Meghan: Harry 'lost' Charles in barney over royal status

- Duchess sparks more controversy in latest interview
- Meghan claims media called her children the N-word

PRINCE Harry "lost" dad Charles in the row over him stepping down as a senior royal, Meghan Markle claimed this week.

She suggested the fallout was "his decision" in an interview in which she took her latest swipe at her in-laws.

The Duchess of Sussex, 41, said the couple were "happy" to leave Britain and claimed by staying, they were "upsetting the dynamic of the hierarchy... just by existing"

The revelations came in an interview with US magazine The Cut.

In it, Meghan was questioned about her estranged relationship with her father Thomas Markle, 78.

'misunderstanding'

The former actress said she believed the media played a role in the breakdown. And she said her husband told her he "lost" his father the same way.

Meghan said: "Harry said to me, 'I lost my dad in this process.' It

doesn't have to be the same for them as it was for me, but that's his decision."

But the author behind pro-Sussex book Finding Freedom responded by claiming there was a misunderstanding about the Charles quote. Omid Scobie posted: "I understand that Prince Harry is referring to Meghan's loss of her own father. Meghan is saying she doesn't want Harry to lose his."

The Duchess also took aim at the British media claiming they called her children "the N-word".

'upsetting the dynamic'

The Duchess said she hated sharing family photos with the media, adding; "Why would I give the very people that are calling my children the N-word a photo of my child before I can share it

with the people that love my child?"

She also claimed the couple quit the UK in 2020 to find financial freedom. She said they were willing to go to another Commonwealth nation, on behalf of the Royal Family, but wanted to make their own money. She said they reasoned: "Then maybe all the noise would stop. Because just by existing, we were upsetting the dynamic of the hierarchy."

"So we go, 'Okay, fine, let's get out of here. Happy to'," she added, reportedly raising her hands in mock defeat.

One of Harry's few contributions to the interview came as the Sussexes discussed working together on their Archewell foundation. The Duke claimed: "Most people that I know and many of my family, they aren't able to work and live

together."

It comes amid claims the Sussexes will miss seeing the Queen during

their upcoming visit to the UK. Harry and Meghan will attend events in the UK and

Germany next week. But they are not expected to travel to Balmoral to see Her Majesty.

Greeting the next PM: ailing Queen will break with tradition and meet Truss or Sunak at Balmoral

■ Next occupant of No. 10 to be named on Monday

Concerns over the Queen's health have forced the 'practical' decision to break with royal tradition – and not appoint the next Prime Minister in London.

The 96-year-old monarch will instead greet Boris Johnson and his successor at Balmoral on Tuesday. The Queen took the decision to provide "certainty" for the new PM's diary.

The monarch – who is resting on her usual summer break – has suffered from mobility issues and it is understood the change was made to prevent the need for any last-minute rearrangements.

skipping the trip

Liz Truss or Rishi Sunak will be announced as leader of the Conservative Party on Monday, with the Foreign Secretary on course to become Britain's 56th PM. The day after Mr Johnson will make the 1,000-mile round trip to resign as PM, before his successor has an audience with the Queen. The new incumbent will be her 15th Prime Minister.

The "kissing of the hands" ceremony will mark the first time a

Prime Minister has officially resigned or been appointed away from Buckingham Palace during the Queen's 70-year reign.

Although the Queen has passed on many of her roles to other members of the family, there are certain constitutional functions that cannot be delegated and appointing a Prime Minister is one of them. One Palace source said that if the Queen were to be experiencing an episodic mobility problem next week and the plan had been for her to travel to London or Windsor, it would have meant alternative arrangements being made at the last minute.

Fears over the Queen's health have increased in recent weeks after it was reported that the Prince of Wales has been making regular morning visits to see his mother.

'unnecessary strain'

Royal commentator Margaret Holder said: "Next Tuesday is set to be a milestone in British political history with the outgoing and incoming Prime Minister visiting the Queen at Balmoral rather than the usual

location of Buckingham Palace.

