# PILOT IMPLICATES ANDREW

## Ghislaine Maxwell Trial: Long-serving Epstein pilot testifies he flew Prince Andrew, Donald Trump and other VIPS to Epstein hideaways

**IN A worrying development for Prince Andrew, the former long-time pilot of paedophile financier Jeffrey Epstein has testified at the trial of Ghislaine Maxwell that he flew the Prince – among other VIPs - to luxury locations worldwide.**

Larry Visoski, the first witness in Ms Maxwell's sex-trafficking trial, recalled flying Prince Andrew, Bill Clinton, Donald Trump and Kevin Spacey.

Ms Maxwell denies the charges and says she is being used as a scapegoat for Epstein, who died in prison in 2019.

But prosecutors argue the pair were "partners in crime" in sex abuse.

Testimony given in court on Tuesday included harrowing details of the alleged abuse.

Ms Maxwell has been in a US jail since her arrest last year, and faces up to 80 years in prison if convicted.

Prosecutors say the British socialite, who also has US and French citizenship, recruited and groomed underage girls for her long-term companion Epstein to abuse.

Asked to describe Ms Maxwell's standing in Epstein's operations, Mr Visoski described her as "the number two".

"Epstein was the big number one," he told the New York court on Tuesday.

Mr Visoski served as Epstein's pilot for over 25 years. During his testimony, prosecutors showed the jurors photographs of Epstein's properties.

### "Lolita Express"

He testified that he had never seen any sexual activity during trips, although the cockpit door was always kept closed during flights on the plane nicknamed the "Lolita Express".

He also recalled flying Virginia Roberts Giuffre, who says she was sexually assaulted by Prince Andrew.

The Queen's 61-year-old second son has consistently denied the allegation.

Asked if he remembered Ms Giuffre, Mr Visoski said: "Yes. A shorter woman with dirty blonde hair. She didn't look young. I mean, whatever you decipher is the definition of young. But she was a

woman in my category."

Another woman testifying under the pseudonym "Jane" told the court that Ms Maxwell had frequently been in the room with her when she had sexual relations with Epstein while just 14 years old.

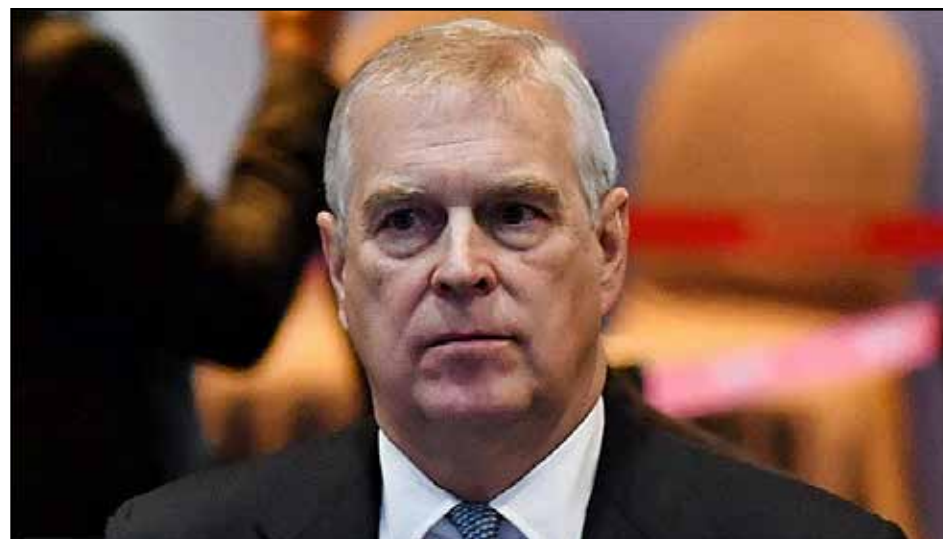
Jane told the court she had met Epstein and Ms Maxwell while attending summer camp in Michigan 1994. He was introduced to her as a wealthy donor who offered scholarships to pupils.

