric "Winkle" Brown, who has died aged 97, was arguably the world's greatest ever test pilot. In his extraordinary career, he flew 487 different types of aircraft, and made 2,407 deck landings at sea – records that are unlikely ever to be broken. The Fleet Air Arm's most decorated pilot, he survived the sinking of HMS Audacity in 1941; and in 1945, took part in the liberation of Bergen-Belsen. Fluent in German, he helped interview the camp's commandant, Josef Kramer, and Irma Grese, a notorious female warden. "Two more loathsome creatures it is hard to imagine," he said.

'born pilot'

Eric Brown (known as Winkle on account of his diminutive stature) was born in Leith in 1919, and educated at Edinburgh's Royal High School and Edinburgh University. In 1936, his father – who was himself a member of the Royal Flying Corps – took him to the Berlin Olympics, where they met a First World War flying ace, who took Eric up in a plane and declared him a born pilot. Eric duly joined the Fleet Air Arm in 1939, and was sent with 802 Squadron to protect North Atlantic convoys from the escort carrier Audacity. Awarded the DSC for his bravery, he was then sent to Farnborough, to trial new versions of the Spitfire and Hurricane, and to test aircraft landing arrangements on new carriers: an extraordinarily hazardous task for which

he was awarded an MBE in 1944.

Brown's astonishing feat of flying 487 different types of aircraft would be unthinkable to today's top test pilots, who average fewer than 100 flights, said Rear Admiral Simon Charlier, former commander of the Fleet Air Arm. "Over 50 is deemed a large number. We can't imagine in this day and age how dangerous his job was."

'slide rule'

"They didn't have the advantage of high-tech simulators. He just had

to look at the aircraft and think what he was going to do with it", said Mark Bowman, chief test pilot at BAE Systems.

"He would have been flying the aircraft with "the benefit of a slide rule, not a bank of computers as we have now," he added.

The US Navy were said to have given one man the specific job of breaking Brown's record. "To his everlasting credit he got up to 1,600 and then had a nervous breakdown," claimed Brown in documentary made on his life late last year.

After the war Brown passed Mach 1 (the speed of sound at any height) in American Sabre and British Hunter jets. In the 1960s, he flew Chinook helicopters, Buccaneer nuclear bombers and Mach 2 Lightning and Phantom fighters. Appointed CBE in 1970, he retired later that year. In 2014, Captain Brown was selected to be the subject of the 3,000th edition of Desert Island Discs. "When you read through his life story, it makes James Bond seem like a bit of a slacker," noted the show's host, Kirsty Young.

Another key element is focus. Our minds only hold thoughts for a second or two and then move on, which means we can be easily distracted. Meditation is only effective when we can provide our own self-help and manage our mental fluttering. This is definitely a skill, and one that gets easier with practice! Don't get discouraged if it takes a little while to get the hang of it. You can't force it; learn to let it happen.

That said, give these meditation tips a try to see what works best for you:

THE STILLNESS

This popular technique involves focusing your vision on a single point until you get the infamous blank stare (or if your eyes are closed, a sort of internal space out). You might stare at a spot on a wall, a candle flame, or a religious or spiritual object. You can also focus on something auditory like chanting or a bell chime.

THE FLOW

This meditation technique is very much like the one listed above

except that you will focus on an object in motion - such as a water fall, your own breathing, or something auditory like drumming.

THE CENTERING

This technique takes many different forms but ultimately aims to heighten your awareness of your place in the world. Centering meditation can be either outer (real) or inner (imagined) but the intent is to anchor your perspective in the center of a vivid image in which even the smallest detail is noted. With this technique, you will get into your meditation space then allow yourself to let in an outside noise or thought. This can be a great technique for beginners because of this (if you find it hard to quiet your mind and concentrate). By responding to "distractions" by absorbing yourself in them and therefore dismantling them, you take their power away.

THE VOID

This technique is sort of the antithesis of the three listed above. Like the name suggests, here you will think about nothing. You will have no focal point. You

could think of focusing on "the blankness" or "the stillness," but nevertheless the void meditation is about the complete absence of any internal or external focus. It can be quite challenging but very rewarding and relaxing.