"To avoid putting the Queen to the unnecessary strain of making the 1,000-mile round trip, the politicians will go to her for the traditional farewell of the current Prime Minister, Boris Johnson, and the introductory meeting with the new one, Rishi Sunak or Liz Truss.

"It is an understandable concession to a woman of 96 who has given this country and the Commonwealth over 70 years of service.

"And it also underlines her determination to do her duty as long as she is able to."

Buckingham Palace has declined to give an ongoing commentary on the monarch's health.

During her Platinum Jubilee celebrations, the Queen only travelled to Buckingham Palace twice, first for her Trooping the Colour balcony appearance and then for a finale after the pageant.

Ex-BBC royal correspondent Peter Hunt said: "The fact officials can't be sure the Queen will be well enough to travel next

week is yet another reminder of her advanced age and increasing frailty.

"Despite this, the Queen remains determined to carry out her core duties. Appointing a new Prime Minister is not something

that can easily be passed to Prince Charles, a king-in-waiting."

The Queen normally spends the months of August and September at her Highlands retreat. The audiences at Balmoral will take place

in the estate's drawing room.

Constitutional expert Prof Vernon Bogdanor said: "There is no constitutional reason why the new PM should not be appointed in Balmoral."

Record number of foreign criminals living freely in Britain despite being eligible for quick deportation

A RECORD number of foreign criminals are living freely in Britain despite being eligible for deportation.

Home Office figures show 11,561 offenders "subject to deportation action" are still in the community.

This number has increased almost three-fold over the last 10 years.

In 2012, 3,943 criminals were still living in the UK.

Also, the number of foreign offenders subject to deportation action still living in the UK five years after their sentence has increased from 1,191 in 2013 to 3,589 in June.

There are renewed

calls for ministers to get tougher and protect borders.

Two weeks ago, the Home Secretary Priti Patel revealed she has ordered her officials to "renew their pursuit of dangerous criminals who devastate lives and communities".

The figures reveal the true scale of the problem, with the backlog growing year-on-year. This is likely down to countries refusing to take back their criminals, it was said.

Ms Patel has been pursuing returns agreements with numerous countries and has already secured deals with Albania and

Pakistan – two of the largest foreign national offender populations in Britain. The number of foreign national offenders living in the community despite being eligible for deportation began to surge in 2017.

By 2018, Britain could not boot out 6,249 foreign criminals.

The following year, this rose to 7,015 and then 8,497 the year after.

By Christmas 2020, this had rocketed to more than 10,000.

Alp Mehmet, chairman of Migration Watch UK, said: "We have long pointed to the scandalous way foreign national offenders

Giggs may face retrial

SOCCKER legend Ryan Giggs is potentially facing a retrial after a jury failed to reach verdicts in a domestic violence trial.

The former Manchester United footballer, 48, denied controlling or coercive behaviour over a three-year period towards his former girlfriend Kate Greville, 38. He also denied assaulting her and her sister Emma, 26, during a row. Manchester Crown Court was told the alleged assaults took place at his Worsley mansion in Greater Manchester on November 1, 2020. But after more than 20 hours of deliberations, the jury of seven women and four men, having lost one juror to illness, failed to reach verdicts.

The Crown Prosecution Service has a week to decide on pursuing a retrial – but it wouldn't be till at least June next year. Giggs was bailed until a September 7 hearing.

are released into the community, simply because the Government can't get them on a flight to wherever they're from and doesn't know what else to do with them.

"What is especially worrying is that many of those wandering freely in unsuspecting communities could pose a threat to public safety. But it seems that the safety of law-abiding citizens matters less to the government than the rights of foreign offenders."

Prisons Minister Stuart Andrew said: "Over the last couple of years, 11,500 foreign nationals have been deported back to their country.

"I am confident now that we'll be able to sort this situation out."