### 'orgies'

Epstein had promised to fund her education but instead abused her, prosecutors said. She testified that her father had died one year earlier from cancer and her family was struggling financially at the time.

In graphic detail, she described her alleged abuse and said that Ms Maxwell, who she said was present for much of it, was "very casual" about the encounters.

She added that she travelled with Epstein

and Ms Maxwell about 10 times, mainly between his homes in New York and New Mexico while she was between the ages of 14 and 16.

Jane also described "orgies" with other participants, and described feeling pain

during the alleged encounters.

Jane is the first of four accusers expected to testify at trial.

Ms Maxwell has pleaded not guilty to eight charges of sex trafficking and other crimes.

The allegations at trial cover the period 1994 to 2004. Prosecutors allege Ms Maxwell was a "right-hand" partner for Epstein, helping to groom vulnerable teenage girls as young as 14 for abuse at his luxurious residences.

# Starmers rapid reshuffle

■ Leader of the Opposition seeks to take advantage as floundering BoJo takes a hit in the polls

Labour leader Sir Keir Starmer launched a reshuffle of his shadow cabinet on Monday as he sought to capitalise on a bounce in the polls and questions over Boris Johnson's leadership.

To try and press home his advantage, Sir Keir carried out a shake up of his top team with former Work and Pensions Secretary Yvette Cooper returning to the Shadow Cabinet in a senior role.

Cooper has been appointed shadow home secretary.

A poll by Opinium earlier this month

showed the ruling Conservative Party had fallen behind Labour for the first time in a year, as the Prime Minister battled a rebellion from his own backbenchers over his handling of the Owen Paterson sleaze affair.

Since then Mr Johnson has been hit by further unrest over social care reforms and the HS2 rail project.

But Sir Keir's second reshuffle inside a year risked being overshadowed by tensions with Labour's Deputy Leader Angela Rayner who appeared to

be caught off-guard by the timing of the move.

Delivering a speech at the Institute for Government think-tank on Monday morning, on Labour's five point plan to shake up Parliamentary standards following the Paterson affair, Ms Rayner told journalists she was not aware of any reshuffle.

But Party officials have played down suggestions she was out of the loop, insisting that Ms Rayner had been briefed by Sir Keir prior to delivering her speech on standards.

Asked about reports

of the reshuffle, Ms Rayner said: "I've been concentrating on the job that I'm doing."

In the first major change, Jo Stevens confirmed she had

been moved from her current role as Shadow Culture Secretary to replace Llanelli MP Nia Griffith as shadow Welsh Secretary.

"It's been a privilege

to closely work with hugely talented people in the DCMS sector, the fastest growing before the pandemic & one of the hardest hit," she said on Twitter.

# MI6 boss warns of China 'debt traps and data traps'

■ Richard Moore outlines growing threat from Beijing and Moscow; denies fall of Kabul was intelligence failure

MI6 chief Richard Moore has warned of China's "debt traps and data traps" in his first live broadcast interview.

Mr Moore - known as "C" - told BBC Radio 4's Today programme these traps threatened to erode sovereignty and have prompted defensive measures.

He denied the fall of Afghan capital Kabul was an intelligence failure and

signalled closer ties with tech giants.

The decision to speak more openly about his work was important in a modern democracy, the ex-secret agent said.

In a wide-ranging interview before he gave his first major public speech since taking on the role as head of MI6, Mr Moore:

Warned China has the capability to "harvest data

from around the world" and uses money to "get people on the hook"

Admitted the assessment of the Taliban's progress in Afghanistan this summer was "clearly wrong" - but denied Kabul's fall was an "intelligence failure"

Described a "chronic problem" with Russia and Ukraine - with Russia posing an "acute threat" to the UK



China's growing military might is only part of their threat, said the MI6 chief

Supported closer links with technology partners and speeding-up the vetting process for new tech-savvy recruits

Speaking about the threat posed by China, Mr Moore described its use of "debt traps and data traps".