THE TAKAWAY

Lastly, for even greater benefits, follow these general guidelines: Make it a routine. Set aside a certain time each day to meditate, (20 mins is good) like before or after reviewing your vision boards. Put it on your schedule if you have to.

Have a quiet, comfortable place to sit. Remove any distractions from the area (such as silencing your cell phone and putting your dog in the backyard).

Sometimes it's nice to have a CD playing with relaxing music or nature sounds. This can also trigger to your brain that it's time to get in meditation mode.

Most people who begin a 30 day period never stop. So if you find it hard to relax, then why not give meditation a go...?

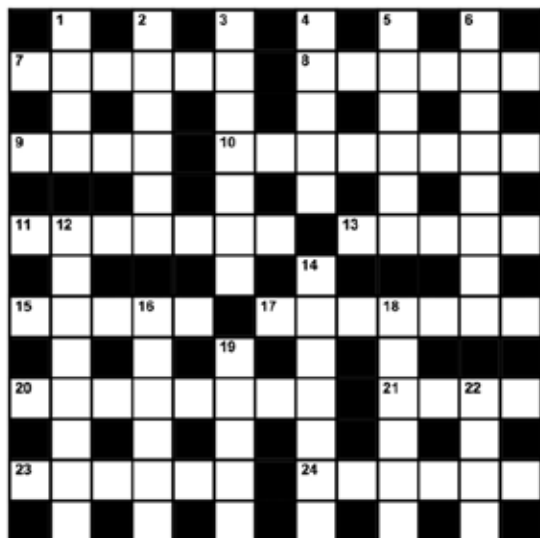

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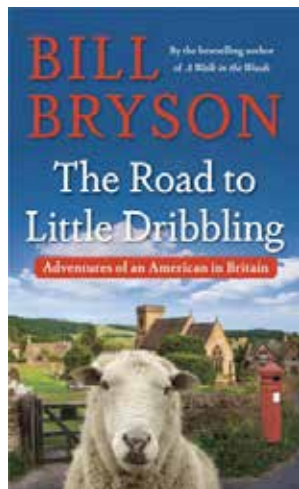
The Road to Little Dribbling: from America with love

FANS of Bill Bryson, rejoice. The Anglophile American who quite literally wrote the book on the charms and foibles of the British Isles in his classic book *Notes from A Small Island*, has done it again with his latest love letter to his adopted country, *The Road To Little Dribbling*.

Bryson landed in England from his native Iowa in 1973 and was immediately bowled over by the country. On a whim he got a job at a psychiatric hospital, met a nurse there, and married her, thus beginning a lifelong love affair with Great Britain, where he's lived on and off for decades and to which he paid homage in *Notes from a Small Island* (1996), his first British travelogue.

After a spell back in



America, during which he wrote, among other works, *A Walk in the Woods* (recently made into a movie starring Robert Redford and Nick Nolte) Bryson revisited Britain to walk what he dubs the Bryson line – a not-quite-straight route from Bognor Regis on the South Coast to Cape Wrath in northernmost Scotland, to observe critique and delight in Britain's many idiosyncratic ways.

It's not at all necessary

to read Bryson's first book to enjoy his latest, but you will miss out on the following observation, which got this reviewer hooked on Bryson's eye and style in the first place: "If you mention in the pub that you intend to drive from, say, Surrey to Cornwall, a distance that most Americans would happily go to get a taco, your companions will puff their cheeks, look knowingly at each other, and blow out their air as if to say, 'Well, now that's a bit of a tall order.'" ... "There's the Great West steam rally at Little Dribbling this weekend," somebody from across the room will add, strolling over to join you because it's always pleasant to bring bad motoring news.

"There'll be 375,000 cars all converging on the Little Chef roundabout at Upton Dupton. We once spent 11 days in a tailback there, and that was just

to get out of the car park. No, you want to have left when you were still in your mother's womb, or preferably while you were spermatozoa, and even then you won't find a parking space beyond Bodmin."

For me, this is marvelous stuff, precisely because Bryson has the eye of an outsider but such a love for British culture and countryside that we laugh with him, rather than raise our eyebrows at his censure.