Stars and fans remember Diana 25 years after her death

MOURNERS across the world paid tribute to Diana, Princess of Wales, yesterday on the 25th anniversary of her death.

The focal point of sombre remembrance was the Pont de l'Alma tunnel in Paris, where the 36-year-old perished in a car crash in 1997.

The area close to the scene has since been renamed Diana Square with the Liberty Flame monument attracting millions each year.

Yesterday it was covered in flowers, messages and tributes to Diana and sons Prince William and Prince Harry. One read "25 years already" while another simply said: "Forever in our hearts".

'always be missed'

Briton Kate Baxter, 32, who was visiting but now lives in Canada, said: "Everybody in the world who was alive at the time of her death remembers her."

Sir Elton John, 75, who performed his song Candle In The Wind with the lyrics adapted to reflect Diana's life at the funeral service, said: "You will always be missed."

Diana was also remembered at Kensington Palace with floral tributes including a stunning display of white chrysanthemums spelling out Princess Diana, and also adorned with pink roses and ribbons. Well-wishers also tied dozens of pictures of Diana and personal handwritten messages to the gates.

'in shock'

One read: "Princess Diana – it's hard to forget someone who

gave us so much."

Mourners even suggested that Diana could have helped to heal the ongoing rift between her warring sons, the Dukes of Cambridge and Sussex. Anne Daley, from Cardiff, remembered hearing the news on August 31, 1997, and said: "People couldn't believe it. The Princess of Wales, dead? Everybody was in shock."

She added: "They're at war with each other – so we're led to believe. It's a terribly sad situation. I think like most mothers they'd call a family meeting, say: 'Cut it out, and behave yourselves.'"

Among those also paying tribute was John Loughrey, who held a silent vigil.

He has gained notoriety as Diana's "biggest fan" after leaving his job to attend every session of the six-month inquest into her death from 2007 to 2008.

Ministers 'must ignore Begum's carping lawyers' and ensure the Jihadi Bride never returns to Britain, say security experts

MINISTERS must ignore Shamima Begum's "carping" lawyers and ensure the jihadi bride never returns to Britain, experts declared this week.

The 23-year-old was sneaked into Syria for Islamic State by a people-smuggler spying for Canada, according to revelations about the case.

Ottawa is accused of withholding information about her whereabouts while the Metropolitan Police scrambled an international search for her.

Her lawyer Tasnime Akunjee said "this confirms Shamima was a trafficked person under the Modern Slavery Act".

But counter-terrorism experts warned intelligence agencies were right to recruit

from within Islamic State to act as double-agents.

They said the fact Begum met a smuggler who worked for Canadian intelligence does not mean "it is a fact" she was trafficked.

'terrorist group'

Begum has denied any involvement in terror activities and is challenging a Government decision to remove her citizenship.

Mr Akunjee added: "When someone is a trafficked person the UK has various treaty obligations and there is a very strong legal pressure to have that person repatriated."

"This was an allied state meant to be working to protect citizens but in their algorithm of risk decided they would put the lives of British children at stake."

Critics warned

Begum's lawyers will attempt to use the claims to regain her British citizenship.

Dr Alan Mendoza, executive director of the Henry Jackson Society think-tank, said: "Given that Miss Begum was on her way to join a terrorist group hell-bent on destroying the West, it is no surprise a Five Eyes Alliance agency wished to keep track of her activities."

"The Government should ignore the carping of her enterprising lawyers. Miss Begum has no one to blame for actions other than herself."

Chris Phillips, the former head of the National Counter Terrorism Security Office, told reporters: "Spy agencies get bad people to give them information. That is how it works."

Just a second, Meghan: Mandela relative and an academic join forces to condemn the Duchess's latest words

■ Claim South Africans were celebrating Meghan's marriage to Harry like the release of Mandela are absurd, says the statesman's grandson

■ Psychology professor describes Duchess as "entitled and narcissistic"

NELSON Mandela's grandson has condemned the Duchess of Sussex for comparing her marriage to Prince Harry to the freeing of the legendary anti-apartheid campaigner.

