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'RECOLLECTIONS MAY VARY' SAYS QUEEN

■ Royal Family sends message of love to Harry vowing to 'address' race claims

IN a rare intervention the Queen has offered an olive branch to Harry and Meghan but raised questions over their race claims.

The Palace issued a 61-word statement in response to the couple's bombshell TV interview, declaring "that while some recollections may vary" the "whole family is saddened" to learn of their "challenging last few years."

It added: "Harry, Meghan and Archie will always be much loved family members."

The hotly anticipated response to the Duke and Duchess of Sussex's interview by US chat show queen Oprah Winfrey came as sources said that the Prince of Wales was "deeply concerned" over racism claims.

Charles—who declined to discuss the crisis at an engagement on Tuesday—insisted they went against everything he stood for, and felt let down by Harry's claim that he cut him off.

One source said: "The Prince of Wales went out

of his way to make sure his son and daughter in law were financially supported."

Charles gave them funds from his investment portfolio after they quit royal duties and moved to the US.

On the racism claims, a source said: "It goes against everything the Prince of Wales believes in. He believes diversity is the strength of our society."

Palace aides issued the statement after two days of crisis talks over the fallout from Sunday's show, which included Meghan's claim that she had had suicidal thoughts and struggled to find help.

She also said one of the Royal Household upset her and Harry by expressing fears over the colour of their first child, Archie. The Duchess implied he was denied the title of prince as he

had brown skin.

The Queen's reaction was the latest attempt to pacify the couple after recent public bust-ups.

Royal insiders admitted it was designed to take pressure off the institution of the monarchy and to emphasize this was a family matter.

The Queen had wielded the axe as chief executive of The Firm to tell the Sussexes they could not be part-time working royals while making money in California. But as Windsor matriarch she stayed in close touch, trying to keep them in the fold despite rifts with the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge and with Prince Charles.

Aides said the family should be given the opportunity to discuss the issues among themselves.

They insisted they had wanted to consider

a response carefully and said two days of crisis meetings, said to have included the Queen, Charles, and Prince William, had let the public see the programme before the statement was issued.

Some of the Royal Household were fuming privately that the Sussexes had accused the family of racism and pointed to many inconsistencies in the couple's account.

They stressed the work that all the family had done to fight racism and to promote the multicultural

Commonwealth. They also argued that in their work and privately the family showed their belief in being open about mental health.

They were supported by former aides, one of whom said they had never seen any racism in the Royal Family. "For Meghan to have played the race card is just despicable," he added.

Former staff dismissed Meghan's implication about Archie, saying whether he would become a prince was governed by rules set out in 1917 by George V and was nothing to do

with his skin colour.

Senior advisers said it was risky to try to refute every allegation and it was better to stick to a general statement emphasizing that the Queen felt it was a family matter.

"The best thing is keep on the moral high ground and avoid engaging in a tit-for-tat war of words," said one source.

The tell-all interview with Oprah was the most-watched UK programme of 2021. More than 12million tuned in to ITV1 on Monday.

“No price on my son’s life”

■ Harry Mom’s fury at driver’s bid for soft sentence

HARRY Dunn’s mother insisted his alleged killer Anne Sacoolas must stand trial in the UK as the Justice Secretary rejected her offer of community service.

Harry, 19, was riding a motorcycle when he was hit by a car on the wrong side of the road outside RAF Croughton, Northants, in August 2019.

Amy Jeffress, the lawyer for American suspect Sacoolas, 43, said her client, who returned to the US claiming diplomatic immunity, has “never denied” responsibility for the crash.

But she said the charge pending in Britain against Sacoolas would not usually result in a prison sentence in the US.

She told Radio 4’s Law In Action: “We understand that community service is a typical sentence for offences like this.

“We have offered

ever since, over a year ago, that she would be willing to serve that kind of a sentence and to make a contribution in Harry’s memory, to take other steps to try to bring some peace to the family.”

Ms Jeffress said Ms Sacoolas is “truly sorry for Harry’s family and

the pain this has caused”. “She’s willing to meet with the family to provide whatever information they are seeking.”