Twenty years later, as he is entering what he fondly calls his "dotage", Bryson seems merely to have sharpened both his heart and his claws. He remains devoted to Britain's eccentric place names, pastimes and manners. He delights in the manicured majesty of Britain's open spaces, while fulminating against the litter bugs and careless planners who may yet destroy

them.

Among the places Bryson finds and ponders in *The Road to Little Dribbling* are Bognor Regis, the New Forest, the London Underground and the little remembered model community of Motopia. He brings readers along as he walks with his trusty Ordnance Survey map in hand through the English countryside visiting well- and lesser-known museums and parks. In this book you will discover why the Himalayan mountain is named after George Everest. And just why London is the best city in the world. Or why Oxford is the most pleasant and improved city in Britain; why Lytham is the best small town in the north, and why Morecambe boasts Britain's most beautiful bay.

Although Bryson's favor is soft and warm

and his disfavor is more often gently mocking than vituperative, on occasion the peculiar madness of the Brits can really set him off. No words are minced or punches pulled where he finds social decline; he rails against indifferent British shopkeepers and indulges in more than one violent fantasy. However, the bulk of his love/hate relationship with Britain falls squarely on the love side. Anglophiles will find Bryson's field notes equally entertaining and educational, and armchair travelers will enjoy the jaunt immensely. A thoroughly recommend read.

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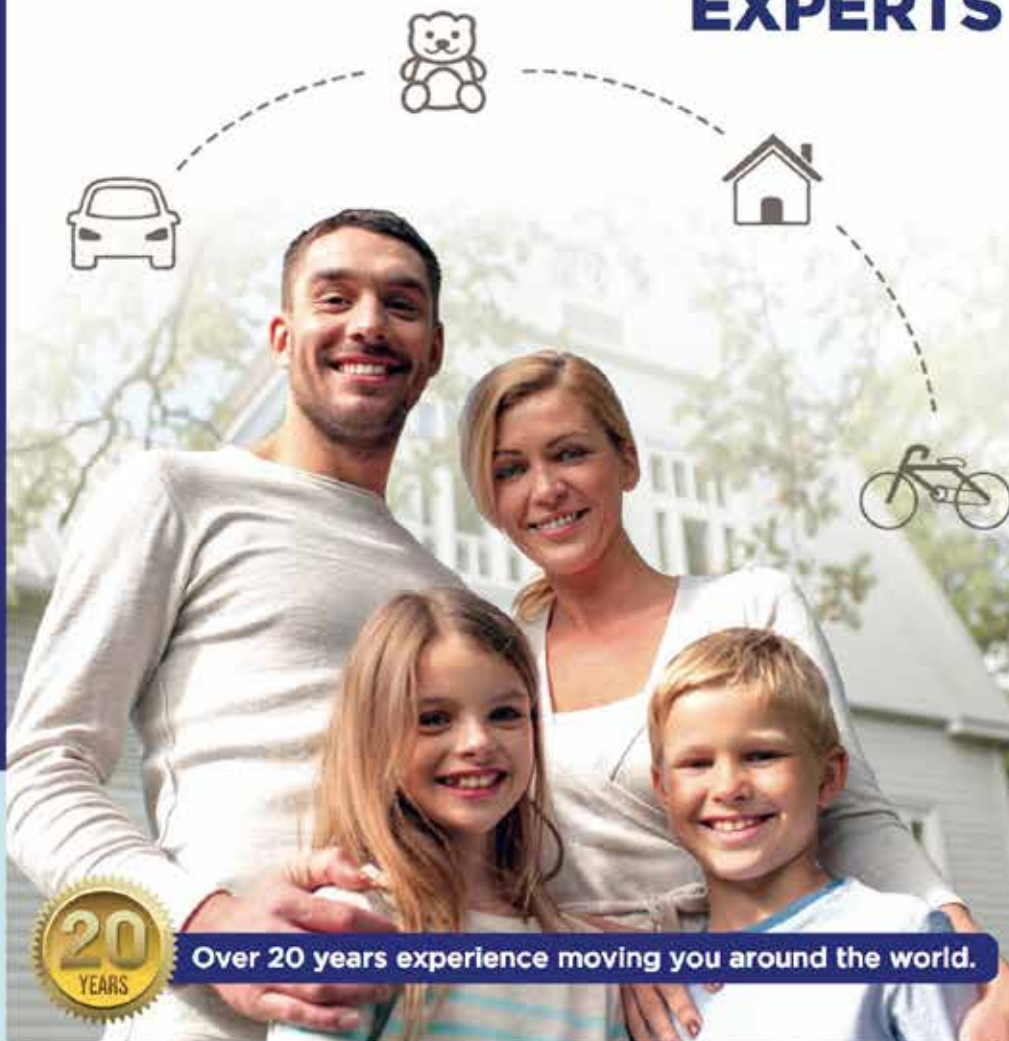

