

Biden and Sunak make 'Atlantic Declaration'

■ Partnership "first of its kind" to cover economic, technological, commercial and trade relations

PRESIDENT BIDEN and Prime Minister Sunak have unveiled a new "Atlantic Declaration", promising greater cooperation on pressing economic challenges in areas like clean energy, critical minerals and artificial intelligence.

The joint declaration described the partnership as the "first of its kind" in covering the broad spectrum of the two countries' economic, technological, commercial and trade relations.

Under the plan, Britain and the United States will strengthen their supply chains, develop technologies of the future and invest in one another's industries. Sunak and Biden also agreed to launch a new civil nuclear partnership as part of their clean energy cooperation, which will include setting up new infrastructure over the long term and cutting reliance on Russian fuel.

The two countries also agreed to work together on ensuring the safe development of AI technology, starting with Britain hosting a global summit later this year.

Greeting Mr Sunak in the Oval Office, Mr

Biden said the special relationship was in "real good shape".

Asked if Thursday's agreement was a recognition that an acceptance the era of "unfettered globalisation" was over, Mr Sunak said the Atlantic Declaration "just talks about strengthening, deepening our cooperation".

'economic issues'

"It's not about looking in and being protectionist, it's about the exact opposite of that, and it's about strengthening that cooperation across the full strength of economic, technological and other spheres. And that's what you will see. You'll see it from me, you'll see the UK and the US working even more closely together on the economic issues of our time.

"Because that's what

the moment demands and that's what our citizens need us to do and that's what the President and I plan to deliver."

Biden gaffe

The meeting started in embarrassing fashion as the President mislabeled Sunak as "President".

Biden said: "Well, Mr President.... Mr President, I just promoted you. Mr Prime Minister, it's great to have you back."

But since the last time Biden tried to announce the PM he called him "Rasheed Sanook", this was perhaps an improvement.

The United States was looking to Britain to help lead a common approach on AI safety and regulation, Biden said at their joint news conference.

The two nations will also begin negotiations on a critical minerals agreement, which

would allow some UK firms to access tax credits available under the U.S. Inflation Reduction Act.

The minerals, such as lithium, nickel, cobalt, graphite and manganese, are critical for batteries for electric cars, smartphones and solar panels.

'data bridge'

Britain and the United States will also co-operate on telecoms technology including 5G and 6G and quantum technologies, the Atlantic Declaration

said. The declaration also included a commitment in principle to a UK-U.S. "data bridge" which would make it easier for British businesses to transfer data freely to U.S. organisations without red tape.

According to No 10 Downing Street, Prime Minister Rishi Sunak says the new Atlantic Declaration "sets a new standard for economic co-operation, propelling our economies into the future so we can protect our people, create jobs

and grow our economies together".

The UK and US have "always pushed the boundaries of what two countries can achieve together" his statement read.

The two nations have "shared intelligence we don't share with anyone else" and "built the strongest investment relationship in world history," he says.

So he says it's "natural" that they would look to each other to build a stronger economic future together.

MIGRANTS: our small boat plan is working, insists Sunak

■ PM claims recent measures have cut Channel crossings by a fifth

LONDON: Prime Minister Rishi Sunak said on Monday his plan to stop migrants arriving in small boats had reduced crossings by 20%, an update he hopes will ease criticism from his party and in the country over immigration policy.

Sunak, who is expected to lead the Tories into a general election next year, has promised to "stop the boats" from crossing the English Channel as one of his five pledges after he was propelled to power in October last year.

But he has been criticised by members of his own party and the public for not moving quickly enough, with people protesting about the housing of hundreds of migrants in hotels after record numbers arrived in Britain last year.

'not complacent'

"In the five months since I launched the plan, crossings are now down 20% compared to last year," Sunak told

a news conference in southern England.

"The plan is working," he said, adding that the government was not complacent and would work hard to make sure parliament passed a new law.

