Three dead in kids club horror attack

■ Nation stunned by 'ferocious' attack on young dancers • Violent protests break out as right wing groups seek to capitalize on immigration issue

THE NATION was left stunned this week by as three children were killed and six left in critical condition after a "ferocious" knife rampage at a dance class.

Five more youngsters were wounded in the terrifying incident during a Taylor Swift-themed event in Southport, Merseyside on Monday.

Two adults were also left fighting for their lives after bravely trying to tackle the masked knifeman who was later identified as 17-year-old Axel Muganwa Rudakubana, who was born in Cardiff to Rwandan parents.

About two dozen children were attending the summer vacation workshop on Monday when the suspect burst in. Alice Dasilva Aguiar, 9, Elsie Dot Stancombe, 7, and Bebe King, 6, died from their injuries. Ten other people were injured, among whom five girls and two adults are in critical condition.

'horror movie'

Colin Parry, owner of nearby Masters Vehicle Body Repairs, said: "The mothers were coming

here screaming. It was like a scene from a horror movie. It's like something from America, not like sunny Southport."

Traumatized onlookers told of scenes of carnage after the attack which left first responders in shock. Eyewitness Bare Varathan, 35, who owns a shop nearby, was told by a staff member: "Get to the shop!"

He said: "I saw seven to 19 kids outside the nursery. They were injured, bleeding."

"They were in the road, running from the nursery."

"They had been stabbed, here, here, here, everywhere."

'profoundly shocked'

13 North West Ambulance Service crews and an air ambulance treated the victims, rushing them to nearby Aintree University Hospital, Southport and Formby Hospital, and Alder Hey Children's Hospital.

Upon being briefed on the incident, Prime Minister Sir Keir Starmer told reporters: "The events today are just truly awful and I know the whole country is deeply shocked at what they have seen and what they have heard."

"I know I speak for everybody in the whole country in saying our thoughts and condolences are with the victims, their families, their friends and with the wider community. It is impossible to imagine what they are going through right now."

The King said: "My wife and I have been profoundly shocked to hear of the utterly horrific incident in Southport today."

"We send our most heartfelt condolences, prayers and deepest sympathies to the families and loved ones of those who have so tragically lost their lives, and to all those affected by

this truly appalling attack."

But the attack was just the beginning of a worrying week in England, as a series of violent demonstrations and assaults followed after a right-wing website in the USA wrongly identified the suspect as a recent immigrant. Amid a swirl of online misinformation and rumor British far-right anti-immigrant groups organized an attack on a mosque near the crime scene, leading to several hours of violent disorder which left more than 50 police offi-

cers being injured.

In the hours that followed similar violence flared in London, Manchester and Hartlepool.

Dal Babu, former Ch. Supt and firearms commander in the Met, has blamed the disorder on the "reckless" spread of misinformation about the identity of the suspect charged in the stabbing.

Speaking to the BBC, Mr Babu said the police have taken the "unprecedented" decision to confirm the suspect "was born in this country".

In London, demonstrators were seen launching flares towards the gates of Downing Street and at a statue of Winston Churchill.

People could be heard chanting phrases such as "stop the boats" and "save our kids" as they threw bottles and cans at officers.

Earlier, the Met said conditions placed on the protest had been breached.

More than 100 people were arrested for offenses including violent disorder and assault on an emergency worker.

Cutious BoE cuts interest rate

The Bank of England acted with typical caution this week, cutting interest rates by a quarter of one percent, with the governor adding a warning that Britons should not expect a further sharp fall in the coming months.

In a closely-run decision, rates were lowered to 5% from 5.25% on Thursday, marking the first cut since the start of the pandemic in March 2020.

Interest rates dictate the cost of borrowing set by High Street banks and money lenders for the likes of mortgages and credit cards.

Bank governor Andrew Bailey said that lower inflation had paved the way for the fall in interest rates but added it was "not mission accomplished yet".

soaring price rises

He said policymakers needed "to make sure inflation stays low and be careful not to cut interest rates too quickly or by too much".

Interest rates have climbed over the last few years, as the Bank has battled to control soaring price rises.

The higher rates have put pressure on household finances, although returns for savers have improved.

The fall to 5% means that homeowners on tracker mortgages will see an immediate reduction in their monthly mortgage payments. Those on variable rate deals may also benefit from the fall.

But many homeowners on fixed rate mortgages still face the prospect of much higher mortgage rates when those deals expire over the next few years.

Edwards: I'm guilty as charged

Former BBC presenter admits multiple charges relating to indecent images of children

Huw Edwards, once the BBC's most senior news presenter, has pleaded guilty to three counts of making indecent images of children.

He admitted having 41 indecent images of children, which had been sent to him by another man on WhatsApp, Westminster Magistrates' Court heard.