■ Arsenal 'not technically precise enough'

Barcelona are "95% through" to the Champions League quarter-finals, says Arsenal manager Arsene Wenger after his side lost 2-0 to the Spanish champions.

The Frenchman blamed his team's finishing and naivety for the home loss in the first leg of their last-16 tie.

Alex Oxlade-Chamberlain and Olivier Giroud missed chances for the Gunners before Barca scored the opener.

"The way we finished our chances is a problem. I felt in the final third we missed something," said Wenger.

"Barcelona are through 95% but we want to go there and play. We will not go there and have absolutely no chance," he added. Arsenal will be eliminated at the last-16 stage for the sixth time in a row if they fail to overturn the deficit at the Nou Camp on 16 March.

Wenger likened his side's defeat by Barcelona to their 3-1 loss to Monaco at the same stage last season when - similarly to Barca's

opener - they conceded from a counter attack.

"I feel that we were extremely guilty and have no excuses for that first goal.

"They are better than us and I believe everyone knows that, but we could have won the game if we had kept the discipline until the end."

France striker Giroud struggled to make an impact in attack along with Oxlade-Chamberlain, Mesut Ozil and Alexis Sanchez as the Gunners failed to capitalise.

"We were impatient in the build-up, we lost balls that we don't usually lose. Not because Barcelona forced us but just because we were not technically precise enough in our passing," added Wenger.

"When you lose 2-0 at home in the Champions League it is not a happy dressing room. I felt there was room to beat them. That is the biggest regret I have."

Spurs in harmony to brush aside the Viola

Tottenham dispatched Fiorentina 3-0 on Thursday night to reach the Europa League last 16 and underline their credentials as serious contenders for the tournament.

Hosts Spurs took the lead as Ryan Mason strode through and side-footed home midway through the first half.

The Italians rallied briefly after the break, but Erik Lamela snuffed out any hope of a fightback as he smashed in from close range.

An own goal from skipper Gonzalo Rodriguez completed the Viola's misery.

Tottenham's Harry Kane is expected to return to the Tottenham line-up for Sunday's Premier League match against Swansea after breaking his nose in the FA Cup defeat by Crystal Palace last weekend.

But the England forward's absence gave

an insight into how Spurs, who lack a clear striking alternative, might cope without their top-scorer.

Dele Alli, Christian Eriksen and Lamela took it in turns to form the focal point of the attack and Fiorentina's defence struggled to keep up with a constant carousel of changing positions and personnel.

The 19-year-old, who was warned about his conduct by boss Mauricio Pochettino after apparently aiming a kick at a Fiorentina player in the first leg, picked up a harsh booking for diving late on.

It did not deter the White Hart Lane crowd from giving the England midfielder a standing ovation when he was replaced after another mature and influential display.

captain Jordan Henderson had a close-range shot saved before the relief of the final whistle.

"It is frustrating. We should be scoring two or three and killing the game off and it makes it tough second half as you know if they score they go through," England midfielder Henderson told BT Sport.

"We have to give credit to Augsburg as well. They are a quality team and put us under pressure."

Milner did go down at one point following an accidental clash with Stafylidis, but there did not appear to be any other injury worries for Jurgen Klopp.

"Phil had one or two situations after challenges but we need to find new faith or trust in the body of the players," said the 48-year-old German.

"They (Sturridge and Coutinho) are very important for us but we need them in their best shape and you can only get this from training and matches."