He said Beijing is "trying to use influence through its economic policies to try and sometimes, I think, get people on the hook".

Explaining the "data trap", he said: "If you

allow another country to gain access to really critical data about your society, over time that will erode your sovereignty, you no longer have control over that data.

"That's something which, I think, in the UK we are very alive to and we've taken measures to defend against."

Speaking later at the International Institute for Strategic Studies in London, Mr Moore said China was now "the single greatest priority"

for his agency and warned that a "miscalculation" by an over-confident regime in Beijing over an issue like Taiwan could pose a "serious challenge" to global peace.

He also said it was essential for Western countries to stand up to the "full spectrum" of threats from Moscow - from state-sanctioned attacks, such as the Salisbury poisoning, to using political proxies to undermine stability in the Balkans.



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# Barbados says goodbye to the Queen

■ Charles on hand as Caribbean island ditches monarch as head of state, becoming the world's newest republic

Barbados has officially removed Queen Elizabeth II as its head of state and become the world's newest republic.

In a ceremony in the capital, Bridgetown, this week, Dame Sandra Mason was sworn in as president.

The Prince of Wales and Barbadian singer Rihanna attended the event, which coincided with the country's 55th anniversary of independence.

In a speech, Prince Charles acknowledged the "appalling atrocity of slavery" the Caribbean island suffered.

The new era for Barbados ends Britain's centuries of influence, including more than 200 years when the

island was a hub for the transatlantic slave trade.

To signify the official change of power, a final salute was made to the British monarchy and the Royal Standard flag was lowered and replaced.

Speaking as the guest of honour at the event, Prince Charles reiterated the continuing ties between the two nations despite the constitutional status change.

## 'special place'

He described the moment as a new beginning before being awarded the prestigious Order of Freedom of Barbados by the new president.

The Queen sent the country her "warmest good wishes" for "happiness, peace and

prosperity in the future" and said the nation holds a "special place" in her heart.

Dame Sandra Mason, 72, the island's governor-general since 2018, was named as president-elect of the nation following a vote in parliament last month. She now replaces the Queen as the head of state.

"Vessel Republic Barbados has set sail on her maiden voyage. May she weather all storms and land our country and citizens safely on the horizons and shores which are ahead of us," she said after being sworn in.

Barbados announced its plan to become a republic last year, but it will remain within the Commonwealth.

Formerly known as the British Commonwealth, the Commonwealth of Nations is a loose association of former British colonies and current dependencies, along with some countries that have no historical ties to Britain.

Leading national figures, including Prime

Minister Mia Mottley, swore allegiance to Barbados in front of the new president at the ceremony, which lasted for several hours.

She later announced that pop star Rihanna would be named a national hero by President Mason.

The artist and

business woman, whose full name is Robyn Rihanna Fenty, was previously named an ambassador by her home country in 2018.

"May you continue to shine like a diamond and bring honour to your nation," Ms Mottley said, in reference to one of Rihanna's songs.

## Estranged Princes team up - remotely - for Diana awards

Princes William and Harry have united to honour the winners of an award named in memory of their mother.

The Duke of Cambridge and Duke of Sussex met winners of The Legacy Award from The Diana Award ahead of a glittering ceremony at the late princess's ancestral home Althorp next week.

William hosted 10 young recipients at Kensington Palace, while Harry met nine of the other 10 via videocall from California.

The royal brothers were both keen to be involved, joining forces for the first time since they unveiled a statue of Diana, Princess of Wales, on July 1.

They were last seen together as the bronze figure was revealed to the world in the Sunken Garden at Kensington Palace on what would

have been their mother's 60th birthday.

According to a source quoted in HELLO!: "Both brothers really wanted to take part and both were keen that it happened on the same day. It's a special award in memory of their mother and that still unites them despite everything that has happened."

Diana's brother, Lord Spencer, will host the 20 winners at a special ceremony at Althorp House, where the siblings grew up, on December 9.