They included seven category A images, the most serious classification - two of which showed a child aged between about seven and nine.

Police later revealed the man who sent the images to Edwards was a convicted paedophile.

Until last year, Edwards was one of the main presenters on BBC One's News at Ten and often fronted coverage of major national events.

The BBC said it was "shocked" and he would have been sacked if he had been charged before he left the corporation in April.

"There can be no place for such abhorrent behaviour and our

thoughts are with all those affected," it added.

The BBC also said it had been "made aware in confidence that he had been arrested on suspicion of serious offences and released on bail" last November.

Edwards had already been suspended in relation to different allegations but remained employed on full pay until he left on "medical advice" three months ago.

He was charged last month and could now face a jail sentence. He will next appear in court on 16 September.

Edwards was flanked by police officers and surrounded by photographers as he entered and left the court on Wednesday.

He was expressionless outside court and inside the hearing, which lasted for less than half an hour.

As the charges were read to him, he replied "guilty" three times, quietly and calmly.

The court heard he had been involved in online chat on WhatsApp from

December 2020 with an adult man, who sent him 377 sexual images, of which 41 were indecent images of children.

Under the law, images can mean both video clips and still pictures. The Crown Prosecution Service said most of

the category A images were estimated to show children aged between 13 and 15. Two clips showed a child aged about seven to nine.

Category A images show serious abuse including penetrative sexual activity.

He also had 12 category B pictures, which involve non-penetrative sexual activity, and 22 photographs in category C, which covers other indecent images. The category B and C pictures showed children aged between 12 to 15.

Losing Whose Marbles? Labour softens over treasures' move to Greece

SIR KEIR Starmer has softened Britain's stance on ownership of the Elgin Marbles - as he cosies up to EU partners.

Answering a written Commons question last Friday, culture minister Chris Bryant deferred the decision about whether to loan the statues to Greece up to the British Museum.

He said: "Decisions relating to the care and management of the museum's collections, including loaning objects from their collection, are a matter for the trustees of the British Museum, in accordance with the

British Museum Act 1963.

"We are aware that the chair of the trustees, George Osborne, has had talks with Greek ministers on the issue, seeking a constructive partnership."

But Mr Bryant said the artworks (pictured, right) were acquired "lawfully" from Greece, and remain the legal property of the British Museum.

Former chancellor Mr Osborne has been lobbying the Government for years to agree a loans deal with Greece. Referring the decision to him

41 years on, graduating student no longer punished for parrot poop

A man has graduated 41 years late after a rent dispute with his former university.

Jonny Clothier was forced to leave a student flat in 1983 when it was damaged by a friend's parrot that had been left unsupervised.

He failed to pay the outstanding £64.80 in rent to the University of Bristol, which subsequently denied him access to his

degree ceremony.

Mr Clothier, 62, from Petersfield, Hampshire, was finally allowed to graduate on Thursday on the same day as his youngest son.

He added that his graduation day on Thursday had been "enormous fun".

His son Carter, 21, who completed a biology degree, said: "It's definitely a unique experience

graduating with your dad, but it was an amazing day and a beautiful ceremony."

The university said it had decided to forgive the debt.

Its vice-chancellor, Prof Evelyn Welch, said: "We are so pleased that Jonny, Carter and the rest of the family had such a great day and we wish them all the best of luck in the future."

Omagh Inquiry vows to 'fearlessly' find the truth

AN inquiry into the Omagh bomb atrocity that killed 29 people will seek the truth "rigorously and fearlessly", its chairman vowed.

Bereaved families and survivors arrived on Monday for the first day of the public hearing.

Judge Lord Turnbull's inquiry will examine whether the massacre could reasonably have been prevented by UK authorities.

The attack on August 15, 1998 was carried out by a dissident republican group months after the Good Friday Agreement and also killed a woman pregnant with twins.

The names of those who lost their lives were read out at the hearing at Strule Arts Centre in the County Tyrone town

while all solemnly stood for a minute's silence in their memory.

Lord Turnbull said the pain of bereavement and trauma caused by the attack spread beyond Omagh and Northern Ireland to families from England and Spain.

'very hopeful'

The bombing caused "outrage and consternation across national boundaries and across continents", he added.

Lord Turnbull said the inquiry will undertake its task rigorously and fearlessly and the "defining character must be its independence".

He said "the value which the inquiry attaches to its independence means that it will not be amenable to influence

from any government or from any state agency. It will not allow itself to be deflected from its purpose by the difficulties which may lie in its way on account of the passage of time or the volume and complexity of materials."

Michael Gallagher, whose son Aiden died, said: "It has taken us 26 years to get here and we're just delighted. It's a long time but we are where we want to be and we just have to wait and see where this inquiry takes us."

Stanley McCombe, who lost his wife Ann, said he had faith in Lord Turnbull and his legal team, adding: "After years of hard labour we're very, very hopeful".