Mandla Mandela, said he was "surprised" by her claim that the royal wedding in 2018 sparked scenes of joy in South Africa reminiscent of the 1990 release after 27 years in jail of his grandfather.

The African National Congress MP, 48, said the wild celebrations that greeted his grandfather's long walk to freedom were

based on overcoming 350 years of colonialism and 60 years of a brutal apartheid regime and were far more important than Meghan's marriage "to a white prince".

He said: "So it cannot be equated to as the same. We are still bearing scars of the past. But they (the February 1990 celebrations of Mandela's release) were a product of the majority of our people being brought out on to the streets to exercise the right of voting for the first time."

Meghan, 41, who met Nelson Mandela's widow in South Africa

in 2019 made the astonishing claim in the jaw-dropping interview with American magazine The Cut in which she took swipes at the Royal Family.

Meghan claimed that at a 2019 London premiere of The Lion King which she and Harry attended, a cast member from South Africa pulled her aside and said: "I just need you to know: when you married into this family, we rejoiced in the streets the same as we did when Mandela was freed from prison."

And a leading Australian psychologist

issued a damning critique the interview, describing the Duchess in a leading British newspaper as "Narcissistic and Entitled."

Kevin Dutton, Professor of Public Understanding of Psychology at the University of Adelaide, is an author and academic. Writing in the Daily Express this week, he issued the following damning analysis of Meghan's interview in The Cut.

"NO MATTER how implausible the claims in Meghan Markle's latest 6,450-word interview with a US magazine might be, they are almost certainly not aimed at you or I."

Her repeated complaints of perceived slights, the low-level maligning of the Royals and tone-deaf

pronouncements on celebrity-dom and her brand of 'entitled' fame will be music to the ears of her audience, even as they leave the rest of us rolling our eyeballs.

Meghan is setting out her store to potential customers. And she has a lot to plug – her Spotify podcast, a Netflix documentary on the Sussexes and a tell-all book. I believe Meghan shows signs of a 'narcissistic' personality.

The five main symptoms of narcissism

are a sense of entitlement, manipulative behaviour, a need for admiration and to be at the centre of attention, a lack of empathy and an arrogant and controlling nature.

To make a comparison between herself and Nelson Mandela smacks of a sense of entitlement and a need for admiration. It's classic delusions of grandeur. It also demonstrates a total lack of empathy. Do you really believe that? And do you really think other people will too?"

England has had joint hottest summer on record, Met Office says

England has had its joint hottest summer on record, tying with 2018 in data stretching back to 1884, the Met Office has said.

Provisional figures show the summer of 2022, covering June, July and August, had an average temperature of 17.1C, tying with 2018 to be the warmest on record.

It means that four of the five warmest summers on record for England have occurred since 2003, as the effect of human-induced climate change is felt on the country's summer temperatures, the Met Office said.

England also had its sixth driest summer on record, and the driest since 1995, according to Met Office data going back to 1836. The UK as a whole saw 62% of its

usual summer rainfall.

It was also sunnier than usual, with an average of 582 hours recorded, 115% of the 1991-2020 average.

The hot summer included the record-breaking heat in July, which saw temperatures climb above 40C for the first time in the UK, as climate breakdown drives more frequent and intense heatwaves.

The Met Office said it was the fourth warmest summer on record for the UK overall, at an average of 15.7C, just 0.1C below the record set in 2018 and 2006. It was the eighth warmest summer for both Scotland and Wales and the 12th warmest for Northern Ireland, researchers said.

Dr Mark McCarthy of the National Climate Information Centre said:

"For many this summer's record-breaking heat in July – where temperatures reached 40.3C at Coningsby in Lincolnshire – will be the season's most memorable aspect. However, for England to achieve its joint warmest summer takes more than extreme heat over a couple of days, so we shouldn't forget that we experienced some persistently warm and hot spells through June and August too."