Harry’s grief-stricken mother, Charlotte Charles, rejected the offer. She said: “There is no price on Harry’s life. I’m not willing to discuss

a contribution, whatever she may mean by that.

“She needs to go through the UK justice system. We all know diplomatic immunity is not there to cover somebody for killing a child in the way it happened and to be able to walk away.”

She said she made a

promise to her son to get justice on the night he died and “there are no circumstances at all under which I will break that promise”.

Justice Secretary Robert Buckland said: “Rather than talking about the sentence that would be appropriate, let’s deal with the

question of liability.

“At the moment there is an outstanding and very serious matter relating to the alleged driving of this person and the death of a young man.

“What we are trying to do is to actually go through due process and deal with the issue of criminal liability first.”

Royals ‘not a racist family’ insists William

The Duke of Cambridge has said the royals are “very much not a racist family” in his first comments after accusations by the Duke

and Duchess of Sussex in a TV interview.

Prince William also said he had not yet spoken to his brother but would do so.

Meghan and Prince Harry said a royal had expressed concern over “how dark” their son Archie’s skin might be.

Buckingham Palace previously said the claim was “concerning” but it would be addressed privately.

In a statement, the Palacesaid “recollections may vary” but that the Sussexes would “always be much loved family members”.

During a visit to a school in Stratford, east London, on Thursday, Prince William was asked by a reporter: “Is the Royal Family a racist family, sir?”

The duke replied: “We’re very much not a

racist family.”

Asked whether he had spoken to Prince Harry since the Oprah interview, Prince William said: “No, I haven’t spoken to him yet but I will do.”

Prince William’s visit is not the first appearance by a senior royal since the interview aired - the Prince of Wales carried out an engagement earlier this

week.

Buckingham Palace issued a response to the interview earlier this week following crisis meetings involving senior royals.

Figures from US TV network CBS suggest that nearly 50 million people around the world have watched Oprah’s interview with the couple, which aired on Sunday night.

Piers Morgan has stood by his criticism of Meghan Markle as it emerged she has complained to ITV about his comments.

It is understood Meghan made a formal complaint to the broadcaster over his repeated outbursts, just hours before his exit from Good Morning Britain.

The Duchess of Sussex is said to have insisted she was not upset that

Morgan said he "didn't believe a word she said" in her Oprah Winfrey interview.

But she complained that she was worried about how his comments could affect people attempting to deal with their mental health problems.

Meghan went directly to ITV chief executive Dame Carolyn McCall, who signed off on the

broadcaster's £1million deal to show the Oprah Winfrey interview.

Morgan is understood to have been ordered to apologize. But he refused and quit instead, saying he had the right to tell viewers his "honestly held opinions".

Asked about his comments on the interview, Dame Carolyn said: "I completely believe what she [Meghan] said. It's important everyone does." representatives for the Duchess have declined to comment.

But Morgan insisted he still did not believe her account of life with the royal Family and branded the Duchess "frankly contemptible".

'diatribe of bilge'

The presenter, 55, also said he was now "talking to people" and claimed he will soon be back on British TV screens following his GMB departure.

Leaving his west London home on Wednesday, he said: "I don't believe almost anything that comes out of her [Meghan's] mouth and I think the damage she's done to the British monarchy and to the Queen at a time when Prince Philip is lying in hospital is enormous and frankly contemptible.

"I believe in freedom of speech.

"I believe in the right to be allowed to have an opinion. If people want to believe Meghan Markle, that's entirely their right.

"If I have to fall on my sword for expressing an honestly held opinion about Meghan Markle and that diatribe of bilge that she came out with in

that interview, so be it.

"Although the woke crowd will think that they've cancelled me, I think they will be rather disappointed when I re-emerge."

Morgan described his departure from the ITV programme as "amicable", adding: "I had a good chat with ITV and we agreed to disagree.

"I'm just going to take it easy and see how we go. I would call it a temporary hibernation."

He added that he is "always in talks with people".

The star had left the flagship ITV breakfast show after a heated on air discussion about the Oprah interview with Prince Harry and Meghan

He also branded her "Princess Pinocchio"

after the Duchess said she was suicidal while five months pregnant and accused the Royal Family of racism.

At one point during the show weatherman Alex Beresford accused Morgan of unfairly "trashing" Meghan, branding him "diabolical".

