



BoJo launches 'largest ever' sanctions on Russia

■ British PM sets out wide-ranging new measures against Moscow in wake of invasion of Ukraine

Boris Johnson has said it is time to “squeeze Russia from the global economy, piece by piece,” as he announced a wide-ranging sanctions package against Moscow, including freezing the assets of all major Russian banks and banning hi-tech exports.

“Putin will stand condemned in the eyes of the world and of history: he will never be able to cleanse the blood of Ukraine from his hands,” the prime minister told MPs on Thursday as he announced the swingeing package of measures.

Pointing to sharp declines in Russian stock markets and the value of the rouble since the invasion of Ukraine, Johnson said, “we will continue on a remorseless mission to squeeze Russia from the global economy piece by piece, day by day and week by week.”

He had earlier tried and failed to convince fellow G7 leaders to shut Russia out of the Swift global payments system, though his spokesperson said he would continue to press the issue in the coming days.

Johnson announced 10 measures the UK was taking immediately. The assets of all major Russian banks in the UK will be frozen, including VTB, the country’s second largest bank with assets totalling £154bn.

Individual sanctions will be imposed on over 120 individuals, entities and subsidiaries, including Rostec, the country’s biggest defence company, which exports £10bn in arms a year, as well as four other defence companies.

‘persona non grata’

Legislation is expected to be tabled next week to ban major Russian companies from raising finance on UK markets and to prevent Moscow from raising sovereign debt in London.

Oligarchs who will be sanctioned include Putin’s former son-in-law

Kirill Shamalov, Russia’s youngest billionaire; Denis Bortnikov, the deputy chair of VTB Bank’s management board; and Yury Slyusar, the director of the United Aircraft Corporation. The Russian airline Aeroflot will be banned from landing in the UK.

A diplomatic source said: “These are people who have international lifestyles. They come to Harrods to shop, they stay in our best hotels when they like, they send their children to our best public schools, and that is what’s being stopped.

“So that these people are essentially persona non grata in every major western European capital in the world. That really bites.”

The UK will suspend and prohibit all dual-use export licences to Russia, which covers items that could have civilian or

military use. There will also be legislation to prohibit a wide range of hi-tech exports to Russia, including semiconductors, aircraft parts such as Rolls Royce jet engines, and oil refinery equipment.

Number 10 said it would set out more detail in the coming days about new legislation to limit the deposits that all Russian nationals can hold in UK bank accounts to £50,000, intended to choke off the ability of Russians to raise finance and keep their money in London.

The measures will also apply to Belarus, which Russian forces have used to invade Ukraine.

The government will also bring forward the economic crime bill, before Easter recess, aimed at making assets more transparent.

Labour leader Keir Starmer said his party would support the measures, saying the public would face “economic pain,” as a result, but “the British public have always been willing to make sacrifice to defend democracy on our continent and we will again”.

Johnson had faced criticism from across the political spectrum earlier this week for introducing sanctions that many MPs,

including in his own party, felt were too weak.

Responding to Johnson’s statement on Thursday, former prime minister Theresa May said “every possible economic sanction” should be levied on Russia so it “absolutely feels the cold wind of isolation” and understood it had become a “pariah state”.

Some Conservative MPs called for the UK to increase military aid to Ukraine, including the former cabinet minister David Davis, who said the UK should consider providing air support to the Ukrainian armed forces.

Nation urged to put 'darkest days' in the past as Covid restrictions finally lifted

■ All UK's domestic Covid curbs abolished this week

Boris Johnson has urged the nation to put the "darkest days" of Covid behind them and grasp their new-found freedoms with renewed confidence.

Announcing his plan to axe lockdown laws and "restore liberties in full", the Prime Minister on Monday said it was time to learn to live with the virus and for Britons to continue to protect themselves without restrictions.

But he gave a sobering warning saying it was too soon to declare victory over Covid as worse variants loom."

At a Downing St press conference this week, the PM urged the country to bounce back "after two of the darkest, grimmest years in our peacetime history".

He said: "I would encourage people to get back to work with confidence. We have the right now, we have the grounds now, to be confident.