Taking place every two years, The Legacy Award is the most prestigious accolade a young person can receive for their social action or humanitarian work. Princes William and Harry presented the inaugural Legacy Awards at St James' Palace in 2017.

This year's recipients come from across the UK, China, Colombia, Germany, India,

Indonesia, Saudi Arabia and the USA and were chosen from a pool of Diana Award winners from 2020 and 2021.

A judging panel chaired by Lord Spencer, and including HELLO!'s Editor-in-Chief Rosie Nixon, chose the winners to recognize their positive impact on society.

Each will now have access to a unique two-year development programme to help enhance their skills in leadership, community development, social entrepreneurship and technology for good.

The Diana Award's chief executive Tessy Ojo said: "The pandemic continues to disrupt lives and exacerbate social inequalities. But out of the darkness of Covid, young people are standing up to shape change in their communities across the world."

# Tributes flow as Sir Frank Williams dies at 79

■ Race car boss was pioneer in Formula One, enjoying decades of success

Tributes from across motor sport have been paid after the death of Sir Frank Williams, at the age of 79.

Williams founded the team that bore his name in 1977 and went on to enjoy enormous success in Formula One. His achievements have been recognised across the racing world after he died peacefully on Sunday.

Williams' team won

seven drivers' titles and nine constructors' championships. They took their first grand prix win in 1979 and under Williams' leadership as founder and team principal they were a dominant force in the 80s and 90s. From inauspicious beginnings in a warehouse in Didcot, Williams' fierce determination to compete and be victorious paid off

as he forged one of the most successful teams in F1 history.

Their driver champions alone reads as a roll of honour. Alan Jones secured their first title in 1980 and Keke Rosberg, Nelson Piquet, Nigel Mansell, Alain Prost, Damon Hill and Jacques Villeneuve all went on to take championships for Williams.

Alongside his co-founder and designer, Patrick Head, Williams built a team that competed at the very top of the sport for decades, overcoming the might of longstanding rivals such as Ferrari. Williams also overcame great personal tragedy when he was paralysed from the neck down after a car accident in 1986. Confined to a wheelchair he went on to lead his team with the same steely tenacity that characterized his whole career.

## 'truly special'

The seven-time world champion Lewis Hamilton summed up the respect and admiration felt for Williams. "Sir Frank Williams was one of the kindest people I had the pleasure of meeting in this sport," he wrote on Twitter.

"What he achieved is something truly special. Until his last days I know he remained a racer and a fighter at heart. His legacy will live on forever."

Williams devoted his life to F1, becoming the longest-serving team principal in the sport's history. He also endured the deaths of close friend and driver Piers Courage in 1970 and in 1994 that of Ayton Senna while driving a Williams at Imola. He was profoundly saddened by both events.

## Arsenal and Liverpool legend Ray Kennedy dies at 70

Ray Kennedy, the former Arsenal and Liverpool footballer, has died aged 70.

Kennedy, who played as a forward, won every domestic honour in the game with the two clubs during the 1970s and 80s.

He scored 148 goals in 581 appearances during a 15-year career in English professional football and also won 17 caps for England between 1976 and 1980, scoring three international goals for Don Revie's side.

He had been suffering from Parkinson's disease since the mid-eighties.

Born in Seaton Delaval, a former pit village in Northumberland, Kennedy turned professional for Arsenal in November 1968.

It did not take him long to make an impression and he helped Arsenal to win the Inter-Cities Fairs Cup in 1970 as well as the First Division and FA Cup double in 1970-71.

Kennedy also appeared as a second-half substitute in the 1972 FA Cup final, which Arsenal lost 1-0 to Leeds United, before moving to Liverpool for a club record £200,000 in July 1974.

Kennedy's new

manager Bob Paisley then converted him from a striker to a left-sided midfielder, with Liverpool going on to enjoy an extraordinary period of dominance in the English game.

During his time at Anfield Liverpool won the First Division five times, the European Cup three times and the UEFA Cup, UEFA Super Cup and League Cup once.

Kennedy also enjoyed spells at Swansea City, Hartlepool United and Cypriot side Pezoporikos Larnaca, whom he also managed.

