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BIG SAM'S SORRY EXIT

■ Allardyce jets out to Spanish bolt-hole as Telegraph sting forces him to quit England job

SAM Allardyce flew out of Britain on Wednesday with £1million in his pocket after being forced to quit in disgrace as England manager.

The 61-year-old was handed the huge pay-off as he lost his dream job after just 67 days – the shortest reign as England manager.

Before heading off to his bolthole abroad Allardyce blamed “entrapment” for his downfall. He left behind a growing corruption scandal following claims that eight unnamed current or former Premier League managers took ‘bungs’ when buying players.

Allardyce admitted he made “an error of judgment” after he was caught out in an undercover sting as he negotiated a £400,000 deal with fake businessmen, who were in fact reports from The Daily Telegraph.

As he prepared to set off from his £500,000 home in Bolton with wife Lynne, he told how he had just been trying “to help” out a friend of 30 years, his agent Scott McGarvey.

Allardyce said: “On reflection it was a silly thing to do. It was an error of judgment on my behalf and I’ve suffered the consequences. Entrapment has won on this occasion and I have to accept that.”

The father of two paid the ultimate professional price after he was filmed allegedly cashing in on his role as England boss, offering advice on how to sidestep transfer rules laid down by the FA.

Hours after the revelations in Monday’s

Telegraph Allardyce was summoned for a showdown with FA chiefs at Wembley Stadium.

After the meeting it was announced on

Tuesday night that he was stepping down from his £3million-a-year job “by mutual consent”. Gareth Southgate will take charge of England’s

next four matches.

Big Sam said after the meeting: “The agreement was done very amicably with the FA and I apologize to those

and all concerned in the unfortunate position I’ve put myself in.”

he had a confidentiality agreement and could not answer further questions.

He added: "I'm off abroad to chill out and reflect. I'd like to wish all the England lads, Gareth and all the staff all the very best."

'laughing stock'

Asked whether he would return to football as a manager in the future, Allardyce was uncertain, simply offering: "Who knows?"

The former England boss then climbed into a taxi after the driver had helped carry matching suitcases to the car. He is thought to be heading to his £1.5million holiday home called "Big Sam's villa" in the Spanish hills on the Costa Blanca.

Allardyce's departure means the FA is once again on the lookout for a new manager just months after crashing out of the Euro 2016 tournament.

During the recorded

interview, Allardyce mocked Roy Hodgson's speech by referring to him as 'Woy' and said his predecessor didn't have the "personality" to lead England. He also criticised Princes William and Harry as well as former assistant manager Gary Neville.

But his thoughts on ways around the FA's ban on third-party ownership of stars was arguably even more damaging. He told the undercover crew it was "not a problem" to bypass rules and claimed he knew of agents who were "doing it all the time".

On Wednesday former England captain Alan Shearer accused Allardyce of a "catastrophic misjudgment" and claimed that England were now the "laughing stock of world football".

Match Of The Day presenter Gary Lineker said on Twitter: "Surely it's time for a proper police investigation into such allegations. The game is rife with corruption and needs cleaning up. Now."

Corbyn calls for party unity after sweeping victory in Labour contest

Jeremy Corbyn has urged the British Labour Party to unite behind him after his overwhelming victory against leadership challenger Owen Smith.

Mr Corbyn strengthened his mandate with a 61.8% share of the vote - up from 59.5% last year - and won the support of more than 300,000 party members and supporters in a result which is likely to kill off any prospect of further attempts to unseat him for some time to come.

'democratic choice'

Accepting victory before cheering supporters in Liverpool, the veteran left-winger said he wanted to "wipe the slate clean" after a bruising contest, and called on Labour MPs to "work together and respect the democratic choice that's been made".

In a statement, Mr Smith said he respected the result and urged Labour moderates not to split the party in response.

He has previously said he will not serve in a Corbyn shadow cabinet, which is thought likely to be reshuffled soon as the leader attempts to bring back on board some of the MPs who walked out of his top team in June.

Mr Corbyn said both he and his challenger

were part of the "same Labour family" as he appealed for unity after receiving 313,209 of the votes cast, compared with 193,229 for Mr Smith.

