I DID IT FOR MY MUM!

■ "Britain's Forrest Gump" completes grueling run across America

Britain's answer to Forrest Gump has run 3,100 miles across America...in memory of his mother.

William Goodge reached New York City on Saturday, having spent almost 56 days running from Los Angeles.

The 29-year-old said: "Finishing felt nothing short of surreal."

"It was very emotional, my dad and brother were there, and we embraced after I crossed the finish line."

"I know my mum would be so proud, and she is the one that gave me the strength to keep going."

He intended to finish the challenge on June 4 – but his trip went "better than planned". Organisers said William's time of 55 days, 23 hours and 51 minutes set a record for the fastest

Brit to run from Los Angeles to New York, beating the previous record posted by Bruce Tulloh who did it in 65 days in 1969.

Just seven years ago he was a semi-professional rugby player who had never been on a solo run, and thought the pastime was "pointless", he told the Telegraph.

Most remarkably, Mr Goodge, 29, who grew up in Ampthill, Bedfordshire, did the whole feat without too many issues.

"I had pain in my knees and glutes throughout but interestingly I only got two blisters," he said. "I got one on my first day of running, I remember it popping as I ran down

the hill, so I never used those shoes again."

Mr Goodge said he could truly be seen as the "British Forrest Gump" after being given the name by family members, friends and social media followers in the lead up to his challenge

In total, he ran through 13 states, clocking up a total of 3,175 miles, at a rate of 55 miles a day.

He went through 12 pairs of running shoes and had to devour more than 7,000 calories to replace what he was losing every day, something he said was very difficult to do.

He said: "It's an eating competition too, food can make or break you, you need the fuel to carry on on something like this."

The feat is all the more spectacular due to the fact that Mr Goodge only started running five years ago after the death of his mother Amanda from Hodgkin lymphoma in January 2018.

"I guess I started running after that because it gave me some kind of purpose," he said. "If I'd be angry, I'd go for a run, sometimes I would

run and cry but every run I went on, I felt a little bit better."

After running his first marathon in Christmas 2018, he decided to embark on his first ultra marathon and run the full length of the UK, from John O'Groats to Land's End.

This led to him pursuing the American adventure to raise money

in memory of his mother. So far, he has raised just over £71,000 for MacMillan Cancer and the American Cancer Charity.

Before beginning the run on April 2, William posted a picture on Instagram, writing: "What could possibly go wrong? I've got an angel on my side."

Cheese rollers? you've Gouda admire them!

A HUGE crowd cheers on the brave souls that faced a near vertical drop at the annual cheese-rolling race on Sunday.

Competitors chase a Double Gloucester cheese down a 200-yard course on Cooper's Hill, near Brockworth, Glos.

The cheese is protected in a wooden casing and can hit speeds of 70mph. The event is thought to be 600 years old.

The Gloucestershire Cheese Rolling originally took place on Whit

Monday. It then moved to the Spring Bank Holiday. The earliest record of cheese rolling traces back as far as 1826 through a message which was written to Gloucester's town crier. It was deemed to have already been a long-existing tradition, even as far back as that time.

There have been two origin stories for the Gloucestershire Cheese Rolling event that have been theorized so far. The first origin story

posits that the ceremony evolved from what used to be a requirement ritual for the maintenance of grazing rights among commoners. The second origin story is that it evolved from pagan origins notable for the custom of rolling objects down the hill. There is a belief that bundles of burning brushwood were rolled down the hill to symbolize the emergence of the New Year after the winter season. Another tradition connected with

this belief is scattering biscuits and sweets at the top of the hill by the Master of Ceremonies while he conducted his business. It is regarded as a rite of fertility to encourage the fruits of the harvest.

Matt Crolla, 28, from Salford, won the first men's race.

Asked how he prepared for the event, he said: "I don't think you can train for it, can you? It's just being an idiot."

Nanny-state policies 'now touching almost every area of British life'

Nanny-state policies are touching almost every area of British life, analysis shows.