But the Opposition claimed Sunak had failed to clear the backlog of tens of thousands of asylum claims and that 7,600 people had crossed the English Channel so far this year.

Britain has long struggled to curb the number of arrivals on its southern shores, but Sunak is keen to show his plan of securing agreements with other European countries to reduce the numbers arriving can produce results.

Asylum cases

He said a deal with Albania had meant that Britain was returning more migrants to the country and that London was increasing its provision of accommodation for those awaiting

immigration decisions. Sunak said so far this year "the number of Albanian small boat arrivals has fallen by almost 90%" and that Britain was now accepting one in 50 Albanian asylum cases compared with one in

five previously.

More than 5,000 asylum seekers in total would be moved out of hotels - which currently cost £6 million per day - into two new sites and two new vessels, the interior ministry said.

Sunak urged

parliament to pass his new Illegal Migration Bill, which will allow for the swift detention and deportation of people arriving on small boats back to their homeland or to so-called safe third countries such as Rwanda.

Iorwerth tipped for Plaid hot seat

Rhun ap Iorwerth is set to become the new Plaid Cymru leader.

Several reports from Cardiff emerged Thursday night, claiming that no other members of

the party's Senedd group will be standing.

Two members of the group, deputy leader Sian Gwenllian and Sioned Williams, had not ruled themselves out of the race.

But Newyddion S4C has been told they will not be standing to succeed Adam Price. Unless there is a U-turn from a Plaid MS it is likely Mr ap Iorwerth

will be the next party leader.

Nominations are due to close on 16 June.

Plaid Cymru has been looking for a new leader since Adam Price stood down in May.

It followed reports of a toxic culture of harassment, bullying and misogyny had become worse under his leadership.

Ynys Mon Senedd member Mr ap Iorwerth announced he would be standing in a video published on Twitter.

In that said he was looking forward to playing his part in uniting the party.

He said previously it must offer a vision of Wales as "confident, fair, green, prosperous", and on a "journey to independence".

Second baby for Eugenie

Princess Eugenie and her husband, Jack Brooksbank, have welcomed their second child

The couple announced the birth of their new son on Monday, with an adorable Instagram post introducing the newest member of the royal family. In addition to including the baby's first public picture, the post also revealed his name: Ernest George Ronnie Brooksbank, and the sweet family connection behind it.

"Jack and I wanted to share the news that we had our little boy, Ernest George Ronnie Brooksbank on 30th May 2023 at 8.49 weighing 7.1lbs," Eugenie wrote in the caption. "He is named after his great great Grandfather George, his Grandpa George and my Grandpa Ronald."

Ernest's triple-great grandfather, of course, would be Britain's King George V (born George Frederick Ernest Albert), the grandfather of Eugenie's own much-beloved late grandmother, Queen Elizabeth II. It's a double sweet homage, as her husband Jack's father is also named George, making the name particularly fitting.

Ronnie is in reference to Eugenie's maternal grandfather, Ronald Ferguson, the father of Eugenie's mother, Sarah Ferguson, Duchess of York. While there was some speculation that Eugenie's second child might take his name from a closer royal relative, like her father, Prince Andrew, given that her eldest son, August "Augie" Philip Hawke Brooksbank was already named after her royal grandfather, Prince Philip, the couple obviously decided to pay tribute to other parts of their family in naming their new baby.



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Piers would often 'inject' extra into royal stories, claims reporter

■ Morgan took "really genuine interest" in Palace coverage, says ex-Mirror editor

A former Daily Mirror royal editor said her former boss Piers Morgan would "inject" information into her stories without explaining where it was from.

Jane Kerr was giving evidence in Prince Harry's hacking case against Mirror Group Newspapers (MGN).

He claims the papers unlawfully obtained private information about him, which MGN denies.

Mr Morgan has consistently said no illegal newsgathering happened on his watch.