'wonderful supporters'

A breakdown of the figures showed the Islington North MP defeated his challenger in all three sections of the 500,000-strong electorate - full members, supporters from affiliated organisations like the unions, and registered supporters who paid a £25 fee to vote.

He acknowledged he had a responsibility as leader to unite the party, but added: "It is also the responsibility of the whole party - Members of Parliament, councillors, party members and our wonderful supporters across the country -

to work together and respect the democratic choice that's been made."

Quoting the maiden speech of former Labour MP Jo Cox, who was shot and stabbed to death earlier this year, Mr Corbyn said: "Always remember in our party, we have much more in common than that which divides us."

'Labour or nothing'

Mr Smith, who quit as shadow work and pensions secretary to fight for the leadership, said he would "reflect carefully" on what role he could play in Labour's future.

But he ruled out leaving for a rival centre-left party, saying: "I have no time for talk of a split in the Labour movement - it's Labour or nothing for me."

"And although today's

result shows that our movement remains divided, it now falls primarily to Jeremy Corbyn, as Labour leader, to heal those divisions and to unite our movement.

"We have to turn round our dire opinion poll ratings and take on this right-wing, failing Tory government.

"Jeremy has won this contest. He now has to win the country, and he will have my support in trying to do so.

"Above all, despite present divisions, we have to stick together in for the long term.

"I call on those party members disappointed by the result and tempted to look elsewhere to stay with Labour, and to stay involved. Let's work together to renew this movement and take the fight to the Tories," added Mr Smith.

PRINCE GEORGE hit the headlines both north of the border and across the pond this week when he pointedly refused a high-five with Canadian Premier Justin Trudeau.

Several media outlets and newspapers focused on the brief appearance of the toddler and his 16-month-old sister Princess Charlotte at Victoria’s airport on Saturday, where the Canadian prime minister was among several dignitaries waiting on the tarmac to greet the royals

when they emerged from their flight on Saturday.

After shaking hands with Prince William and his wife Kate, Trudeau knelt down to meet three-year-old George, who was holding his father’s hand. Trudeau was seen lifting his hand, trying to high-five the young prince, who shook his head and did not accept the gesture.

Videos and photos of the interaction made headlines across Britain, with the *Mirror* sniffing: “Superstar politician Mr. Trudeau might have

endeared himself to millions online through his outspoken feminism, support for diversity and willingness to embrace Internet memes, but it seems to take more than that to impress Will and Kate’s eldest.”

Similar reports were done by *The Independent*, with a story headlined: “Prince George leaves Justin Trudeau hanging after he goes for a high-five.”

The *Daily Mail* shared a story with the headline: “Sorry, one doesn’t high-five with commoners.”

Wealth of people in their 30s has ‘halved in a decade’

British citizens in their early 30s are half as wealthy as those now in their 40s were at the same age, a report finds.

Today’s 30-something generation has missed out on house price increases and better pensions, according to research by the Institute for Fiscal Studies.

Those born in the early

1980s have an average wealth of £27,000 each, against the £53,000 those born in the 1970s had by the same age, said the IFS.

They will also find it harder to amass wealth in the future, it added.

The think tank found that people born in the early 1980s were the first post-war group not

to have higher incomes in early adulthood than those born in the preceding decade.

“This is partly the result of the overall stagnation of working-age incomes,” it said. “But it also reflects the fact that the great recession hit the pay and employment of young adults the hardest.”

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Revealed: the behind the scenes bust-up over sexing-up Sooty

The idea to introduce a female puppet to Sooty's children's TV show in the 1960s was so controversial that the BBC director general had to intervene, a new documentary has revealed.

The suggestion by Sooty creator Harry Corbett caused a furore in the press, which claimed it would "introduce sex into a children's programme".

The show's producer and a BBC governor were against Sooty having a girlfriend.

BBC DG Hugh Carlton Greene finally stepped in to allow panda Soo's introduction.

Matthew Corbett, Harry's son, told the documentary: "My father was called into the head office and the director general of the BBC said he had made a decision."

He said Greene had ruled that Sooty having a female friend "was to be allowed - but they must never touch".

So Soo was introduced in 1965 - originally voiced by Harry Corbett's wife Marjorie - and she has

been at Sooty's side ever since.