The UK has the most restrictive tobacco regulations, the second toughest food and drink rules and some of the highest alcohol taxes in Europe, says a report.

We have been placed 11th in the Nanny State Index, up one spot since the last audit in 2021.

Chris Snowdon, who compiled the rankings for the Institute of Economic Affairs think tank, said: "With the UK introducing some of the world's most nanny-ing policies on food, it's no surprise to see it rising up the league table against stiff competition."

"The UK scores poorly in every category except e-cigarettes where it is the best in show."

lifestyle choices

"Scotland and Wales drag down the overall score by having minimum pricing for alcohol, and the UK as a whole is the worst place in Europe to be a smoker. With alcohol taxes rising sharply this year and more food regulation to come, things will get worse."

The 2023 Nanny State Index, published today by the IEA and the European Policy Information Centre, gives each European country a score out of 100 on the basis of how it regulates private lifestyle choices. The UK demands plain packaging for tobacco and smoking in enclosed public places and workplaces is banned. We have a tax on sugary drinks as well as food marketing restrictions.

The UK also has the highest booze taxes in Europe while Scotland has minimum pricing and bans on off-trade alcohol discounts.

Turkey was in top spot in the ranking followed by Norway and Lithuania. Germany got the lowest score, making it the most liberal country in Europe, followed by the Czech Republic and Italy.

obesity rates

The rankings come as both the Tories and Labour plan further nanny-state measures including banning "buy two, get one free" offers, extending restrictions on food advertising and expanding the so-called sugar tax.

The UK is helped in the index by having among the least restrictive controls on the sale of e-cigarettes in Europe. Alcohol duties have also fallen in real terms after being frozen for several years, although there is a large tax hike in August. The report finds no link between stricter drinking, eating, smoking, and vaping regulations and higher life expectancy.

Ministers want people to enjoy freedoms – but obesity rates are soaring.

Top oncologist Karol Sikora said officials should not tell us what we should eat. He said: "We're all big enough and ugly enough to make those decisions for ourselves."

Professor Sikora urged people to get into shape but added: "We need to give people, and especially children, the information and the tools to make their own minds up."

£1.1m court win after motorist's pothole hell

A driver has won over £1.1million after being injured by a pothole.

The huge £1,188,565 payout followed a four-year legal battle.

A Freedom of

Information Act request also shows the Welsh Government settled 11 claims for pothole-related vehicle damage over the past five years and a further two for

personal injuries.

The highest payout for vehicle damage claims was £1,077.

The RAC's Nicholas Lyes warned last winter's weather was

"the perfect recipe for potholes".

He added: "There are too many occasions where potholes have been poorly patched up by cash-strapped councils which then return all too quickly."

Meanwhile, villager Dan Munford has set up a toy road block alongside a mini excavator and flat bed truck on damaged road surface near his house in Llanrhaeadrym-Mochnant, Mid Wales.

Dan said he wanted to shock the council into action. He said: "The main road through our part of the village has never been in a worse condition."

Powys Council said repairs were taking place in line with budgets.



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Terror for Cumberbatches as ranting chef launches knife attack at their £3.5m London home

ACTOR Benedict Cumberbatch and his family were left fearing for their lives when a former chef at a luxury hotel launched a ranting knife attack at the star's home.

Jack Bissell, 35, kicked his way through the front garden's iron gate at the actor's £3.5million house in north London, ripped the intercom off the wall and made a series of terrifying threats.

Bissell, who has not explained his outburst, was shouting: 'I know you've moved here, I hope it burns down,' a court heard.

A source said: 'Naturally all of the family were absolutely terrified and thought this guy was going to get in and hurt them.'

'Luckily it never went

that far. Benedict and Sophie have had many sleepless nights since worrying that they may be targeted again.

'The fact that it was a targeted intrusion makes it a lot more scary.'

no defence

Bissell fled the scene but was arrested after police found his DNA on the intercom.