The hot, dry weather has led to drought conditions across much of England, drying up rivers, damaging crops and fuelling wildfires that have destroyed homes and land.

However, some respite has been forecast for the near future as an area of low pressure moves in.

Cowboy Cool: Welcome to Pioneertown

If you're looking to get out of LA for a fun day trip, then allow me to recommend riding into Pioneertown.

This evocatively-named place is an old western town 30 miles north of Palm Springs which offers an incredibly cool step back in time.

The place was built as a working movie set nearly 80 years ago and great names like Gene Autry and Roy Rogers filmed countless cowboy pictures there.

But when westerns went out of fashion, the sets got turned into shops and the place became something of a magnet for tourists headed to Joshua Tree and other nearby attractions.

There are vintage clothes stores selling cowboy boots, a bookshop, saddle store, art gallery and other shops selling soap and crystals.

Nevertheless, the hidden gem stayed largely unknown by the wider world— until



Instagram changed everything.

More recently it's attracted the IG crowd as hipsters from SoCal and further afield flock there to pose for selfies in Pioneertown during a desert sunset.

You'll see them all the time, posing in front of the old post office, town bank or hay bales – just like I did on my trip there.

The town has also had an increase in residents. More than 400 people live there now, many relocating from LA as the pandemic has prompted Angelenos to uproot and build houses in this a much quieter and cheaper but still fun environment.

I chatted with a few of these new pioneers on my visit. They're an artistic and eclectic bunch and talking to them it's clear they like

the option of being completely cut off from things while still being close enough to drive to LA if they suddenly need to reconnect with their old way of life.

And they don't seem to mind the tourists – which is something else you are used to if you've lived in Los Angeles.

At weekends, Pioneertown entertains the tourists by staging wild west shows and mock gunfights.

But even without those, there's plenty to enjoy in this old west wonder.

At the center of things is The Red Dog Saloon, the bar where western movie actors drank back in the day and which is still the main watering hole in town today.

EMMA RADUCANU'S year-long reign as US Open champion ended this week with a whimper, rather than a bang, but the British star remained upbeat despite her 6-3, 6-3 loss to French veteran Alize Cornet.

Twelve months on from the most extraordinary fortnight of her life – or that of any player – the British star could see only positives as the defence of her title fell apart in 102 minutes.

Having gone all the way in 2021 without dropping a set, Raducanu won just six games on the Louis Armstrong Stadium.

"Obviously it's really disappointing, I'm really sad to leave here," said Raducanu.

"It's probably my favourite tournament. But also in a way I'm happy because it's a clean slate. I'm going to drop down the rankings. Climb my way back up. The target will be off my back slightly.

"I've been doing some really good work in the last six weeks especially. I'm looking forward to putting more of those weeks together consistently, then we'll see what happens.

"With perspective, actually as a 19-year-old I've had not a bad year. To be top 100, if you told me that a year ago I'd take it."

Raducanu held serve twice and lost the last five games from 3-1 up in the second set. She called for the physio at the end of the first set, wincing as she received treatment for blisters.

"I've been getting some blisters throughout the weeks in the States, but I think that's just down to humidity and stuff," said Raducanu, who suffered from them during her Australian Open defeat in January. "You tape it up and move on. It's a blister. Not much you can do about it."

Club owner unimpressed by manager's public complaints

SCOTT PARKER was sacked by Bournemouth this week after a bitter war of words with the club's hierarchy.

Parker openly questioned Bournemouth's direction and commitment after their 9-0 humiliation at Liverpool on Saturday.

The club's Russian-born owner Maxim Demin issued a strongly worded statement in sacking Parker and his dismissal was down to the former England midfielder's comments rather than the Liverpool defeat.

There was a very clear fallout in the wake of the Anfield battering with Parker unable to conceal his frustrations about the lack of activity.