The documentary, titled *Sooty Ungloved*, will have its world premiere in Guiseley, Yorkshire, on Saturday, with profits from the screening going towards providing a defibrillator for the area. Corbett and his family lived in the town for 35 years. He and the puppet found fame on TV in the early 1950s.

When Corbett suggested introducing a female character in the 1960s, the show's producer Trevor Hill dismissed the idea

"on the grounds that sex would be creeping into the programme", according to a letter written by Corbett in 1965.

The tabloid press picked up on the disagreement, causing a row between Corbett and Grahame Miller, the BBC's head of north regional programmes.

Miller accused Corbett of orchestrating a campaign in the press for Sooty to be allowed a girlfriend, letters from the BBC archive reveal.

As a result, he told Corbett the BBC was

prepared to "hold up the contractual negotiations which are in train" and "urgently review the future of the Sooty series in BBC Television".

One of the BBC governors, Dame Anne Goodwin, was also strongly opposed to Sooty having a female friend.

In May 1965, Hill wrote to Miller: "I was left in no doubt as to her feelings in this matter!"

The Sooty Show was cancelled by the BBC two years later, however, before being picked up by ITV.

Lawyer disbarred for repeatedly dodging train fare

A BARRISTER dubbed "the Artful Dodger" after avoiding £6,000 in train fares has been booted out of his profession.

Oxford graduate Dr Peter Barnett, 45, commuted daily from his £600,000 home in Thame, Oxfordshire.

He boarded at sleepy Haddenham & Thame Parkway station in Buckinghamshire without a ticket.

At Marylebone, after the 50-mile journey, he "tapped" his Oyster card and exited. When the Australian-born lawyer was challenged in 2014 he said he had boarded in north-west London.

He was accused of cheating Chiltern

Railways out of more than £23,000 which would have made him the UK's worst ever fare dodger.

He admitted fraud between April 2012 and November 2014 at City of London magistrates court last year.

Dr Barnett, who worked for a think-tank, was spared jail after his lawyer Angus Bunyan said the actual loss was £5,892.70. Judge Ola Omotosho ordered him to pay it back, work 200 hours unpaid and gave him a four-month suspended prison sentence.

After the conviction, his dismissal by the Bar Standards Board this week became inevitable.

Older women like 'bonkbusters' because 'they're not getting any' claims best-selling author

Older women enjoy reading racy novels because they are 'not getting enough', best-selling author Prue Leith has suggested.

Women who grew up reading Jilly Cooper's "bonkbusters" are not as easily shocked because they are used to it, she also joked.

Speaking at the Henley Literary Festival this week, Ms Leith, who made her name a food writer before moving into the more racy world of sexy-laden romantic novels,

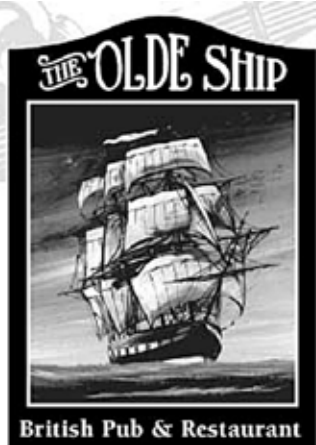
added: "If [some people] know there is going to be a sex scene in a novel, they won't buy it because they think it will be toe-curlingly gynaecological."

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Apple ink deal for Battersea Power station move

■ London mayor hails deal, describes capital as the leading city for trade and investment."

Apple has agreed a deal to move its London headquarters to occupy almost half of the redevelopment of Battersea Power Station, relocating 1,400 staff to the iconic building.

The company will be the largest office tenant in the development, taking six floors, and moving in in 2021. The deal is the largest office letting in London's West End in 20 years, according to the site's developer.

The iPhone maker will consolidate its staff from its existing London offices into the new building, making it the largest employer in Wandsworth borough.

Rob Tincknell, chief executive of Battersea Power Station Development Company, said: "It has always been our clear objective to create one of London's

most thriving new communities and this commitment from Apple will undoubtedly help us achieve our goal."