"The sun is shining, but we are keeping our umbrella. We are going to make sure we invest in

surveillance. We want to have the keenest eyes in the crow's nest to watch out for the iceberg which is a new variant."

But Chief medical officer Sir Chris Whitty warned that the Omicron wave was "still high".

He said: "The rates are coming down but this is still a very common infection.

"Some of those new variants will just disappear, but some of them will cause us significant problems."

Speaking to the Commons two days before all domestic legal restrictions ended on Thursday, the PM declared: "It is time to get our confidence back. We don't need laws to compel people to be considerate of others.

"We can rely on that sense of responsibility towards one another, providing practical advice in the knowledge that people will follow it to avoid infecting loved ones and others.

"So let us learn to live with this virus and continue protecting

ourselves without restricting our freedoms.

"We have emerged from the teeth of the pandemic before many others, retaining one of the most open economies and societies in Europe and the fastest growth in the G7 last year.

"And while the pandemic is not over, we have passed the peak of the Omicron wave, with cases falling, and hospitalisations in England now fewer than 10,000 and still falling.

"Today is not the day we can declare victory over Covid, because this virus is not going away.

"But it is the day when all the efforts of the last two years finally enabled us to protect ourselves while restoring our liberties in full.

"And after two of the darkest, grimmest years in our peacetime history, I do believe this is a moment of pride for our nation and a source of hope for all that we can achieve in the years to come."

The Government on Wednesday unveiled a four-part Living With

Covid Plan. The key points are: Removing domestic restrictions while continuing to publish public health advice in common with long-standing ways of managing infectious illnesses.

Secondly, protecting the vulnerable through pharmaceutical interventions and testing.

Maintaining resilience against future variants will also be vital, including thorough ongoing surveillance, contingency planning and the ability to reintroduce key capabilities such as mass vaccination and testing in an emergency. Investing in scientific research is also key.

In a statement to MPs, the PM said Britons could "protect ourselves without losing our liberties".

He pointed out that the Queen's recent infection showed the virus is still present. Mr Johnson added:

"It is a reminder that this virus has not gone away, but because of the efforts we have made as a country over the past two years we can now deal with it in a very different way, moving from government restrictions to personal responsibility."

He dismissed calls from the opposition and various scientists for some restrictions to stay in place because the disease is still circulating.

He told MPs: "Covid will not suddenly disappear. So those who would wait for a total end to this war before lifting the remaining regulations would be restricting the liberties of the British people for a long time to come."

Queen catches Covid ...but keeps on working

BY her own workaholic standards, the Queen had an easy week while self-isolating after contracting Covid.

But according to courtiers, Her Majesty took this latest setback in her stride by continuing to work.

Although she had no formal meetings planned at Windsor Castle, the 95-year-old monarch spent much of the week going through her red boxes of official papers.

She also took a phone call with Boris Johnson and conducted virtual audiences with foreign ambassadors from her laptop while sitting alone in a room at the castle for at least a couple of days.

The monarch, who will be 96 in April, has been triple vaccinated and is said to have mild, cold-

like symptoms. Doctors are monitoring her closely as experts warn most cases start with mild symptoms and anyone in their mid-90s needs to be watched carefully in case it gets worse.

Buckingham Palace officials will not discuss her treatment but it is likely she is on anti-viral drugs.

The palace has said she will follow all Government guidelines after testing positive on Sunday.

Until Covid restrictions are lifted she will make do without dressers and a hairdresser to help her prepare for those planned video meetings.

For some company she has her dogs with her – the elderly Candy, corgi puppy Muick and Lissy, another corgi.

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Chelsea owner linked to Russian state and 'corrupt activity', claims Labour MP

■ Labour's Chris Bryant says UK should seize Roman Abramovich's assets as he tells MPs allegations are from leaked 2019 Home Office document

The Chelsea owner, Roman Abramovich, was identified by the Home Office in 2019 as having links to the Russian state as well as to "corrupt activity and practices", a Labour MP has told parliament, suggesting the UK should seize his assets and bar him from owning the football club.

Chris Bryant told MPs he was quoting from a Home Office document leaked to him, and asked why nothing more had been done about Abramovich's UK assets given this official verdict.