Lawrence's body to return to the UK

Stephen Lawrence's body will be returned to the UK from Jamaica 31 years after his racist murder, his mother Doreen Lawrence has said.

The Lawrence family laid the 18-year-old to rest overseas because they felt "he would not be at peace in this country".

Mr Lawrence, who was black British and from Plumstead, south-east London, was killed in a racially motivated attack while wait-

ing for a bus in Eltham in April 1993.

Only two of his five or six killers have been brought to justice.

The original police investigation into the 18-year-old's death was marred by institutional racism in the Metropolitan Police, incompetence and alleged corruption.

In a statement issued through her lawyer, Baroness Lawrence said: "My family and I have been

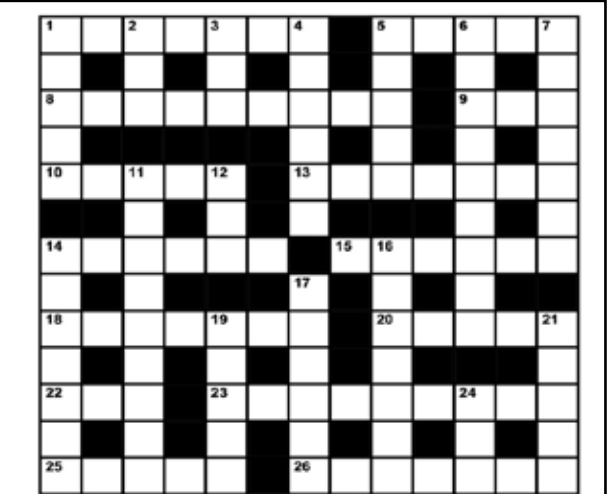
made aware of the recent images of my son's grave that have been circulated on social media.

"After 31 years, we have decided as a family that we would like to bring Stephen home to be closer to us."

Years after the original police investigation into Mr Lawrence's death, it emerged that undercover police officers had spied on campaigners supporting the Lawrence family in their fight for justice.

away the tourists, who began the day on 33-2, for 175 in their second innings. Set 82 for victory skipper Ben Stokes then hit England's fastest-ever Test half-century off just 24 balls, as he stepped in to open the batting. Stokes, who finished unbeaten on 57, had opened with fellow left-hander Ben Duckett after regular opener Zak Crawley suffered a broken finger in the field. He thrilled supporters with some archetypal Ba-

zball hitting in a carefree knock which included nine fours and two sixes as the hosts romped to the target in just 7.2 overs. West Indies had earlier shown some resistance thanks to a maiden Test fifty for Mikyle Louis, while Kavem Hodge also made a measured half-century, before Wood supercharged the atmosphere with a superb spell. This was the first time in his Test career that Wood has taken five wickets in a single spell.

Paris provides silver lining to Tom's golden career

BRITAIN'S greatest diver Tom Daley ended his distinguished Olympic career with a golden glow about him - despite having to settle for second-placed silver. Tom claimed his fifth Olympic medal in as many Games, having made his debut aged 14 at the Beijing 2008.

But after winning gold last time out in Tokyo the 30-year-old and 10 metre synchro partner Noah Williams on Monday failed to topple China's world champions Lian Junjie and Yang Hao. Yet despite taking two years out before ending his retirement last year, Tom managed to "complete the set of having a medal in every colour". An emotional Tom

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Storming finish gives Yee Triathlon gold

ALEX YEE added to Team GB's remarkable record in the Olympic Triathlon by securing an unlikely gold medal in Paris.

Since the sport was added to the Olympic roster in 2000, no country can match Britain's medal haul, but Yee seemed unlikely to add another gold to the total with barely a mile to go in Wednesday's contest. At that point New Zealand's Hayden Wilde enjoyed a 14 second lead in the events third and final discipline, the 10,000m run.

But suddenly Yee found a second wind and the Kiwi hit the wall. To gasps of astonishment on Pont Alexandre III, with its gilded bronze statues bathed in sunshine, it was the 26-year-old sports science graduate from Lewisham who appeared first on the blue carpet. It was the team's second unlikely come-from-behind win in three days after Tom Pidcock had overturned prohibitive odds to win mountain bike gold after a puncture saw him slipping 40 seconds off the pace before storming back over the last mile to

win in a photo-finish. "I didn't even know I could catch him until I caught him," said Yee. "It was one of those mad moments where everything just fell into place. "At 5km to go I was going through a really bad patch and with 2.5km left I thought, 'I'm going to give myself one last chance at this and not give up' - and here we are." Yee was so stunned to find himself following two-time triathlon champion Alistair Brownlee into Olympic legend that he did not even celebrate as he breasted the tape. He said: "It was a bit of disbelief that I was the