Knight Frank and CBRE acted for Battersea Power Station Development Company to broker the deal, while Cushman & Wakefield acted for Apple.

tube station

The Battersea Power Station development, which when completed will comprise more than 4,300 homes, as well as office space, shops and hotels, is owned by Malaysian shareholders Sime Darby, SP Setia and The Employees Provident Fund (EPF).

A new tube station is being developed to support the site, as well as major upgrades to the existing rail lines that

surround the station.

Sadiq Khan, Mayor of London, said the move would generate new jobs for Londoners: "It is a further sign that London is open to the biggest brands in the world and

the leading city for trade and investment."

Designed by Sir Giles Gilbert-Scott and one of the most famous examples of art deco industrial architecture, the power station became

operational in the 1930s and provided electricity to Buckingham Palace, Carnaby Street and the Houses of Parliament.

It has provided the backdrop to a number of famous cinematic

moments, including the opening scene of Alfred Hitchcock's 1936 film *Sabotage*, and has been used in fashion shows and on Pink Floyd's famous *Animals* album cover.

Booming UK climbs two spots in global competitive rankings

The UK's solid economy and efforts to cut red tape have propelled the country up three places in the global competitiveness rankings, according to the World Economic Forum.

The WEF's influential report said the UK's status as a digital pioneer and support for entrepreneurs had cemented its position

as "one of the most competitive economies in the world".

This helped the UK to leapfrog Japan, Hong Kong and Finland into seventh place out of 138 countries this year, representing its highest ranking since comparable records began a decade

ago.

It came as European powerhouse Germany slipped one place into fifth as the eurozone continues to grapple with low growth and inflation.

While the rankings do not take into account June's Brexit vote, the WEF said

there were reasons to be optimistic about the UK's competitiveness.

It said the decision to leave the EU meant the Government could set policies and regulations that were "optimal" for the UK instead of having to "compromise" with 27 other EU member states.

It also said UK policymaking was likely to become more transparent following its exit from the bloc.

However, the WEF warned that leaving the bloc could increase

trade barriers that would raise costs for businesses and consumers.

It also warned that the vote to leave risked diminishing the UK's ability to attract and retain top talent.

Sir Cliff's relief at end of sex crime probe

Sir Cliff Richard says "a cloud lifted" when he was informed he would not be prosecuted over claims of historical sex offences.

"It's not been the best two years of my life but it's all gone," he told Ken Bruce on BBC Radio 2 this week.

"Even though I knew it couldn't go anywhere [because] these things never happened, there is always the fear and the embarrassment of being talked about in those terms.

"I'm moving on with my life."

The singer was the subject of a long-running investigation by South

Yorkshire police, which centred on accusations made by four men.

He was never arrested or charged, and always maintained his innocence.

The claims against the singer were dropped on 16 June on the grounds of insufficient evidence.

The CPS reviewed the case following an application by one of his accusers but concluded this week that their decision has been correct.

Sir Cliff was speaking to BBC Radio 2 after announcing the release of a new album, *Just... Fabulous Rock 'n' Roll* which will feature a duet with Elvis Presley.

Was there a particular reason you chose LA?