He added: "I'm sorry but Piers just spouts off on a regular basis and we have to sit there and listen."

Morgan stormed off the set before quitting the show for good. His views have sparked more than 41,000 complaints to Ofcom.

His co-host Susanna Reid admitted the outspoken presenter's sudden departure would mean the show will be

"very different".

Ms Reid said: "Some of you may cheer and others may boo. It is certainly going to be very different but shows go on and so on we go."

Morgan later tweeted to his 7.8 million followers: "On Monday, I said I didn't believe Meghan Markle in her Oprah interview. I've had time to reflect on this opinion, and I still don't.

"If you did, OK. Freedom of speech is a hill I'm happy to die on.

"I'm off to spend more time with my opinions."

Morgan also shared a famous quote by Winston Churchill, which said: "Some people's idea of free speech is that they are free to say what they like, but if anyone else says anything back, that is an outrage."

Britons left stunned as police officer charged with murder

■ Kent cop linked with slaying of younger woman

THE BRITISH law and order establishment as rocked this week with the arrest of a diplomatic protection officer on suspicion of murder.

Wayne Couzens, 49, is the prime suspect in the murder of Sarah Everard, 33, who disappeared on March 3 as she walked home from a friend's house in Clapham, south London.

Mr Couzens was arrested on Tuesday night at his home in Deal on suspicion of kidnapping Miss Everard and further arrested the following day on suspicion of murder and also on suspicion of an unrelated indecent exposure allegation.

Several hours later Dame Cressida Dick, the Commissioner of the Metropolitan Police confirmed that human remains had been found in woodland in Kent.

The body has still not been identified and police have said it may take some time.

Former Durham

University student Ms Everard, who is originally from York, was wearing a green rain jacket, navy blue trousers with a white diamond pattern, and turquoise and orange trainers when she went missing.

In a statement, her family appealed for more information to "help solve this terrible crime".

"Sarah was bright and beautiful - a wonderful daughter and sister. She was kind and thoughtful, caring and dependable. She always put others first and had the most amazing sense of humour," they said.

"She was strong and principled and a shining example to us all. We are very proud of her and she brought so much joy to our lives."

Originally from Dover, Mr Couzens's family ran a garage and car body shop. He worked in the business along with his brother but they both left to pursue a career in policing and the garage closed down.

He first joined the Civil Nuclear Constabulary, where he underwent firearms training, working as part of the team protecting Dungeness Nuclear Power station close to where he lived in Kent.

But he later transferred to the Metropolitan Police, where he was able to use his firearms expertise to join the elite Diplomatic Protection Group.

Based in Westminster, the unit is tasked with protecting MPs and other dignitaries in and around the capital.

Neighbours in Deal described them as being the perfect family who doted on their two children.

Hairdresser Kerry Slade, 56, said she had last seen them on Monday when she spotted their young daughter in her uniform, ready for her first day back at school.

She said: "They are just a nice normal family. I think they moved in between three and five

years ago. I spoke to the woman whenever I passed the house as she was always very chatty.

"The last time I saw them was when I was walking the dog at about 8.30am on Monday and I saw the little girl in her school uniform.

"I know the man has had building stuff in his garden getting work done recently. He is a police officer. I saw him in his uniform. He was a biker and you'd often see him in the garage working on his motorbike."

Bafta chiefs salute most diverse ever gong nominations after all-white row

WOMEN directors and ethnic minorities have been thrust into the Baftas limelight after the film awards unveiled its most diverse list of nominees to date.

No fewer than four women are shortlisted for best director for films including road movie Nomadland and coming-of-age drama Rocks.

It follows criticism of a lack of diversity in last year's awards over the all-white acting nominees

and lack of female directors.

Organisers introduced a raft of changes including expanding the nomination slots for best director, actor and actress from five to six.

The contenders for the 2021 British Academy of Film and Television Arts awards, delayed due to the pandemic, were unveiled this week.

Krishnendu Majumdar, chair of Bafta, said: "After last year's nominations,

we started the Bafta review process with the intention of levelling the playing field and introduced a range of measures to ensure that all entered films were seen by our members and judged on merit.