He admitted criminal damage at Wood Green Crown Court earlier this month, was fined £250 and a given a three-year restraining order banning him from approaching the Cumberbatch family and the area in which they live.

Prosecutors said that before targeting the Sherlock star's home, Bissell bought two

packets of pitta bread from a shop nearby and shouted to the shopkeeper that he was going to break into Cumberbatch's house and burn it to the ground.

It is not clear why Bissell targeted the Oscar nominee. He offered no defence in court.

previous conviction

He pleaded guilty and was sentenced on May 10 but details of the case could not be reported until a leading British newspaper successfully challenged blanket reporting restrictions this week.

Cumberbatch bought his five-bedroom home in 2015.

Bissell, who in 2015 was photographed being arrested in his underpants during

a central London protest against military intervention in Syria, worked at the Beaumont for two spells in 2017-2018 and 2019-2020.

The chef, from Kentish Town, north London, claims on his LinkedIn profile to have created a dish that still remains on the restaurant's menu.

He has a previous conviction for theft, three warnings for offences against property, a public order offence and a drug offence.

He added: "When it gets tough out here, to me, there's a sense of ignorance to my own suffering because I know, seeing someone fight cancer, just how much worse that is".

The runner, a former rugby player for Ampthill RUFC in Bedfordshire, is no stranger to extreme challenges, having run 48 marathons in 30 days in 2021. He said his mother's death when he

was 23 "was the most devastating thing that probably could have happened".

"If I got the best news in the world, she'd be the first person I talked to, and if I got the worst news in the world, she would be the person I'd go to," he said.

William, a brand partnerships manager from Ampthill, Beds, discovered running to feel close to his mum after his first run in Santa Monica.

Having run through the Californian city, he

said: "I was in this really jubilant mood, and when I got back, my mum also called me. She'd just been to her doctor, and she was in remission, so as far as I was concerned, at that moment, she had beaten cancer, and it really was the happiest moment in my life.

"Fast forward nine months, and she did pass away because the cancer came back, but I naturally found myself running. On reflection, I understand I was trying to get back to that moment of feeling pure joy and happiness."

MADDIE: Reservoir search items not confirmed as evidence, say police

■ German suspect had history of keeping 'trophy' from his crimes

German prosecutors have said a number of items recovered in searches last week that may be linked to Madeleine McCann's disappearance have not yet been confirmed as evidence.

The searches, which took place in Portugal after requests from German investigators, involved a large section of the Barragem do Arade reservoir being cordoned off, in an area about 30 miles from Praia da Luz, where Madeleine went

missing in 2007.

Police flattened an area of woodland and dug a number of holes near the remote reservoir as part of the three-day operation.

In 2020, German police said they believed Madeleine to be dead and identified Christian Brückner, a convicted sex offender, as probably responsible.

Christian Wolters, the German prosecutor for the city of Braunschweig, said: "A number of items were seized as part of the investigation. These will

be in the evaluated in the coming days and weeks.

"Whether individual items actually have a connection to the Madeleine McCann case cannot yet be said. The investigations conducted here in Braunschweig against the 46-year-old suspect are expected to continue for a long time."

He added that the joint operation between German, British and Portuguese authorities went "excellently and very constructively".

After last week's searches concluded, Portuguese police said materials had been sent to Germany for testing. They were given the go-ahead to search the area after German prosecutors received "certain tips" about the case. Heavy machinery, sniffer dogs and pickaxes were used during the operation.

Brückner is in prison in Germany for the rape of a woman in Praia da Luz in 2005, and is suspected

of further rapes and child sexual abuse committed in the area between 2000 and 2017.

Mark Hofmann, a criminal profiler in Germany, said Brückner, who is serving a seven-year sentence, had a history of keeping "trophy" from his crimes. He said: "From chat histories with like-minded people and from other crimes, it is known that Christian B tends to do exactly

this: documenting his crimes."

Brückner has reportedly denied any involvement in Madeleine's disappearance.

Madeleine was three when she vanished while on holiday with her parents in Praia da Luz, after they left her and her younger twin siblings asleep in their apartment while they went out to a tapas dinner with friends.