Sweet 16 brings vindication for Pellegrini

Manchester City boss Manuel Pellegrini said his decision to prioritise the Champions League over the FA Cup was vindicated by the win at Dynamo Kiev in midweek.

Pellegrini was criticised for playing a weakened side in Sunday's 5-1 fifth-round defeat at Chelsea, but they won Wednesday's last-16 first-leg tie 3-1.

"Having just 13 fit outfield players - it was

a key decision to rest the team in the [FA Cup] game," said Pellegrini.

"It was important for the way we had to play this game with lots of intensity."

Pellegrini made 10 changes as he went with his strongest available line-up in Kiev.

Sergio Aguero, David Silva and Yaya Toure scored for City, while England keeper Joe Hart, who also missed the FA Cup tie, superbly saved

an effort from Kiev scorer Vitaliy Buyalsky.

Chilean Pellegrini added: "In this profession you always get criticism when you don't win, but for the manager it is important to take the right decision.

"I always try to respect all the competitions but unfortunately we couldn't continue in the

FA Cup."

City are favourites to progress to the quarter-finals for the first time but Pellegrini, who will be replaced as manager by Pep Guardiola at the end of the season, warned that the tie was far from over.

"I'm very happy. It's a very good result," he said.

City centre-back Vincent Kompany hopes the result will give his side confidence as they prepare to face Liverpool in the League Cup final at Wembley on Sunday.

"It was a great result, especially away from home, and we couldn't have hoped for better," he said.

"We will take a lot of positives out of the game and it's a good start to a big week for us."

Teenage tyro grabs brace for United

■ **EUROPA LEAGUE: Smiles for Van Gaal at last as United find form to ease into last 16**

Teenager Marcus Rashford scored twice on his debut Thursday night as Manchester United came from behind to thrash FC Midtjylland 5-1 and reach the Europa League last 16.

The Danish champions led 2-1 from the first leg and Pione Sisto increased their advantage.

Nikolay Bodurov's own goal reduced the deficit before Rashford, who only started after Anthony Martial was injured in the warm-up, struck twice.

Ander Herrera's penalty and Memphis Depay's late goal completed the rout.

Juan Mata missed a penalty at 1-1, while Midtjylland finished with 10 men after Andre Romer was sent off for a second yellow card.

While the scoreline was emphatic in the end, United were looking at an embarrassing exit before Rashford netted twice in the space of 12 second-half minutes in front of the Stretford End.

The 18-year-old, named as a substitute on the team sheet, was only elevated to the starting line-up after France forward Martial damaged his hamstring in the warm-up.

Manchester-born Rashford showed confidence beyond his years from the start, but Sisto's tidy finish left Louis van Gaal's side staring at an embarrassing exit at the hands of a team formed in 1999.

Bodurov lifted the mood inside Old Trafford when he sliced Depay's cutback into his own net before Mata's spot-kick was saved by Mikkel Andersen after Ander Herrera was clipped by Kian Hansen.

The exciting Rashford put United ahead when he tucked home from seven yards before repeating the trick with a half-volley to make it 3-1.

Herrera added his side's fourth from the penalty spot after Hansen handled before Depay's thumping effort

completed the scoring.

It looked like another sorry chapter in United's season of underachievement even before a ball had been kicked.

Defender Chris Smalling was ruled out earlier on Thursday with a shoulder problem, paving the way for 19-year-old Joe Riley, a substitute in United's FA Cup win at Shrewsbury three days earlier, to make his first senior start.

Martial's injury paved the way for Rashford's debut, but after recovering from falling behind on the night, United scored four times inside the final half hour to pull away.

They could even afford to end the match with another teenage debutant on the pitch in the shape of 17-year-old Regan Poole.

Under-pressure Van Gaal managed a smile at the end after his side scored five in a match for the first time under his control in front of a 58,609 crowd.

Reds squeak through to next round

Liverpool warmed up for the Capital One Cup final on Sunday by reaching the last 16 of the Europa League with a tense 1-0 win over Augsburg at Anfield.

Following a goalless first leg, James Milner scored a penalty after Dominik Kohr's handball to put the Reds ahead.

Liverpool failed to take their chances and a Lucas Leiva back-pass released Augsburg's Caiuby but he shot wide.