Ms Kerr, who worked for the Daily Mirror's royal team from 1996 to 2007, told the High Court that Mr Morgan would add snippets of information into stories she had authored.

Harry: "I was the cheat, the thicke, the underage drinker"

PRINCE HARRY made history this week as the first senior royal to appear in a courtroom in over a century.

Facing cross-examination in the High Court in his case against Mirror Group Newspapers (MGN), the prince was questioned about his 55-page witness statement, which details the times when he says journalists at the newspaper publisher used unlawful methods to gather information to generate stories about him, including phone hacking. MGN denies phone hacking in this case.

In a mostly cat-and-mouse exchange with the defendant's lawyer, Harry was vague about how he could be certain that private information published in the Daily Mirror could only have come from illegal means such as wire tapping. The Prince would only

She said he might have been speaking to "someone at the palace" but she would not know who.

Ms Kerr added that Mr Morgan, who was editor of the paper from 1995 to 2004, took a "really genuine interest" in the coverage.

'hugely relieved'

In her written witness statement, Ms Kerr said he "engaged with the Palace press offices and would occasionally direct or inject information into a story".

Prince Harry alleges about 140 articles published between 1996 and 2010 by MGN - the publisher of the Daily Mirror, Sunday Mirror and the People - contained information gathered using unlawful methods.

A sample of 33 stories

are being scrutinised during this case, a number of which were written by Ms Kerr.

She was asked about a story reporting that a young Prince Harry had taken drugs at parties, which included reports that Prince Charles had been "hugely relieved" to have been told his son had only used cannabis "spliffs".

Prince Harry's barrister, David Sherborne, put it to her that this was private information which could have been obtained from listening to voicemail messages, asking: "Where did you get the quotes from Ms Kerr?"

She replied: "I can't say for sure where I got them from, I can't remember - it's possible Piers gave them to me, it's possible the Palace. I don't

remember."

Mr Sherborne responded: "You're saying the Palace would have given you what Prince Charles said in highly sensitive meetings with his son?"

She repeatedly said that she could not remember the sources of stories published decades ago.

'off-limits'

The questioning has focused on additional details added by Ms Kerr while following up on stories already in other papers.

In March 2002, she wrote about Prince Harry catching glandular fever, reporting that "Harry's friends and William have teased him about the illness because it is spread through saliva, usually by kissing".

The prince told the court during his evidence that these suggestions were upsetting and embarrassing at the time as he was still at school.

Ms Kerr told the court

she could have got the information from the Palace, despite the media having been told during this period that Prince Harry and Prince William were "off-limits" to reporters in the wake of the death of Princess Diana.

"You're suggesting some Palace spokesperson would have casually tossed it to you as a little morsel to add colour to your story?" Mr Sherborne asked.

When she said she did not know where it had come from and could easily have been a "throwaway line", Mr

Sherborne said: "That's total speculation, isn't it?"

Mr Sherborne asked: "Or was this something Mr Morgan injected into the article?"

"Possibly but I just don't know," Ms Kerr replied.

Speaking to the BBC ahead of the trial, Mr Morgan said: "I've never hacked a phone. I've never told anybody to hack a phone."

He has poured scorn on Prince Harry's decision to go to court, telling reporters: "I wish him luck with his privacy campaign and look forward to reading about it in his next book."

say that the appearance of many stories was 'highly suspicious'.

The royal began his day in court with the following statement about his treatment at the hands of the British tabloids:

"In my experience as a member of the Royal Family, each of us gets cast into a specific role by the tabloid press.

"You start off as a blank canvas while they work out what kind of person you are and what kind of problems and temptations you might have.

"They then start to edge you towards playing the role or roles that suit them best and which sells as many newspapers as possible, especially if you are the 'spare' to the 'heir'.

"You're then either the

'playboy prince', the 'failure', the 'dropout' or, in my case, the 'thicke', the 'cheat', the 'underage drinker', the 'irresponsible drug taker', the list goes on.