In a statement, Liverpool said: "We are mourning legendary former player Ray Kennedy, who has passed away at the age of 70."

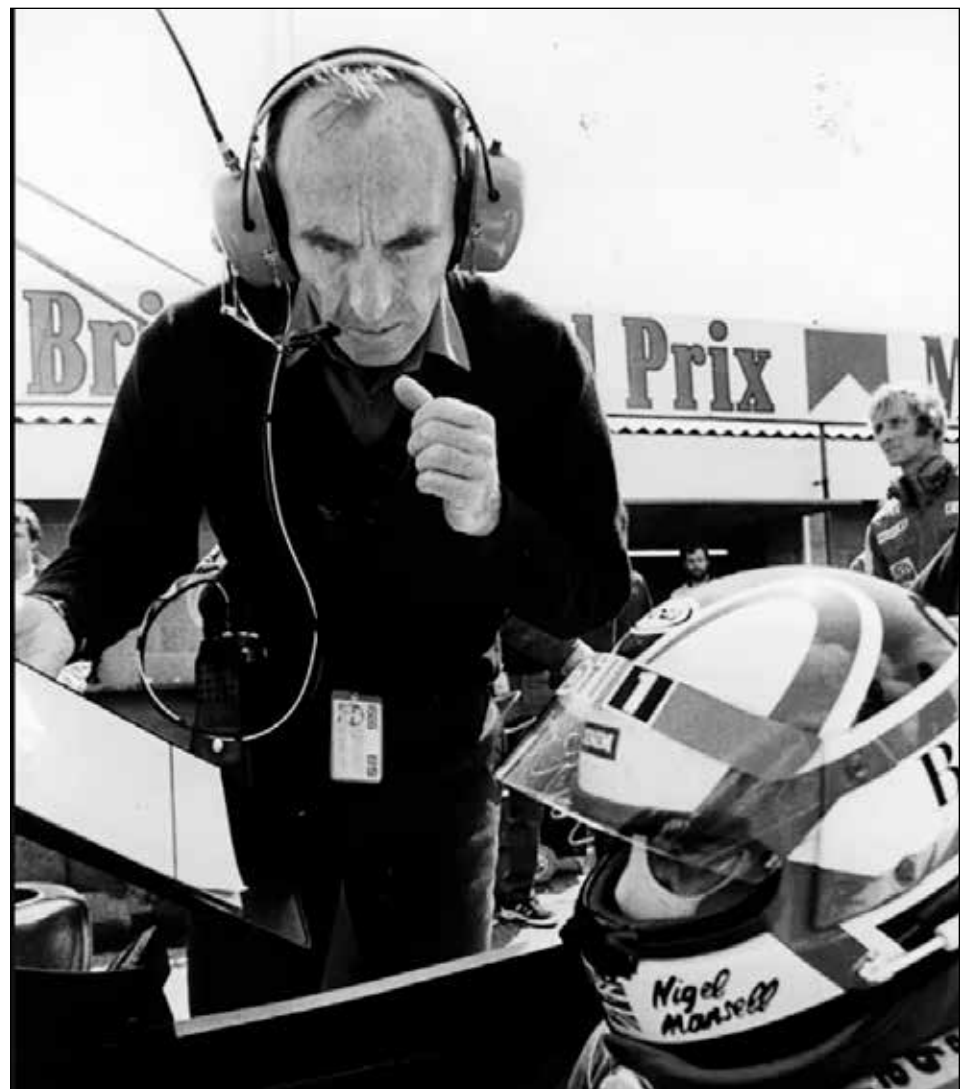
"The thoughts of everybody at Liverpool Football Club are with Ray's family and friends at this sad and difficult time."

The England football team said: "We are deeply saddened to learn of the passing of Ray Kennedy at the age of 70."

"All of our thoughts go out to his family, friends and former clubs."