"This year's nominations showcase and celebrate the remarkable range of performances and nominees behind the camera from 50 films and we're delighted to

recognise such high-quality work."

The outstanding British film category was expanded from six to 10 nominations. Contenders include The Dig, which stars Carey Mulligan and Ralph Fiennes, Calm With Horses, The Father, His House, Limbo, The Mauritanian, Promising Young Woman, Rocks and Saint Maud.

Among the nominations for best actor is Chadwick Boseman (above) who



received a posthumous nomination for his performance as a trumpeter in Ma Rainey's Black Bottom. He died at 43 from colon cancer last August.

Among others

nominated are Riz Ahmed, for his role as a drummer who loses his hearing in Sound Of Metal, and Sir Anthony Hopkins for The Father, about a man slipping into dementia.

A right royal ruckus!

A personal perspective by royal correspondent **SANDRO MONETTI**

"The Queen's favorite drink is a glass of gin & dubonnet. I expect she's already on her 4th or 5th of the night trying to blot out the memory of the damaging Meghan and Harry interview."

That's one of the fun lines I used on live television when covering the fallout from the explosive Oprah special.

As a royal correspondent, this has been a fascinating and busy few days reporting on the "War of the Windsors," which has so dominated global headlines.

I've been covering it for CNN as well as Fox 11 here in LA, Channel 4 News in the UK and various

British radio stations and try to make each broadcast informative and entertaining.

It's a tricky one though because public opinion is sharply divided and the issues raised in the bombshell interview are so troubling.

So the professional solution, at least as I see it, is to just fall back on your experience and knowledge of the royal family, who I've been covering on and off since the last years of Diana, to add insight about how it all got to this crisis point and where things go from here.

Full disclosure: I also represent the Queen's charity in America as a

Trustee of the California branch of the Royal Society of St George. But despite seemingly being on "Team Queen," there's much I admire about Harry and Meghan too and I was eager to hear what the California based couple had to say. The Oprah interview certainly lived up to the hype as they shared their personal pain while throwing verbal punches at the palace. As I said on TV, "If that was a boxing match, it would have been stopped to save the royal family from further punishment."

Two days later, under global pressure to respond, Her Majesty issued a carefully worded statement which started by saying the family was "saddened" by the interview. I thought, "Saddened? They're probably ready to unleash the corgis!"

By going on to say the issues raised, particularly that of race, were concerning and would be addressed privately, "The Firm" was clearly hoping to calmly shut things down for now. But this story will run and run.

It was interesting to read opinion polls after the interview showing that in Britain sympathies run largely along age lines with younger people supporting Meghan and Harry and older ones siding with the palace.

Here in the States there

seems great support for the Sussexes and Meghan's moving words tarnished and perhaps banished the princess myth, popular in America and long fueled by fairytales and classic Disney films, that marrying a prince is an automatic path to happiness. We only have to think back to Princess Diana's tragic story to see that was a flawed narrative.

My own royal reporting back in Britain started with covering Diana, who was uniquely special and adorable, and when she died I stepped away from the royal beat for a while, switching to showbiz reporting and that ultimately prompted my move to the world entertainment capital of Los Angeles.

Being back on the royal beat in recent years and



now covering this US TV special featuring one of Diana's sons has been a real time of reflection for me and it's sad to see the royal family so fractured.

"Time heals all wounds," Prince Harry said to Oprah. Let's hope he's right about that.

And best wishes to him and Meghan for the

upcoming birth of their daughter. I'll bet you they name her Diana.

Cavani headed for United exit

EDINSON CAVANI will quit Manchester United this summer after becoming disillusioned – and has already held talks with Boca Juniors.

In an explosive interview, the striker's dad, Luis Cavani, revealed the Uruguayan feels uncomfortable at United and wants to be closer to his family.

Cavani joined United on a £200,000-a-week deal in October after leaving Paris Saint-Germain on a free transfer. But the 34-year-old has made just nine league starts this season and was left out of the squad altogether for last Sunday's 2-0 win at derby rivals Manchester City.

United boss Ole Gunnar Solskjaer has been keen for Cavani to trigger the 12-month option in his deal and remain at United next season.