Raising the issue of tier 1 visas, the sort held by Abramovich, which allow very rich people to invest in the UK, Bryant directly quoted a section of what he said was the Home Office document.

"I've got hold of a leaked document from 2019, from the Home Office,

which says in relation to Mr Abramovich: 'As part of HMG's (Her Majesty's Government) Russia strategy aimed at targeting illicit finance and malign activity, Abramovich remains of interest to HMG due to his links to the Russian state and his public association with corrupt activity and practices,'" Bryant told the Commons.

He went on, still quoting the document: "An example of this is Abramovich admitting in court proceedings that he paid for political influence. Therefore HMG is focused on ensuring individuals linked to illicit finance and malign activity are unable to base themselves in the UK, and will use the relevant tools at its disposal, including immigration powers, to prevent this."

Bryant added: "That's

nearly three years ago. And yet remarkably little has been done. Surely Mr Abramovich should no longer be able to own a football club in this country? Surely we should be looking at seizing some of his assets, including his £150m home, and making sure that other people who have had tier 1 visas like this are not engaged in malign activity in the UK?"

worsening links

Abramovich, who made his fortune acquiring newly privatized Russian oil assets following the end of the Soviet Union, bought Chelsea in 2003 and has put enormous sums into the club.

In 2018 he withdrew his application for a new UK investor visa, amid worsening links between the UK and Russia. Abramovich has an Israeli

passport and has since travelled to the UK using that.

A week ago the government said it was ending the tier 1 visa system over concerns it allowed people to invest "dirty money" in the UK.

On Tuesday, speaking to the Commons as he announced a first wave of measures against Russia over its invasion of Ukraine, Boris Johnson

said Abramovich was "already facing sanctions" because of links to the Russian state. However, Downing Street later said the prime minister had made an error, and formally corrected the record.

Abramovich has vehemently disputed reports suggesting his alleged closeness to Vladimir Putin and Russia or that he has

done anything to merit sanctions being imposed against him.

Bryant cannot be sued for quoting the report and its claims about Abramovich, as statements in the Commons are protected by parliamentary privilege.

Abramovich's representatives refused to comment on Mr. Bryant's claims.

Record number of million-pound homes in UK

A HOUSING boom caused by a demand for home working means a record one in 42 homes in the UK is now worth £1million or more.

Those who fled London and other cities to buy a property in the suburbs and countryside have pushed up prices in

the past year.

Estate agents Savills says a record 689,168 homes are now in the £1million plus bracket – 2.4 per cent of all housing. About eight in 10 of these are outside London, compared to just eight per cent in the capital, which saw the

smallest growth of any region.

'turbo-charged'

Numbers rose by 63 per cent in Wales, 49 per cent in the East Midlands and 36 per cent in the South-east. Elmbridge in Surrey has the greatest concentration

of £1million-plus homes outside London, with 37 per cent of its properties in this price bracket.

Savills said low interest

rates and the stamp duty holiday "turbo-charged" a buyer exodus.

Meanwhile, Rightmove data has

revealed that March is the best month to sell a home, as buyer competition is strongest then.

Venables in bid for freedom

Killer Jon Venables is expected to launch a new bid for freedom.

Venables, 39, hopes his application will be handed to the Parole Board as early as April.

A hearing could take place in the autumn.

He and Robert

Thompson were 10 when they murdered two-year-old James Bulger on Merseyside in 1993.

A legal order bans the media from publishing any details about their new names or their whereabouts.

Thompson has been law-abiding since release on licence in 2001 but Venables has twice been recalled to jail, in 2010 and 2017, for child sex offences. On the last occasion, he was found to have 1,200 images of children being abused.

UK social media users could get power to block unverified accounts

Social media users could be cut off from other accounts on platforms such as Twitter if they do not sign up for ID verification, under new government proposals to tackle anonymous trolls.

Popular services including Twitter, Facebook and Instagram will be required to give users the option to opt in or opt out from receiving messages, replies and content from unverified or anonymous accounts. Verified users could also block unverified or anonymous accounts from seeing their content under the opt in/opt out proposals.