Hill remained a great admirer of Williams despite being dropped by the team after winning his title in 1996. "He was just remarkable in every respect," Hill said. "His record will stand for a very long time. As a team founder, there won't be another one like him again."

The Williams team had endured harder times in recent years, fighting at

the back of the grid, while his daughter Claire had taken over day-to-day running in 2013. Yet her father's passion remained, his resolve and desire to compete as fierce as ever. He brought recognition and success to British racing with a record that is second only to that of Ferrari in F1 constructors' championships.

The three-time world champion Sir Jackie

Stewart acknowledged how important a role Williams had played in the industry. "We will miss him always. He was a great man for British motor sport and always did the right thing," he said.

"A great man and a very good team owner. I raced against him from time to time and he was a competitor of the highest level."

Veteran entertainer Tommy Steele discovered an unexpected new fan this week – Princess Anne.

The Princess Royal told him she 'knew all about' his career as she knighted him at Windsor Castle.

Sir Tommy, 84, said it was the 'highlight of the highlights' of his 65 years in showbusiness.

In the 1950s, he was considered Britain's first rock'n'roll star and teen pop idol, with hits including Singing The Blues earning comparisons to Elvis Presley.

He went on to star

Bermondsey, south-east London, in December 1936, was honoured for services to entertainment and to charity.

He said Princess Anne spoke to him about his career 'and she knew all about it', adding: 'It has been like a very important first night in the theatre.'

'It is like you are blessed by something that has been happening for centuries and then all

of a sudden, you find that as an actor you have got the part.'

Just four months before his first hit record, Rock With The Caveman (which he co-wrote with Lionel Bart), Steele, was a merchant seaman, travelling the world and teaching himself how to play a £1.50 guitar he'd bought from a fellow sailor.

His big break came in 1956 when, during shore leave, he was spotted singing and

playing Elvis's Blue Suede Shoes in a Soho coffee bar. He'd bought the sheet music weeks before in New York.

Days later, he was snapped up by record company Decca.

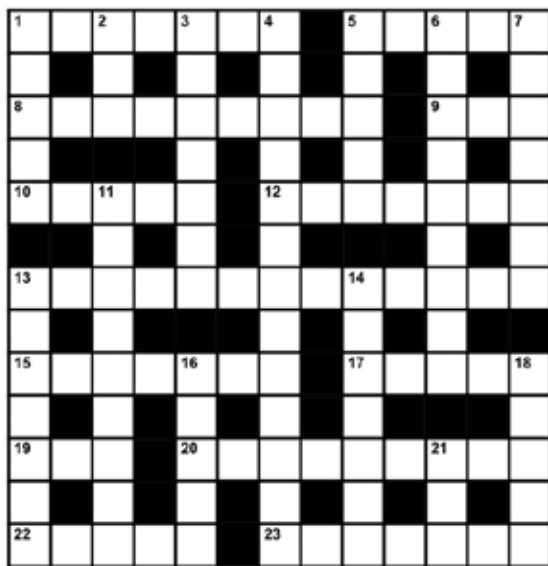
During his early days as a star, he ended up unconscious in Dundee Royal Infirmary after hundreds of fans bent his arm back and pulled out clumps of his hair in a frenzy.

He was made an OBE in 1980.

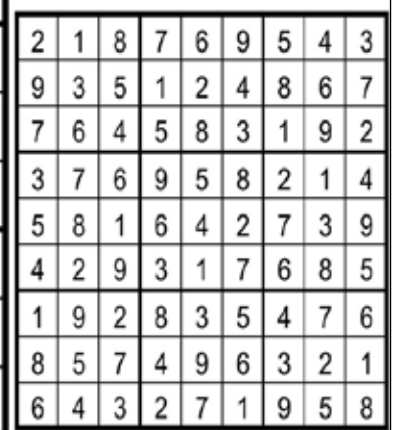

# The Larkins: you really shouldn't go back again

■ Now streaming on Acorn TV, this remake of a much-loved classic is not worth your time, says Nick Stark

WAS IT really 30 years ago that Catherine Zeta-Jones burst into the nation's TV consciousness as Mariette in *The Darling Buds of May*?