An away goal would have put the Germans through and Reds keeper Simon Mignolet had to save from Tobias Werner late on.

Liverpool ended up hanging on as they made it into Friday's draw in which there are no seedings or restrictions on facing teams from your own country.

The Reds would have wanted to put this tie to bed as quickly as possible with the Wembley showpiece against Manchester City on Sunday and they were aided by the early penalty.

Liverpool pressed high up the pitch and played some stylish football but, with six goals in seven previous Europa League outings this season, they again struggled in front of goal and failed to turn

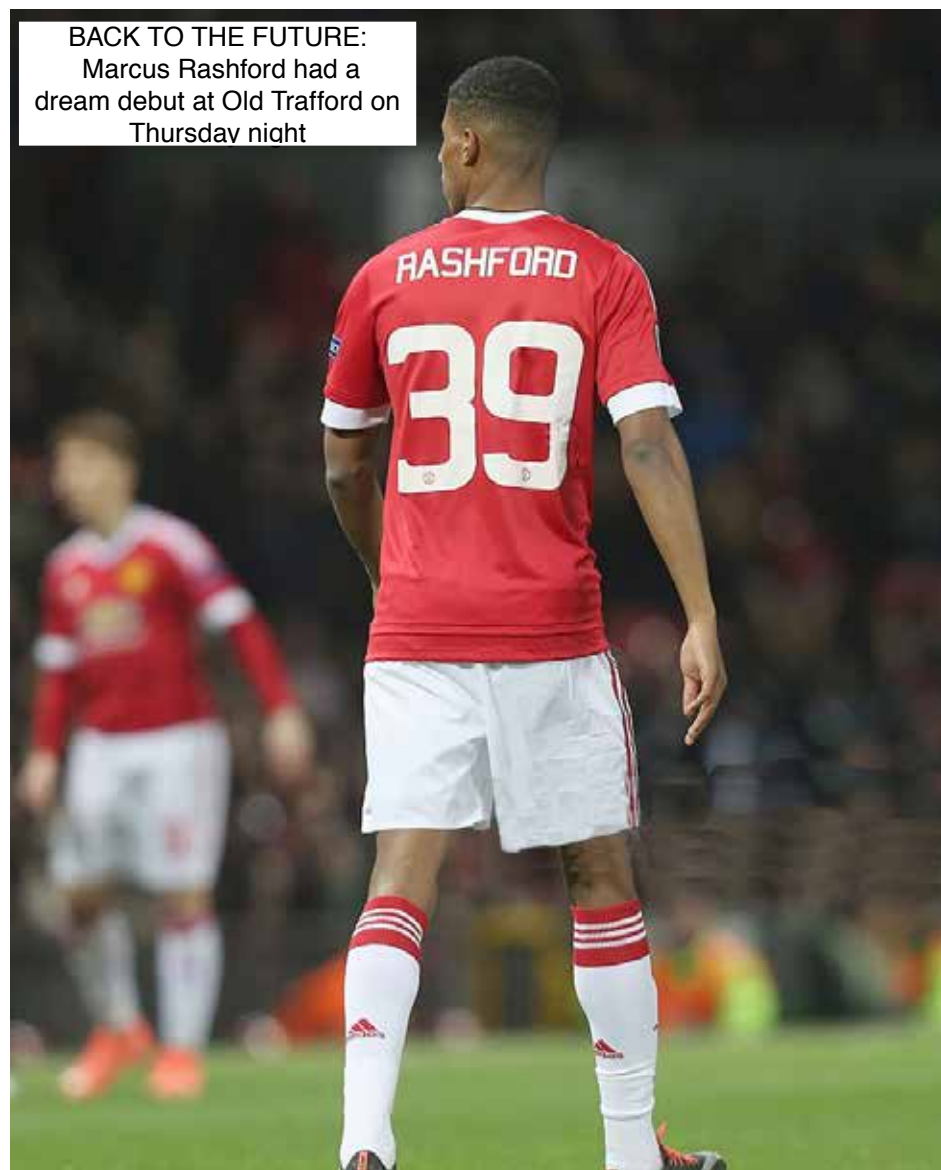
their superiority into a bigger lead.