"As a teenager and in my early 20s, I ended up feeling as though I was playing up to a lot of the headlines and stereotypes mainly because I thought that, if they are printing this rubbish about me and people were believing it, I may as well 'do the crime'.

"It was a downward spiral, whereby the tabloids would constantly try and coax me into doing something stupid that would make a good story and sell lots of newspapers.

"Looking back, such behaviour on their part is utterly vile."

The case continues.

He has ticked them all off as well as 40 venues that have since closed.

He said: "I travel about a lot following Burton Albion, and to do my trainspotting, and every time I get to somewhere new I search out the Wetherspoons.

"There are so many interesting ones.

"I've had a drink in old fire stations, a police station, a tram station, printing halls and newspaper offices.

"There's such a history to a lot of these pubs."

He added: "I mainly

travel by public transport so I've been able to have a pint in most of them.

"I don't know how much I've spent. We don't just go to the pub, we visit other things and we stay over when we travel, so maybe £30,000?"

"Whatever the number it's been such a great experience. I've really been living the dream."

Wetherspoon spokesman Eddie Gershon said: "We applaud David Bingham on his outstanding achievement.

"Many people love to visit Wetherspoon pubs across the UK and Ireland, but only a handful have visited each and every one.

"David will now join that select group.

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Aston Martin Bulldog: 0-200 in 45 years

■ Legendary prototype finally lives up to its billing

More than 45 years after it was first conceived - as a 237mph car, no less - the Aston Martin Bulldog has finally broken the 200mph barrier at a former NATO airbase in Campbeltown, Scotland. The 1977 one-off prototype was famed for almost being the fastest production car of its time, though it never achieved more than 191mph back in the day and didn't actually make production.

Originally a run of 15-20 examples was planned, but it all got a bit too pricey and the prototype was eventually sold to a Saudi Prince for £130,000. The engine blew up on its first drive. But like a Saturday morning Parkrunner, the Bulldog has finally smashed its personal best. Driven by works driver Darren Turner - who's no stranger to these kinds of speeds as a three-time class winner at Le Mans - the attempt

was made possible after an 18-month project to restore the 70s trailblazer. More than 7,000 hours of restoration work and hundreds more of testing were needed to bring the Bulldog back to its best.

'very proud'
"Bulldog's 200mph goal has been over 40 years in the making, being part of that legacy is a fantastic feeling," said Turner, whose last attempt to hit the magic double-ton in the

Bulldog in 2021 fell short at 176mph.

"The Bulldog has now fulfilled Aston Martin's promise and everyone who has worked on the car - from those who first designed and built it, to Classic Motor Cars who undertook the restoration under the management of Richard Gauntlett, can feel very proud."

Apparently "conditions were perfect" and the Bulldog hit 200mph "easily" this time round. Wonder what did the trick this time?

Tim Griffin, MD of Classic Motor Cars, said: "Thanks to the CMC

team's hard work the Aston Martin Bulldog has done it. The people of Campbeltown were very welcoming and encouraging to us, and we're glad to give them the opportunity to see the car and meet Darren."

The car's current owner, Beverly Hills-based billionaire Phillip Sarofim, added: "Today is about making dreams come true, the dreams of the original designers and engineers who created Bulldog. Those automotive pioneers were breaking barriers, not just speed

barriers but frontiers of design, innovation and engineering."

And project leader Richard Gauntlett (son of the former owner of Aston itself, Victor Gauntlett) said: "It is a truly incredible moment to witness the close of a 45-year chapter in the history of the incredible Aston Martin Bulldog. The team who built it and the team who re-built it are deservedly celebrating their momentous achievements and it is heartwarming to see all their hard work rewarded."

'Extinct' butterfly makes a comeback

Blink and you could miss them - but mysterious sightings of a the black-veined white butterfly in England have set the hearts of enthusiasts fluttering.



The species (pictured, right), previously described as extinct in Britain for nearly 100 years, has suddenly appeared in countryside on the edge of London.