This means people or organisations without verified accounts – symbolised by a blue tick on Twitter and Instagram – would be blocked from communicating with, or being seen by, accounts that have opted out from interactions with

unverified sources.

The new system will be introduced under the online safety bill, which requires tech firms to protect users from harmful content or face the threat of substantial fines imposed by Ofcom, the communications regulator.

The culture secretary, Nadine Dorries, said: “Tech firms have a responsibility to stop anonymous trolls polluting their platforms.” She added: “People will now have more control over who can contact them and be able to stop the tidal wave of hate served up to them by rogue algorithms.”

The ID move was welcomed by the Football Association, which has called for action against racist and abusive online trolls who often operate anonymously.

Dame Helen: I still suffer from imposter syndrome

■ Ahead of landmark SAG award, veteran actress reveals surprising insecurities

With a wealth of memorable roles, an Oscar and numerous Baftas, she has more than secured her place as one of Britain’s greatest actresses.

But Dame Helen Mirren, 76, says that in spite of her massive achievements, she still suffers from “imposter syndrome” – not believing her own worth and fearing that she will one day be “found out”.

Some 56 years after she first trod the boards – and just a week before she is given a Lifetime Achievement Award by Kate Winslet at the LA Screen Actors Guild – the actress spoke of her continued insecurity.

Dame Helen said: “I think of myself as still being the way I was in my mind, in my body, through my 20s, 30s and 40s – struggling, ambitious, frustrated and self-critical.”

And revealing her continued insecurity about her abilities, she added: “There’s always that endless, niggling feeling: ‘Oh God, I’m going to be found out any minute. I got away with it that time, but the next time...’”

“Because you can never be absolutely sure that you’re that good.”

Next weekend, Dame Helen will add to the scores of accolades she

has won – including an Oscar, a Tony and an Olivier Award for playing the Queen on stage in London and on Broadway, as well as a clutch of awards for Prime Suspect – when she receives the lifetime achievement award.

The guild’s president, Fran Drescher, said: “She has set the bar very high for all actors and, in role after role, she exceeds even her own extraordinary

performances.”

But the actress herself played down such praise, saying: “I genuinely do not feel I remotely deserve it, except that I’m still alive and working.”

“I’ve done some wonderful films and I’ve done some pretty awful films. It took me by surprise, completely.”

Dame Helen returned to the big screen this week with the UK opening of *The Duke*, in which she stars opposite

Jim Broadbent. The movie tells the true story of Kempton Bunton, a retired bus driver who in 1961 apparently stole a Goya portrait of the Duke of Wellington from the National Gallery in protest at the Government’s lack of help for pensioners.

“The Duke has the feeling of those wonderful Ealing comedies,” Dame Helen said, describing it as being in her top 10 pieces of work.

A Whiter Shade Of Pale singer Gary loses cancer battle at 76

PROCOL Harum singer Gary Brooker, who helped create mournful sixties classic *A Whiter Shade of Pale*, has been lauded for his talent, wit and decency by heartbroken fans.

The rocker, (pictured, right) who died at 76 from cancer on Saturday, shot to fame with the 1967 hit, famed for its organ intro.

A Whiter Shade of Pale topped the charts for six weeks and reached

number five in the US Billboard Hot 100.

The track, which Brooker wrote with Keith Reid and Matthew Fisher, and on which he played keyboard, is one of the defining songs of the 1960s, selling more than 10 million copies.

It has been covered more than 1,000 times and featured at the beginning of cult classic 1987 film *Withnail and I*, starring Richard E Grant. The song was named

joint winner alongside Queen’s *Bohemian Rhapsody* as Best British Pop Single of the last 25 years at the Brit Awards in 1977.

Procol Harum were formed in 1967 in Southend, Essex. London-born Brooker – who was also a prize-winning angler, pub owner, painter and inventor – was the band’s only continuous member.

The band’s website said: “*A Whiter Shade of*

Pale is widely regarded as defining *The Summer of Love*.”

“Gary’s voice and piano were the single defining constant of Procol’s 50-year international concert career.”

“Without any stage antics or other gimmicks he was invariably the most watchable musician in the show.”