But in a clear dig at United, Cavani senior said the former Napoli ace wanted to "fight for something important" and revealed he had been left upset by the FA's decision to sanction him over an innocent message on social media that turned into a race row.

He said: "My son does not feel comfortable in England and wants to be close to the family again.

"Edinson is going to end up playing in South America. I want Edinson to play in a team that fights for something important.

"Edinson had many conversations with Boca vice-president Juan Roman Riquelme and he would like to play for Boca.

"He was always seduced by the idea of playing in Boca. By the middle of the year he will return to South America.

Cavani has scored seven goals this season under Solskjaer, but has drawn a blank in his past three appearances.

Rooney in awe of Gerrard aura

WAYNE ROONEY says Steven Gerrard's success a Rangers is no surprise because he has "an aura" about him.

Gerrard cracked Celtic's domination of the Scottish league by steering their fierce rivals to the title for the first time since 2011 at the weekend.

Reds back in old routine

■ Klopp's men cast aside domestic woes to cruise into CL quarter finals

LIVERPOOL may be in freefall domestically but it is onwards and upwards in the Champions League after Mo Salah and Sadio Mane struck twice in four second-half minutes to kill off RB Leipzig on Wednesday.

A quarter-final spot is theirs after the old firm rediscovered Liverpool's scoring touch following a profligate first half to complete their assignment against the well-beaten Germans.

It was a heartening night all round with a disciplined defensive performance enabling Jurgen Klopp's side to

progress with something to spare – quite the contrast to their Premier League woes.

The last eight is one round better than last season in Europe when they were eliminated by Atletico Madrid at the last-16 stage.

The return of Fabinho as protector-in-chief to the novice centre-back duo of Nat Phillips and Ozan Kabak was important with a two-goal lead from the first leg at the same Puskas Arena to defend.

This time the venue was nominally the home leg and the Brazilian and Thiago Alcantara controlled matters well

in midfield alongside Gini Wijnaldum, right, who was captain.

The tie could actually have been made safe by half-time.

Leipzig, second in the Bundesliga, had won four times since the first meeting but it was Liverpool who were much more threatening in the opening period.

Diogo Jota could have scored a hat-trick. Former Liverpool goalkeeper Peter Gulacsi made a fine save in the 19th minute as Jota's header from a corner powered goalwards.

Then Jota forced Gulacsi into another stop after a surging run

had taken him through Nordi Mukiele's tackle.

The best chance of all for the Portuguese with the last kick of the first half, blazing wide after Salah had pressurised Dayot Upamecano into knocking the ball straight into his path.

Salah was culpable too, wasting a fine chance from Thiago's spectacular through ball as Liverpool picked off the Germans on the break.

Liverpool had a scare when substitute Alexander Sorloth hit the bar with a stooping header in the 65th minute.

But five minutes later the Reds got what they deserved when Salah struck after their best move of the night.

A sweeping build-up from their own half involving some fine interplay saw Jota pick out Salah with the final pass and the Egyptian

danced inside on to his left foot to bury the ball in the bottom corner.

The first goal might not have materially altered the balance of the tie – Leipzig still needed to score three times to progress – but the second goal four minutes later did.

It was another sweet move which saw Mane put the ball away from substitute Divock Origi's cross from the right.

City back to winning ways

SIX more wins will deliver the title to Manchester City and on this form they will not need long to take it.

Pep Guardiola's men got back on track after defeat in the Manchester derby with a comfortable win 5-2 against Southampton on Wednesday.

Riyad Mahrez scored two goals and set up another, Kevin De Bruyne added two more and Ilkay Gundogan netted a fifth.

Yet, for all the comfort, this was a night which could have ended with red faces for referee Jon Moss and the VAR officials.

Despite City hammering five past a poor Southampton, one of the biggest talking points remained the failure to award them a clear penalty with the score 1-1.

Stockley Park and Moss had good cause to thank City for their reaction not

only in not being derailed but in the blizzard of goals which covered up their blunder.

Mahrez, who has been moving stealthily into top form over the past few weeks, posted his seventh and eighth Premier League goals in a stunning display.

This game had been brought forward from late April on account of it clashing with City's Carabao Cup final clash with Tottenham.