first person to cross the finish line. In my head I probably thought second, with the guys closing rapidly behind, was the best thing but I just didn't want to give up. "I owed it to myself, I owed it to so many guys that came out to watch, who waited after the postponements and all the chaos. "It goes without saying this is my greatest win. But as much as winning the gold medal, I feel like I extracted everything out of myself and that's one of the things I'm most proud about." When shell-shocked Wilde trailed home as

runner-up, he shared an iconic moment with Yee, sat on the ground like brothers. It turns out that Yee, a former British 10,000m champion, and Wilde used to be room-mates as well as standard-bearers for sportsmanship. Yee, a silver medalist in Tokyo three years ago, added: "It's just an appreciation for each other. When there is that one person that pushes you to those new limits, I have so much appreciation for him. "From our first Super League we shared rooms and he's a top mate as well as a top racer."

Tearful exit for Andy Murray

■ Paris 2024: Tennis legend bows out after straight sets defeat in doubles quarter finals

British tennis icon Andy Murray's illustrious career ended with a straight-set defeat in the Olympic men's doubles quarter-finals on Thursday.

Murray, the two-time Olympic singles champion, and Dan Evans lost 6-2 6-4 to American third seeds Taylor Fritz and Tommy Paul before exiting the court in tears.

Murray, 37, confirmed before the Paris Games that it would be his final event before retiring from the sport.

"I'm proud of my career, my achievements and what I put into the sport," said Murray.

After a long hug with Evans at the baseline, Murray was visibly emotional at the noise created by the fans at Roland Garros chanting his name in appreciation.

Evans gently encouraged his team-mate to

go into the centre of the court for one final time and Murray waved to all sides before disappearing to the locker room.

Speaking shortly afterwards, Murray said he was "ready" for retirement.

"Obviously it was emotional because it's the last time I will play a competitive match," he said.

"But I am genuinely happy just now. I'm happy with how it finished.

"I'm glad I got to go out here at the Olympics and finish on my terms because at times in the last few years that wasn't a certainty."

Murray is no stranger to getting emotional in public, of course.

Most famously, there were the tears on Wimbledon's Centre Court after losing to Roger Federer in the 2012 final, finally endearing him to a larger share of the British pub-

lic.

"This isn't going to be easy..." he said to Sue Barker on court post-match that day, before the tears came.

Before that, he welled up after losing the 2010 Australian Open final to Roger Federer - quipping he could "cry like Roger... it's a shame I can't play like him".

Once he did land that Grand Slam title - and two more after that - it was injury that led to more tears.

In 2018, he sobbed uncontrollably under his towel at the Washington Open as he battled through hip pain.

On the eve of the 2019 Australian Open, Murray broke down in a pre-tournament news conference when he revealed he would have to retire because of impending hip resurfacing surgery, which he thought would

end his career.

Five and a half years later, and after squeezing every last drop out of his comeback, Murray was finally content to call it a day.

"It's been really hard. Physically, pain-wise, I feel bad," he said.

"Physically, I can obviously go on the court and perform at a level that's competitive.

"We were close to getting in the medal rounds here. That's OK but the pain and discomfort in my body is not good and that's also why I'm happy to be finishing."

Carlos off as Villa lose in friendly

Diego Carlos was sent off in Aston Villa's friendly defeat by RB Leipzig in New Jersey on Thursday.

The Brazilian defender was dismissed after two yellow-card offences in the first half as Villa lost 2-0 to their German opponents.

Carlos, who joined Villa from Sevilla in 2022, was booked for separate altercations with Leipzig goalscorer Lois Openda.

Andre Silva also scored for Leipzig, with both goals coming before half-time.

Villa boss Unai Emery, who lost Sweden goalkeeper Robin Olsen to injury, preferred to focus on the performance of new signing Amadou Onana rather than Carlos' red card.

Midfielder Onana signed for Villa from Everton in a £50m deal in July.

"Onana is progressively getting better," said Emery.

"It was a test. In the first half I think we were good, even losing 2-0 due to two mistakes.

"After the red card it was a completely different match."

Chelsea secured their first victory under new manager Enzo Maresca by sweeping to a 3-0 win over Club America in Atlanta.

Two of Chelsea's three goals were penalties by Christopher Nkunku and Noni Madueke while Marc Guiu also scored.

Argentina midfielder Enzo Fernandez came on

at the start of the second half.

His appearance came after it emerged Chelsea would take no action against Fernandez for singing a derogatory song about France's black players, after he apologized to several French team-mates.

"You can see that he is a bit behind. In terms of his physical conditioning, he was a bit slow," said Maresca when asked about Fernandez's contribution.

"He had one or two sessions with us so 45 minutes today was just another chance to give him another session.

"These kinds of games, we also use them like a training session, and for Enzo today was a very good training session."