To the non-expert, they could easily be mistaken for the common or garden cabbage white butterflies seen in Britain every summer.

But there's nothing common about the black-veined white on our side of the Channel.

First listed as a British species during the reign

of King Charles II, they officially became extinct in Britain in 1925.

This month they have mysteriously appeared among their favourite habitat: hawthorn and blackthorn trees.

As their name suggests, they are a medium-sized white butterfly with distinctive black vein markings on their wings.

The charity Butterfly Conservation, which monitors butterfly numbers in Britain, told the BBC the insects will have been released, but they don't know by who or why.

They added that while it's lovely for people to be able to see them, it probably does not signify a spontaneous recovery of an extinct species.

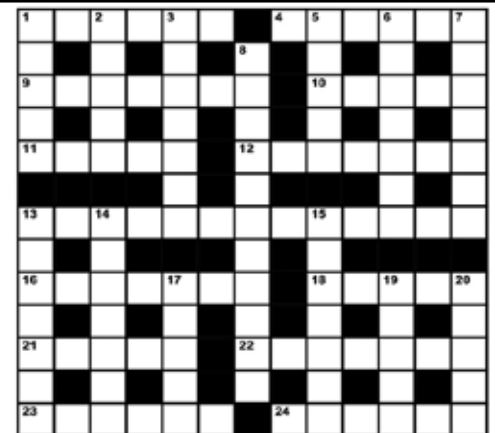

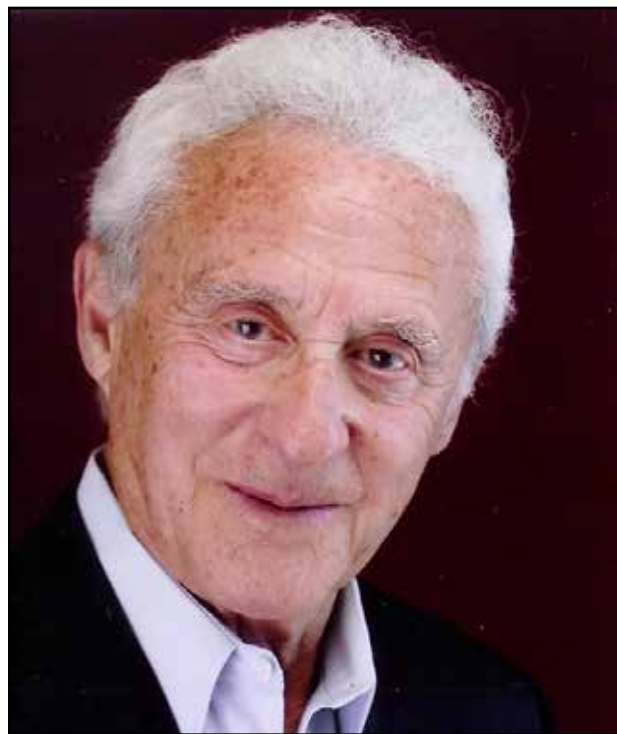

optimistic

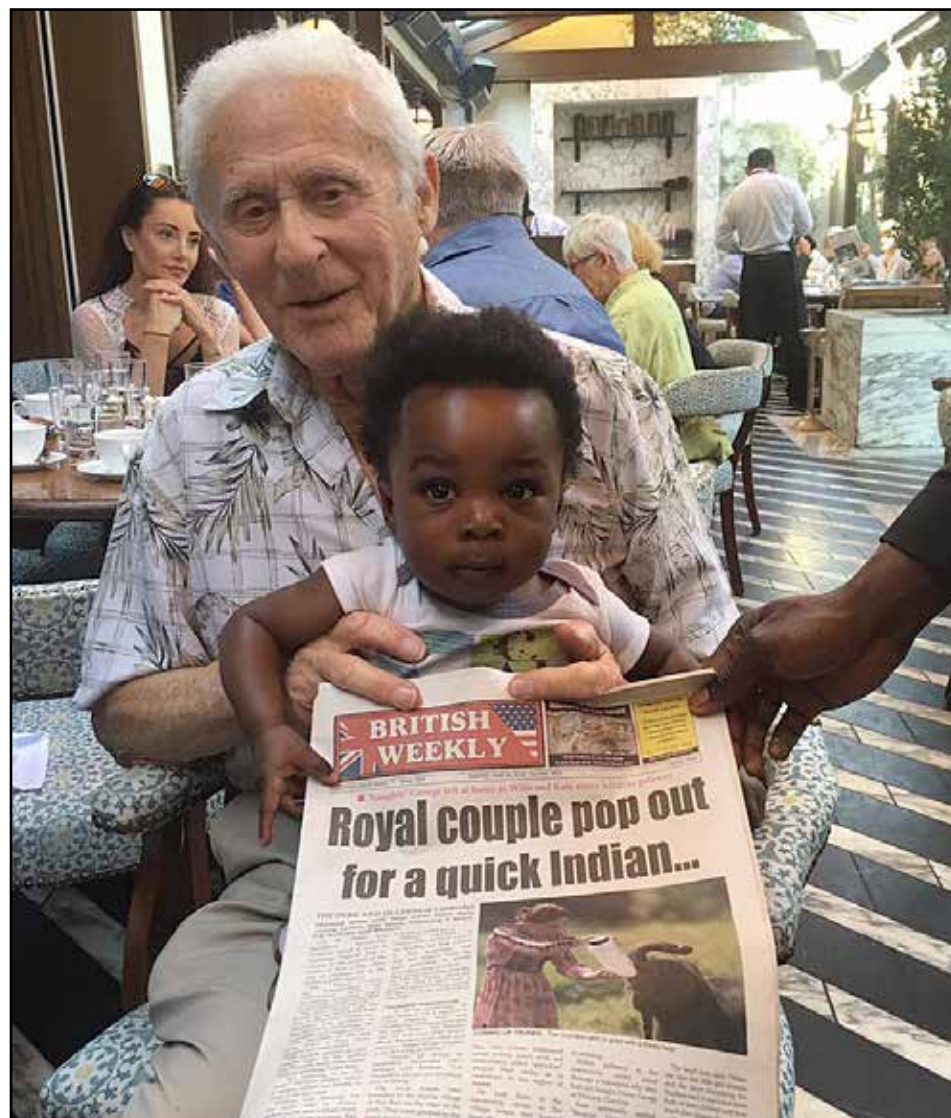

Born in 1928, Bernard grew up near Leeds during a time of great turmoil and uncertainty. Despite the challenges of his early years, he remained optimistic and determined to make a difference in the world. With a keen intellect and a fierce work ethic, he pursued a career in engineering, eventually becoming a respected leader in his field. He was always quite an extrovert, and this week we heard from another local Yorkshireman, Bernie Sidman, that during the 1960s 'our' Bernard was a frequent sight in Leeds city centre, driving around in a Jaguar with the personalized license plate BS1

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Spurs try some Ange management

Ange Postecoglou has been confirmed as the new Tottenham Hotspur manager.

The 57-year old leaves Celtic after a trophy laden two years in charge and he may not be the high-profile appointment some Spurs fans were calling for but the 57-year-old's CV shows he could be the antidote to a club in serious need of direction.

The first Australian to manage in the Premier League will be tasked with re-energising a patchwork squad - that may or may not include the greatest Spurs player of a generation in Harry Kane - cultivating a more positive and productive culture and creating a brand of attacking football craved by the fanbase since the end of the Mauricio Pochettino reign.

Postecoglou has a track

record of delivering on the above with previous rebuilding jobs leading to league titles in Australia, Japan and most recently a Scottish treble with Celtic.

He also has a self-proposed commitment to playing dynamic, attacking and energetic football he demands must be "pleasing to the eye" but "with a purpose".