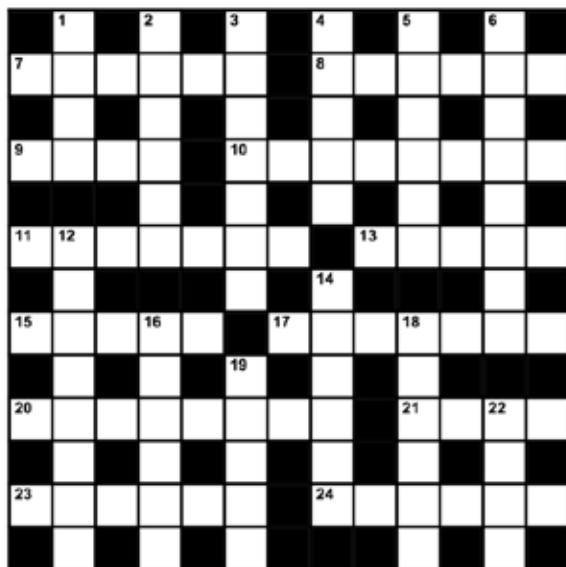

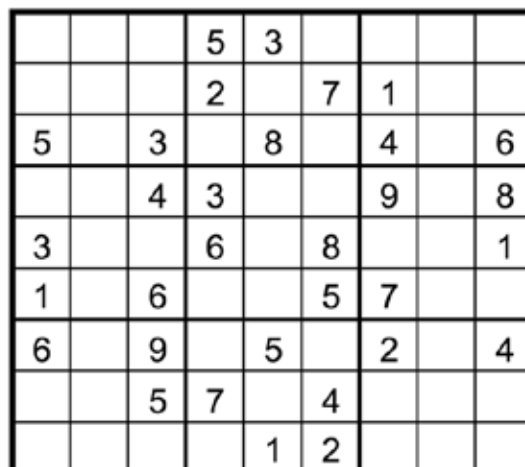

The Huntingfield Paintress: heaven up there

Exclusive interview with author Pamela Holmes and her book about St Mary's Church in Suffolk and its beautifully painted ceiling

"I wasn't thinking about making a New Year's resolution," says *The Huntingfield Paintress* author Pamela Holmes. "But, I came out with one, to write a novel about the woman who had decorated the church. Two years later, I achieved that ambition. It's a resolution and a dream come true."

On New Year's Day 2011 Holmes and her husband visited the beautiful village of Huntingfield in Suffolk. "We went inside the ancient church of St Mary's. It was bright outside but dark and gloomy in the small church. A sign suggested the visitor to the church put a pound into the box on the wall. Now,



where above our heads it had been shadowy, there shimmered a medieval ceiling of saints, apostles and religious iconography in bright colours and gold leaf. The rafters were wild with patterns and pigment. Carved winged angels leapt from the ends of the hammer beam roof. I was bowled over."

Based on the true Victorian era story of Mildred Holland and her husband William Holland, who was the vicar in a small Suffolk village, I love that it's a real place we can visit. However, Mildred

doesn't get to painting until halfway through the book. There is lots of time with peripheral characters and with Mildred's interaction (or lack of) with the women of the town. I was left wanting more about Mildred's life after she finished painting. Although at times the story moved slowly, it's still lovely.

For the first eight years of their marriage Mildred and William lived abroad as the living at the vicarage was still occupied until the current vicar decided to retire. When they returned they found the church in disrepair. As work progressed on the church, she thought they needed art on the ceiling, like they'd seen in Italy. She painted the first part of the church. The town was scandalized, but on seeing it they liked what she'd done. They had only one comment. Why was it only over the pews for the rich? Didn't all the parishioners deserve art?

"I couldn't understand

what would drive a Victorian woman, expected to administer tea and sympathy to parishioners, to stand on a sixty feet high scaffold," says Holmes. "And, to work stretching up above her head or lie on her back, without the benefits of heating or lighting, to create a 15th century angel ceiling. I was inspired to find out more...and I did. Then I began to write the story behind the facts, what drove this woman to take on this Herculean task. A leaflet explained that in the 1850s, Mildred Holland, the parish vicar's wife, had single-handedly created this medieval fresco."

"I read widely around the topic of Victorian England including the lives of vicars, artists, the impact of industrialisation, public health and the role of women," says Holmes. "I interviewed people such as an art historian, a specialist in gold leaf application and a vicar's daughter. I visited places and buildings relevant

to the story, I drew pictures and patterns from the Church ceiling and I lived for two weeks in Huntingfield village in an ex-laundry, walking the hills and woods, to absorb what it might be like to live in Huntingfield."

Holmes won the Jane Austen Short Story Award in 2014 for *The Wedding Planner* and was Highly Commended with the HISSAC award in 2015 for *We Battle for the Taj*. Besides writing short stories, Holmes writes a diary and has written songs for her band. *The Huntingfield Paintress* is being considered by several production companies for film or TV.

Matthew Smith, founder and owner of Urbane Publications, is Holmes editor. "There are many stories that deserve to be told, but it is a very rare and wonderful feeling when you see a story that *has* to be told," says Smith. "As a small, but quickly growing, independent publisher, Urbane is

focusing on developing brilliant new authors and taking them to a wider audience."

Holmes is currently writing her second novel, a story set in the 1970s.