We've all passed a lot of water since then, as a funny man once said, but even now the landmark TV show, which also starred David Jason as Pop Larkin, the rascally head of a tight-knit postwar English family, retains a strong nostalgic pull, doubly so because the series itself was a glorious evocation of 1950s England.

Unfortunately we British are no more immune to the remake and sequel-itis that has gripped Hollywood for far too long – as *The Larkins*, a recent new offering from ITV, so depressingly proves.

The show has just become available on the streaming service Acorn TV, and this past

weekend we binge watched the show...and wished we hadn't.

The new Pop Larkin, Bradley Walsh, claimed in an interview that his new adaptation of the HE Bates classic is just what society needs in a time of strife, but let's face it, if the Larkins were around today the family would be under the watchful eye of social services (boy driving truck?), Pop would be exposed by the BBC as a Rogue Trader, and the village would be in the grip of a vicious planning dispute.

Joanna Scanlan is better as Ma than Walsh is as Pa, and as Mariette, Sabrina Bartlett looks good in a pair of jodhpurs but, as one British critic put it, "any actress trying to follow CZJ is on a hiding to nothing."

There are a few new plot twists; most notably Mariette's yearning for a new life in Paris,

along with a lovestruck younger Larkin having her heart broken by a funfair attendant and Pop playing tricks on both a snooty local and a couple trying to buy a second home. It's mildly interesting but hardly diverting and without any real depth or texture. Thoroughly weak tea, in fact.

Then there's the nod to modern sensibilities with the updated cast to reflect our multi-racial modernity. Instead of an all-white Kent village, decidedly post war, pre-Suez, we have instead a racially diverse utopia. An Indian brigadier and headteacher, an Asian postman, a black shopkeeper, house buyer and man from the tax office. It can't be color-blind casting because all of the Larkins are white. Instead, we're asked to believe that the locals don't bat an eyelid at an Indian woman running

a village school in 1958, when Britain didn't get its first black headteacher until 1969.

One senses the backers of this regrettable exercise into sepia-tinted faux nostalgia

could have better spent their money on a gritty, relevant, multi-racial urban crime drama. At least then the casting would have fit the milieu and there would have been no sense of a

clumsy shoe-horning of modern sensibilities into what is best remembered – and told – as a period piece.

Sadly for Acorn, this is one seed that will never grow into a mighty oak.

■ Ageless Portuguese striker writes himself into the record books as Carrick signs off with a win

**Cristiano Ronaldo scored his 800th career goal before driving home a penalty winner as Manchester United came from behind to beat Arsenal in a memorable contest featuring two crucial VAR decisions.**

As new United interim boss Ralf Rangnick watched from the directors' box, where former England captain David Beckham also enjoyed a thrilling encounter, Arsenal scored first in controversial circumstances.

Emile Smith Rowe drove home from the edge of the area, while United keeper David de Gea was lying on the ground, seemingly injured, with his back to play.

The inevitable VAR check concluded De Gea had fallen after bumping into and being trodden on by his own team-mate Fred, and referee Martin Atkinson gave the goal.

Bruno Fernandes levelled, when he finished off an intricate move involving Jadon Sancho and Fred a minute

before the break, setting up the pulsating second half that followed.

Ronaldo put United ahead as he swept home Marcus Rashford's cross, but Martin Odegaard made it 2-2 with a well-taken equaliser.

Then came the second big VAR decision, as Atkinson gave United a penalty after reviewing Odegaard's challenge on Fred on a pitchside monitor - and Ronaldo kept his nerve to score.

Watching proceedings unfold, Rangnick was largely impassive and made plenty of notes, although he did stand to applaud Ronaldo's winner.

The result leaves United three points off fourth-placed Arsenal after recording two wins and a draw under Michael Carrick, the interim's interim.

Carrick, stand-in for the past three matches, said afterwards that he was leaving the club, where he has been since 2006, first as a player and latterly as a coach