Showdown looms as Tories launch legal challenge... to their own Covid inquiry

The UK government is to launch an unprecedented legal challenge over the Covid inquiry's demand for WhatsApp messages and documents.

On Thursday the government missed a 16:00GMT deadline to share Boris Johnson's messages and notebooks from during the pandemic.

It is thought to be the first time a government has taken legal action against its own public inquiry.

Mr Johnson said he would be "more than happy" to give the unredacted material directly to the inquiry's chair.

The Cabinet Office - the department that supports the prime minister in running the government - had been given the deadline to hand over all documents requested by the Covid inquiry.

But the government refused to disclose some of the material by arguing it was not relevant to

the inquiry, it would compromise ministers' right to privacy, and would set a precedent that could prevent ministers discussing policy matters in future.

Crossbench peer and retired judge Baroness Hallett, who is the inquiry's chair, says it is up to her to decide what material is relevant.

Mr Johnson has not disclosed any WhatsApp messages sent before April 2021 because his mobile phone was involved in a security breach and has not been turned on since, his spokesman said.

The former prime minister has written to the Cabinet Office asking whether security and technical support can be given so that content can be retrieved without compromising security, the spokesman added.

In a highly unusual move announced after the 16:00 deadline had passed, the Cabinet Office said it would seek a judicial review of

Baroness Hallett's order to release the documents.

This means a judge will have to decide whether the inquiry has overreached its legal powers - setting up a potential legal showdown in court just weeks before the inquiry is due to hold its first public hearings.

Ministers set up the Covid inquiry in 2022 and tasked Baroness Hallett with identifying lessons from the government's handling of the pandemic.

Elkan Abrahamson, the lawyer representing the Covid-19 Bereaved Families for Justice group, said: "The Cabinet Office is showing utter disregard for the inquiry in maintaining their belief that they are the higher power and arbiter of what is relevant material and what is not."

Opposition parties have accused Prime Minister Rishi Sunak's government of trying to obstruct the Covid inquiry and urged him to comply with its requests.

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US fines British Airways \$1.1m for 'failing to refund' Covid cancellations

■ Airline says it 'acted lawfully' after claims that refunds for abandoned or rescheduled flights in 2020 were not 'timely'

British Airways has been fined \$1.1m (£878,000) by the US over claims it failed to pay refunds for cancelled flights during the coronavirus pandemic.

The US Transportation Department said in a legal document the airline did not "provide timely refunds to passengers" for abandoned or rescheduled flights to and from the country in 2020.

British Airways said it had "acted lawfully at all times" after being hit

with the fine on Thursday and rebutted the claims. A consent order from the department read: "From March to November 2020, British Airways' website instructed consumers to contact the carrier via phone to 'discuss refund options', including for flights the carrier cancelled or significantly changed.

"However, consumers were unable to get through to customer service agents when calling the carrier for several months during this period because British

Airways failed to maintain adequate functionality of its customer service phone lines. There was also no way to submit a refund request through the carrier's website during this period.

"Also, from March to November 2020, British Airways had misleading information on its website which led consumers to inadvertently request travel vouchers instead of refunds.

"Since March 2020, the Department has received

over 1,200 complaints alleging that British Airways failed to provide timely refunds after cancelling or significantly changing consumers' flights to or from the United States.

"British Airways has received thousands more complaints and refund requests directly from consumers. British Airways' failure to establish, for several months, a readily accessible method for

consumers to request refunds for flights the carrier cancelled or significantly changed caused significant challenges and delays in thousands of consumers receiving required refunds."

The department said the fine "establishes a strong deterrent to future similar unlawful practices".

British Airways is being credited just under £500,000 towards the penalty because in 2020

and 2021 it paid more than \$40m in refunds to customers with non-refundable tickets.

The airline said: "We're very sorry that at the height of the unprecedented pandemic – when we were unfortunately forced to cancel thousands of flights and close some call centres due to government restrictions – our customers experienced slightly longer wait times to reach customer service teams."