Matt Smith won back-to-back titles under Postecoglou at Brisbane Roar and says the boss was not content with simply winning, he wanted to "change the whole scope of how Australian football was perceived".

"Ange's massive strength is his ability to be able to bring players along that journey and buy into what he does," the former Brisbane captain said.

After winning the

Asian Cup with Australia, Postecoglou created a similar legacy in Japan. He took over a Yokohama F Marinos side suffering from an "identity crisis" and turned them into J League champions.

"Ange really gave the club purpose," explained Dan Orlowitz from the Japan Times.

"It was a refreshing style of football that the league hadn't really seen. Even when YFM struggled results-wise in 2018 it was very clear that the players and above all Ange believed in what he was doing.

"The fans believed in him as a result, and over the next year he let go of players who weren't a good fit for the system and brought in players who were a great fit. All of that added up to the triumph of 2019.

"It was exactly what

you've seen at Celtic - not just 11 players, but 11 attackers, a disciplined and fluid build-up from box to box that moved like water and was nigh-on unstoppable.

"YFM fans loved it and opposing fans respected it - even when they were on the

wrong end - because it was just such a joy to watch."

Wherever Postecoglou's unique and varied footballing journey has taken him, he has silenced any sceptics.

He was relatively unknown to Celtic fans when he arrived in Glasgow

two years ago.

But on the day his departure was announced, after winning five of the six domestic trophies available to him, chief executive Michael Nicholson labelled the Australian a "great football manager and a good man".

Walker: we want to 'right the wrongs'

Kyle Walker said the outcome of Saturday's Champions League final won't define the achievements of Manchester City in recent years.

However, the full-back said there are members of Pep Guardiola's squad who want to "put right the wrongs" from City's 2021 defeat by Chelsea.

Speaking before today's final against Inter Milan, Walker said: "It doesn't define what this squad has achieved over the last six years if we go on and win this or not.

"It helps massively to say that we can be put in that category of probably one of the best Premier League teams of all time. We don't win five Premier Leagues in six years if we are not a good team.

"We kind of know we are a good team but to be recognized globally as one of the best teams you need to win the Champions League.

"We are not beating around the bush with that, we know this is now a great opportunity, we have a second chance definitely with Pep and the group of players who have stayed around and we need to put right the wrongs we did against Chelsea."

And City goalkeeper Ederson said his side will "keep the same personality" and not change their style of play.

The Brazilian said: "We need to keep playing in the same way that we have been. We can't change that just because we're playing in a final.

"We have to have the personality to play, to have the ball at our feet, to find passes. Of course, making mistakes is part of being a goalkeeper, defender, the whole team.

"We're all able to make a mistake, whether it comes in the first game of the season or the last, but we have to keep the same personality to play."

Bellingham off to Madrid

Real Madrid have agreed a deal with Borussia Dortmund to sign England midfielder Jude Bellingham for 103m euros (£88.5m).

The 19-year-old, who joined Dortmund from Birmingham City in July 2020, was one of England's top performers at last year's World Cup.

The midfielder, who has been linked with some of Europe's top sides, will sign a six-year deal.

Manchester City and Liverpool were two of the sides keen on Bellingham, who is set to become the world's third-most expensive teenager.

The Bundesliga's player of the season will also become the second-most expensive English footballer and Real Madrid's second-most expensive signing after Eden Hazard's 115m euro move from Chelsea in 2019.

In April, Liverpool dropped out of the race to sign Bellingham because of the cost involved. Asked about Bellingham at the time, Liverpool manager

Jurgen Klopp compared talk of big-money transfers to a "child wanting a Ferrari for Christmas".

He excelled at Dortmund and in October last year he made history by becoming the club's youngest captain aged 19.

Bellingham has played 42 times for his club this season - scoring 14 goals and registering seven assists.