Parker had been growing increasingly concerned about the club's chances of survival because of a lack of new signings and let rip after the game.

He said: "I have been clear how this season

could look for us and I stick by that. We need to make a decision and try and help this young group who at times are struggling for air.

"Every one of us needs to make that decision. We have been trying to get more quality in and there are a million reasons why it hasn't happened."

Demin said after the firin: "I would like to place on record my gratitude to Scott and his team for their efforts during their time with us.

"Our promotion back to the Premier League last season under his tenure will always be remembered as one of the most successful seasons in our history.

"However, in order for us to keep progressing as a team and a club as a whole, it is unconditional that we are aligned in our strategy to run the club sustainably. We must also show belief in and respect for one another. That is the approach that has brought this club so much success in recent history, and one that we will not veer from now. Our search for a new head coach will begin immediately."

Parker guided Bournemouth to promotion from the

Championship last season, got just four games back in the Premier League – including an opening day win over Aston Villa – and now first-team coach Gary O'Neil will take interim charge for their game against Wolves tonight.

Parker is the first Premier League manager to go this season and is the first in England's top flight to be given his marching orders in August since Sir Bobby Robson and Paul Sturrock in 2004.

Former Burnley manager Sean Dyche has been made bookies' favourite, while Jonathan Woodgate is also in the odds, having had a short spell in charge at the club in 2021.

■ Striker joins Chelsea in £10m deal

Chelsea have signed forward Pierre-Emerick Aubameyang in a £10.3m deal from Barcelona and Juventus midfielder Denis Zakaria on loan.

Gabon striker Aubameyang, 33, scored 13 goals in 24 appearances for Barca after joining the Spanish club in February from Arsenal.

Left-back Marcos Alonso has left Chelsea by mutual consent and is expected to sign for Barcelona.

Chelsea have the option to sign Zakaria on a permanent deal.

The 25-year-old Switzerland international only joined Juve from Borussia Monchengladbach in January.

When Aubameyang

signed for Barca he had a buyout clause of 100m euros (£83.4m) in his contract, but has only played eight minutes this season. Barcelona have been looking to offload players after spending almost £200m on new arrivals despite being more than £1bn in debt.

The deal for Aubameyang means Chelsea chairman Todd Boehly has spent around £270m in his first transfer window since buying the club from Roman Abramovich - the highest amount any English club has spent in a single transfer window.

Aubameyang said: 'I'm really happy. It's an honour to be part of this team and I can't wait to start. I have some

unfinished business with the Premier League so it's good to be back and really exciting.'

Aubameyang scored 92 goals in 163 games in all competitions for Arsenal, but left on a free transfer after falling out with manager Mikel Arteta.

That departure played a big part in the Gunners documentary All or Nothing.

Only four players have scored more Premier League goals than Aubameyang's total of 68 in the period since 31 January 2018 - the date he joined Arsenal.

Aubameyang worked with Chelsea boss Thomas Tuchel at Borussia Dortmund between 2015 and 2017.

He scored 79 goals in 95

games under the German, 38 more than he netted under any other manager.

United win again; climb to fifth

Manchester United reeled off their third successive Premier League win under new manager Erik ten Hag, beating Leicester 1-0 to ensure the Foxes' troubled start to the season continued at King Power Stadium on Thursday.

Jadon Sancho's smooth finish from Marcus Rashford's pass after 23 minutes maintained United's recent revival and allowed them to build on victories at home to Liverpool and away to Southampton. United remained largely in control against an out of sorts Leicester, who remain bottom as they search for their first league win of the season and who, along with manager Brendan Rodgers, felt the impatience of the home fans.

Visiting keeper David de Gea was forced into a fine save from James Maddison's free-kick in the second half but

After Sancho's strike, United were able to do a containing job on a toothless Leicester side lacking in confidence and urgency and occasionally suffering the discontent of the increasingly impatient Foxes fans.