Respect their pronouns or leave, Oxford college warns students

Students at the University of Oxford could be expelled for misgendering their peers under a college's new transgender harassment policy.

Regent's Park College – once called home by the goddaughter of the late Diana, Princess of Wales – has launched a campaign against transphobia with a "trans inclusion statement".

The new policy says that "unlawful discriminatory behaviour,

including transphobic harassment or bullying ... will be regarded extremely seriously and could be grounds for disciplinary action".

The statement lists examples of harassment, including "consistently using incorrect titles, pronouns or names to refer to a trans person ('deadnaming') especially where this causes distress".

The college's students are also banned from "unduly intrusive or

personal questioning", "making jokes about trans people or their trans status" and "denying or disputing the validity and/or existence of a trans person's identity".

Students found to have broken the policy may face "expulsion or dismissal", the statement continued.

Regent's Park College is thought to be the first college to recognise gender identity as a protected characteristic by implementing a specific policy about it.

Bye Coach Lasso, we barely knew ye

■ As Apple TV's football comedy bows out, Nick Stark offers an appreciation

IN THE END, of course, three seasons was not nearly enough.

Apple TV's much-loved comedy Ted Lasso bid its fans a bittersweet farewell this week, with plucky underdog AFC Richmond clinching second place in the English Premier League and with it, Champions League football for next season. Peace and harmony had broken out within the team, Roy Kent and Jamie Tartt had become besties and even the turncoat former-kit-

boy-turned-coaching-wunderkind Nate was back in the fold. All incredibly feel-good stuff.

Except that Ted (Jason Sudeikis) was leaving. Moving forward, the team will have to muddle through without their unlikely and inspirational leader, the gosh-darned Midwestern aphorism-spouting Coach Lasso, for whom the pull of his young son back in Kansas City proved just too strong.

Not everybody gets Ted Lasso. For some it's just too upbeat,

too saccharine, too determined to tie up all the loose ends in a feel-good bow. But for this reviewer, it's been one of the best treats on TV these past couple of years. The show is not just a love-letter to optimism, communication, love and reconciliation, it's also a paean to shared sporting experience, to universal themes of redemption and forgiveness, and to Richmond itself, the local town which features so prominently in the opening moments of so many episodes, but especially the season finale.

When the show began three years ago, Lasso found himself the unlikely new coach at Richmond, hired only because owner Rebecca Welton wanted the team to crash and burn, to spite her former husband, (and the club's former owner) Rupert. But despite ridicule from players, fans and pundits, Ted persevered, turned the team into a family (admittedly a dysfunctional one) and earned success on the field and respect off it. And as the players bought into his methods and learned to unpeel layers of toxic masculinity, the huge array of supporting characters, from Nate to Trent to Jamie to Roy to Keeley and to Rupert each unfolded their own compelling character arcs, too.

The final episode saw the team say their goodbyes with a camp but still charming "So Long, Farewell" routine lifted straight from The Sound of Music, before the show

tied up a couple of loose ends, with Roy Keane confirming his transformation into what used to be called A New Man by uttering the words Ted longed to hear. Part of the charm of Ted Lasso when it's at its best is that unabashedly corny things work because of the charm of the performances. Who among us has not felt the need to say, "Can I be your friend?" Or, in this case, "Can I be a Diamond Dog?"

Other loose ends neatly tied up was that Rebecca asks Ted to stay, and of course he gently declines, thereby confirming their relationship as emotionally intimate but not romantic. Jamie and Roy become

besties, even while both affirming their continuing romantic interest in Keeley, and even cynical and snidey scribe Trent Crimm reveals himself as an adherent of the cult of Ted, completing his book, The Lasso Way, a loving account of his season with the team.