"Every time you think you've seen a fully formed Jude Bellingham he does something else, something different and adds more layers to his game," German football expert Raphael Honigstein said.

"He's just a phenomenon and it is sometimes frightening to think where he might be at his prime of 26 or 27."

Another layer Bellingham has added this season has been goals. In his previous two seasons at Dortmund he did not score more than six goals, but this season he has 14, including one against Manchester City in the Champions League in September.

MacAllister seals £35m Reds switch

Liverpool have completed a £35m deal to sign midfielder Alexis MacAllister from Brighton on a five-year contract.

The fee could rise to £55m for the Argentina playmaker, who helped Brighton finish sixth in the Premier League this season to qualify for Europe for the first time.

The 24-year-old scored 20 goals in 112 appearances for the Seagulls and helped Argentina win the 2022

World Cup.

"It's a dream come true and I can't wait," said MacAllister.

"I wanted to be in [from] the first day of pre-season, so it's good that everything is done. I'm looking forward to meeting my team-mates.

"It was a fantastic year for me - World Cup, what we achieved with Brighton - but now it's time to think about Liverpool and try to be a better player and a better human being every day."

East Enders end trophy drought

■ London streets turn claret and blue as Hammers fans welcome home their cup-winning heroes
 ■ Late Bowen goal in Prague secures 2-1 win in Europa Conference Final, their first silverware since 1980

The streets of east London turned into a sea of claret and blue on Thursday evening as thousands gathered for the West Ham trophy parade after their Europa Conference League victory.

The Hammers beat Fiorentina 2-1 in Prague on Wednesday, with Jarrod Bowen scoring a late winner.

The parade started at the Champions Statue - which depicts the club's 1966 World Cup winners - in Barking, close to the club's old stadium the Boleyn Ground at 19:00 BST and slowly made its way to Stratford Town Hall.

Many West Ham fans arrived early to ensure they got the best spot and cheer on their heroes, who had secured the club's first major European trophy in 58 years and their first major trophy of any kind since Trevor Brooking's header secured them the FA Cup in 1980.

In a slow and raucous open-top bus ride towards Stratford, the players took it in turns to hoist the trophy into the air, prompting cheers from the crowd.

The parade left West Ham's old home at Upton Park at 7pm and travelled to a reception at Stratford Town Hall. The streets were so packed that it took the team much longer to arrive for the Town Hall celebration than initially planned.

'hit me yet'. He added the feeling is 'absolutely incredible' and that 'time and time again I've said these are the best fans in the world.'

Matchwinner Jarrod Bowen, who scored the last-minute winner, - said 'he just wanted to score as soon as possible'. This prompted huge cheers from the crowd.

But the beaten side were less charitable in their appraisal of the Hammers' win, with the Italian club's president Rocco Comisso claiming David Moyes' men treated Fiorentina like "animals".

Striker Luca Jovic had to come off at half-time with a broken nose, while left-back Cristiano

Biraghi was left with a bloodied face after being hit by an object thrown from the crowd.

"I expected to win, but it wasn't like that," Comisso told local media.

"But there have been episodes on the pitch where the referee had to make the difference.

"I spoke to the president of the Premier League, those of West Ham are animals in the way they treated ours. It's not right.

"This match could be won 3-0. I'm sorry for the fans, they deserved more."

Separately, the Serie A club "strongly condemned" what happened to Biraghi.

"This unacceptable

behaviour obviously team-mates, who had affected the performance their attention drawn of the footballer and his away from footballing

matters by the threats to their own safety," Fiorentina said.

It added it was "certain" European football's governing body Uefa would "duly punish those responsible for this act, delivering an appropriate response and setting an example so that such situations never occur again".

Meanwhile, police said a total 23 fans were arrested in Prague. One was a West Ham fan, with the other 22 supporting Fiorentina.

Fiorentina fans attacked West Ham fans in a bar in central Prague, with 17 of the 22 fans of the Italian club detained over that incident.



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