The multi-instrumentalist, who got an MBE in 2003, married au pair Françoise



“Franky” Riedo, in 1968.

The band said: “His mordant wit, and appetite for the ridiculous, made him a priceless raconteur.

And his surreal inter-song banter made a fascinating contrast with the gravitas of Procol Harum’s performances.”

On the Buses star Anna, 85, dies in London house blaze

STUNNED celebrities and friends of *On The Buses* and *EastEnders* star Anna Karen have paid tribute to the actress who has died in a house fire aged 85.

Firefighters battled the blaze for an hour after neighbours spotted smoke pouring from Anna's front door on Tuesday night.

Singer Cheryl Baker said: "I have just heard the awful news that my fabulous mate, Anna Karen, has died in a house fire.

"What a horrific way to die, I can't bear to think about it. I adored her. She was an absolute treasure."

Anna (pictured, right) was best known for playing Olive Rudge in the hit 1970s sitcom *On The Buses*.

She joined *EastEnders* in 1996 as Aunt Sal, the sister of Peggy Mitchell, played by her close pal, the late Dame Barbara



Windsor, who died in December 2020. They first met in 1969, on the set of *Carry On Camping*.

South African-born Anna moved to London as a teenager. Early in her career, she was a striptease dancer. The actress hit the big time as dowdy conductress

Olive alongside Michael Robbins as her grumpy husband, Arthur.

She was married to actor and comedian Terry Duggan, from 1967 until his death in 2008. The Fire Brigade is probing the blaze at her Ilford, east London, home. It is not thought to be suspicious.

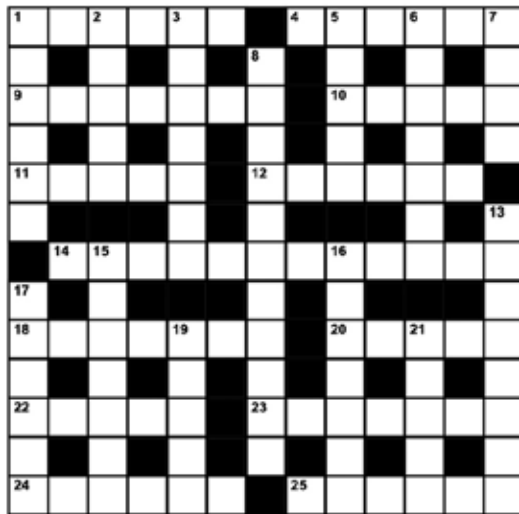

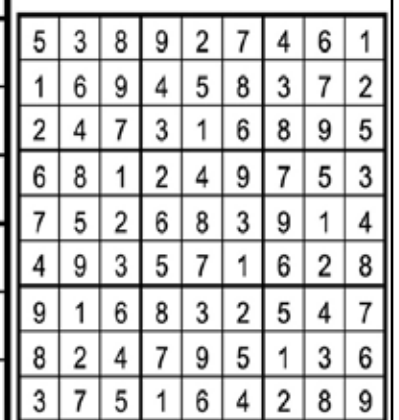

What A Braw Burns Night!

One of the benefits of being on the BritsinLA newsletter distribution list is you get to hear of events coming up in our backyard.

On last month's newsletter we heard about and registered for a televised showing of 'Hell's Kitchen' with Gordon Ramsey, and we got to hear of the St. Andrews Society of Los Angeles (saintandrewsla.org).

My wife and I are not Scottish, (having both being born in central England) but we were delighted to have come across the St. Andrews Society and to learn it was first founded during colonial times, with the fundamental purpose to advance charitable and cultural causes within the ambiance of Scottish heritage. The

first chapter was founded in Charleston, South Carolina in 1729. Right here in the City of Angels, our chapter was founded in 1930. Membership is open to anyone who is Scottish by birth, by heritage, or by inclination.

As an Englishman I must admit I knew little of Robert Burns when we decided to attend last week's supper to celebrate his life and works at the beautiful Fairmont Miramar Hotel and Bungalows in Santa Monica. At school in middle-England we studied the works of St. John Betjeman, Billy Shakes (of course) and a little Laurie Lee - but our minds weren't stretched across the border to Scotland.