It's a threadbare cliché in showbusiness that you should always leave them wanting more, and perhaps the greatest genius of this show was quitting while they were ahead after three short seasons. Co-creators Sudeikis and Brendan Hunt (who plays Coach Beard) have done just that, leaving us both with a sense of satisfaction but also curiosity. The

Ted Lasso fan universe was rampant with speculation this week about the questions the show left unanswered: does Keeley end up with Roy or Jamie? Will Rebecca end up with the handsome Dutch pilot she spent a night with in Amsterdam? Will Ted get back with his ex-wife? Will Roy Kent be successful in succeeding Ted? And where does Nate fit in? Will he always be happy to be just the kit man?

In the end it doesn't matter, the show gave us lots of feelgood moments but the final whistle blew at the right time. No extra time. No penalties. And whatever happens in the future...we'll never forget this season.

Mourinho blasts English ref after final defeat

■ Roma manager may face sanctions after foul-mouthed tirade against Anthony Taylor

José Mourinho escalated his verbal attacks on the referee Anthony Taylor after Roma's Europa League final defeat by swearing at him in a car park after Wednesday's match, calling the English official "a disgrace".

Mourinho was filmed shouting abuse at Taylor in English and Italian in the VIP car park before leaving the Puskas Arena in Budapest. Towards the end of about 50 seconds of criticism he walked up to the passenger door of

what appears to be the van in which Taylor is to be driven away.

The Roma manager could face punishment from Uefa for his conduct there and in the press conference after Roma lost on penalties to Sevilla. Mourinho used the word "scandal" when describing Taylor's performance to reporters. He and several of his staff were shown yellow cards on a night when seven Roma players were booked.

Referees' body PGMOL

says it is appalled by the "unjustified and abhorrent" abuse.

PGMOL said in a statement: "[We are] aware of videos circulating on social media showing Anthony Taylor and his family being harassed and abused at Budapest Airport.

"We are appalled at the unjustified and abhorrent abuse directed at Anthony and his family as he tries to make his way home from refereeing the Uefa Europa League final.

"We will continue to provide our full support to Anthony and his family."

Meanwhile, Uefa

is waiting for reports from match officials and delegates before deciding whether to take action against Mourinho.

Bayern eye Rice bid



Bayern Munich have a confirmed interest in West Ham midfielder Declan Rice.

The England international, (above) valued at around £120million by his manager David Moyes, has been expected to join Arsenal once his season is over while West Ham believe Manchester United are also willing to make an offer following their attempts to sign the 24-year old last summer.

Bayern coach Thomas Tuchel is an admirer and was open to signing Rice during his time as Chelsea boss. Tuchel is understood to have spoken to Rice and the player's father last week along with Bayern technical director Marco Neppe.

The Bundesliga champions are willing to pay around £87million for Rice but could also

offer players to meet West Ham's valuation.

Arsenal, for their part, are believed to have around £180m to spend this summer plus what they generate in player sales.

They are expected to offer a deal worth around £90m for Rice but want to recruit another midfielder too, plus a forward, centre back and full-back.

United offered a deal worth up to £100m for Rice last summer and remain admirers but their priority is to sign a striker.

West Ham have been evaluating a number of midfield targets to fill the void Rice will leave. Southampton's James Ward-Prowse has been mooted but he is expected to wait before making any decision on his future amid tentative interest from other Premier League clubs.

Big Sam and Leeds call it quits

Sam Allardyce and Leeds have decided to go their separate ways after the Elland Road club's relegation to the Championship.

Although Allardyce presided over the collection of only one point during his four-match interim tenure at the end of the season, the staff and players at Leeds were highly impressed by his management style and the possibility of keeping the former England manager in the post next season was seriously considered.

Yet after a day of discussions with the West Yorkshire club's chief executive, Angus Kinnear, on Thursday, it emerged that no agreement was reached, dictating that Allardyce is set to leave Elland Road as Leeds step up their search for a new manager. Allardyce's appointment came at the end of a chaotic campaign in which Leeds sacked Jesse Marsch in February and his interim successor, Javi Gracia, at the start of May when they enticed the 68-year-old out of retirement for the final four games.