But here are 10 facts that popped up during what was indeed a *braw*, (which I came to understand means "nice, brilliant or

fantastic) evening, that was had by all:

Did you know that Robbie was only 37 when he left this mortal coil? He crammed a lot of life into his 37 years as you'll see below.

He was widely regarded as the national poet of Scotland.

The only time he wrote in English was when he was making blunt political or civil commentary - his discourse would make a Facebook rant today look tame.

Rabbie as he was more familiarly known was regarded as the pioneer of the Romantic movement and after his death, became a great inspiration to the founders of liberalism and socialism.

He was the author of "Auld Lang Syne". This was a shocker to me.

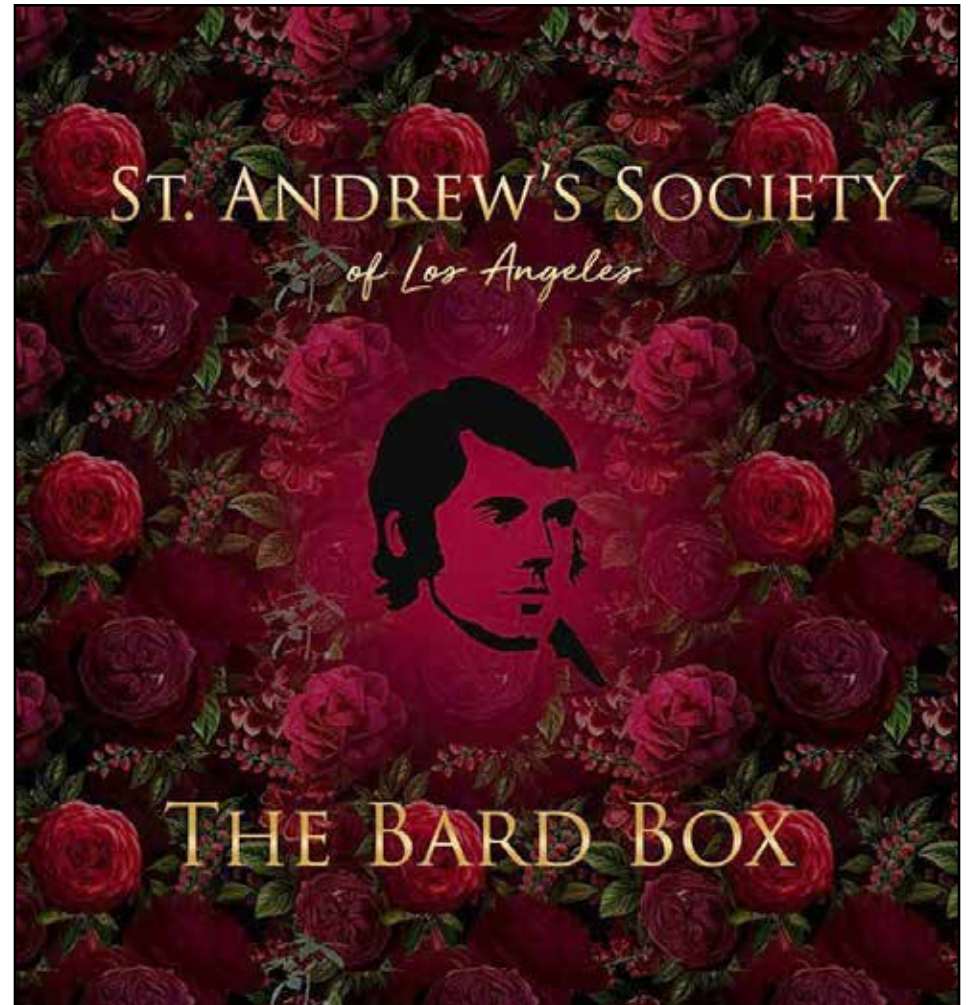
Ignorantly, I never knew he wrote a poem titled, "Tam O'Shanter" which is obviously where that wonderful restaurant and bar in Los Feliz got its name.

He got much of his early education from his father who also wrote for him and his siblings, A Manual of Christian Belief which based on many of Robert's later shenanigans, I'm not convinced he referred back to that manual very often.

Burns was also a writer of songs and enthusiastically contributed "about 200 songs" to The Scots Musical Museum. Interestingly, the Beatles also wrote "about 200 songs". I wonder if Robert would have been the fifth Beatle if the timing was right?

He died on July 21, 1796 and was buried on the day his son Maxwell was born - one can only imagine the mixed emotions on that sad and wonderful day.

Another record for mighty Mo

Mohamed Salah is running out of records to beat at club level, as the Egyptian set another Premier League landmark in Liverpool's midweek hammering of Leeds United.

The 29-year-old scored twice and set up another goal in Wednesday's 6-0 victory over the Whites, taking him to 160 goal involvements in the English top flight and a new record for an African player.

That figure, comprising 116 goals and 44 assists, means Salah has beaten the previous tally set by former Chelsea and Ivory Coast striker Didier Drogba.

Remarkably Salah, who has been Liverpool's top goalscorer in each of his four seasons at the club, has achieved this feat in 72 fewer games than Drogba.

Salah is now 27th in the

all-time Premier League goal involvement list, but almost halfway to Alan Shearer's record of 324.

The Liverpool forward leads this season's scoring charts with 19 league goals - seven more than second-placed teammate Diogo Jota despite missing two games while on international duty at the Africa Cup of Nations.

Pharaohs captain Salah moved to Anfield in June 2017 and last Saturday he became the 10th player to score 150 goals in all competitions for Liverpool.

He reached that total in just 233 appearances, with only former England World Cup winner Roger Hunt doing so faster than him in the early 1960s.

Salah lifted the Premier League title with Liverpool in 2019-20, and the win over Leeds helped the Reds

move three points behind league leaders Manchester City as they bid to regain it.

Back in October, Salah overtook Drogba and became the top-scoring African in Premier League history, and fellow Liverpool forward Sadio Mane has also now surpassed the Ivorian.

Mane, 29, also netted twice against Leeds, and the Senegalese moved on to 106 goals - two more than Drogba in two fewer games.

Mane's Senegal beat Salah's Egypt in the Nations Cup final earlier this month, and the two players will face each other in March in a two-legged play-off for a place in the 2022 World Cup.

Before that, the pair will aim to add another trophy to Liverpool's cabinet when they face Chelsea on Sunday in the League Cup final.

Gunners edge closer to top four

An own goal from Wolves goalkeeper Jose Sa helped Arsenal complete a dramatic late turnaround on Thursday in their pursuit of a top-four Premier League place.

The Gunners edged a game Wolves side, 201, but for long periods Hwang Hee-chan's early effort had looked like being decisive for the visitors.

However, Arsenal substitute Nicolas Pepe levelled from Eddie Nketiah's pass towards the end of a dominant second period in which the hosts had continually pressed for an equaliser.

And as the clock ran down Alexandre Lacazette's effort was inadvertently touched into his own goal by Sa to spark wild celebrations inside the Emirates stadium.

The result sees Mikel

Arteta's side move up to fifth in the table, just one point behind fourth-placed Manchester United, with two games in hand, while Wolves who were hoping to further their own Champions League ambitions sit in seventh.

"We don't know today how important this will be but we know the importance of winning our matches," said Arsenal manager Mikel Arteta, who is aiming to guide his team back into Europe's elite club competition for the first time in five years.

"At the end of May we want to be fighting for those places. After three defeats in the first three games we had to avoid relegation.

"Then we took it game by game and don't lose sight of the objective with the team. You just have to be consistent with your

vision and the way you prepare and believe the result will come."

Bruno Lage's side had gone into the contest searching for their sixth win in seven top-flight matches and a fifth successive away victory in the top flight for the first time in 42 years.

They looked well on course when their South Korea international Hwang stole in front of Arsenal goalkeeper Aaron Ramsdale to score from a tight angle early on from Gabriel's misplaced back pass.

But while they defended resiliently for long periods, Hwang's miss just after the break and Pedro Neto's errant late shot with the score at 1-1 proved costly.

While Wolves may point to missed opportunities they can ultimately have few