Whoever takes charge next season is likely to do so against a backdrop of considerable uncertainty. While it is unclear whether a successor to the recently sacked former

director of football, Victor Orta, will be appointed or that position scrapped, the club's ownership remains opaque.

Had Premier League survival been secured, the San Francisco-based investors 49er Enterprises, were set to increase their current 44% stake in Leeds by buying out the majority stakeholder, Andrea Radrizzani, but that deal now appears very much in the balance.

Radrizzani, meanwhile, is involved in a consortium buying Sampdoria, and Leeds fans reacted angrily when a report in The Athletic revealed that the chairman had offered Elland Road as collateral as he endeavoured to secure a £26m loan to help purchase the Italian club. Although it is not

thought that Radrizzani, who owns the ground, did ultimately use it as security, the episode is not believed to have gone down too well with some of his fellow board members in Yorkshire.

This turbulent backdrop is unlikely to persuade either Brendan Rodgers or Graham Potter – two managers much admired by Leeds executives – to take charge of the team this summer. Nonetheless, both are likely to feature on a shortlist also expected to include West Brom's Carlos Corberán and Lorient's Régis Le Bris.

While Corberán previously served as Marcelo Bielsa's first-team coach at Leeds, Le Bris is regarded as a rising star of French coaching.

Poch shows unlucky Felix the door

■ Portuguese striker sent back to Atletico as Chelsea's new boss aims to pare down bloated squad

Mauricio Pochettino has instantly stamped his authority at Chelsea by telling the club he does not want to sign Joao Felix on a permanent basis.

Felix, who scored just four Premier League goals in 16 top-flight outings since signing on loan from Atletico Madrid in January, is the first high-profile casualty of new head coach Pochettino's impending mass clear-out, with more set to follow.

Atletico president Enrique Cerezo said this week: "We have been informed that Poch does

not count with Joao Felix for Chelsea. We've known for less than 24 hours."

Atletico signed Felix from Benfica in 2019 for a club-record £113million. He has made 131 appearances for Diego Simeone's side, scoring 34 goals, and helped them win the Spanish title two years ago.

However, Felix's relationship with Simeone deteriorated earlier in the season and there does not appear to be any way back for him.

Atletico are said to value him at close to £88m despite his lack of goals this season. The

Portugal international had indicated he was open to staying at Chelsea, saying last week: "My team-mates were unbelievable and I really like to be here."

Chelsea are expected to sanction a big-money signing in attack, with Napoli's Victor Osimhen of strong interest and Harry Kane and Lautaro Martinez also credible options.

The Blues have appointed Chris Jurasek as chief executive, with president of business Tom Glick set to leave after less than a year in the role.

POSTECOGLU: Spurs interest 'doesn't register'

Celtic manager Ange Postecoglou says reported interest from Tottenham "doesn't register" with him as he prepares for the Scottish Cup final.

Several media outlets say Spurs are preparing to move for the Australian (above) after Celtic's meeting with Inverness Caledonian Thistle on Saturday.

Postecoglou insisted the latest reports have not changed his thinking.

"Somebody else was favourite last week, weren't they? So no, it doesn't register," he said.

"I get all the interest and why people love to

speculate on these things. "But we've worked really really hard to get ourselves in this position and for me to let my mind wander about anything else other than getting our team prepared for a big day on Saturday, it's just not who I am."

Victory against Inverness CT at Hampden would secure a domestic treble for Celtic, and a fifth trophy out of six available in Scotland for Postecoglou.

The 57-year-old, who is on a 12-month rolling contract, has been linked with other jobs in the Premier League and was asked if he could reassure

fans he would be at the club next season.

"Our supporters want to roll up on cup day and celebrate and make sure it's a special day," he said.

"Because anything I say now, will mean absolutely zero if we don't win on Saturday. I can tell you that. That's my focus because it's my responsibility. That won't change. I've been pretty clear on that.

"It's a massive role to be manager of this football club and for me to be dismissive of potentially our biggest game of the year is just not going to happen."



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
