MANDY'S U-TURN ON 'RECKLESS' TRUMP

■ Blair's former spin doctor sees the light after being tapped as next Ambassador to Washington

FORMER LABOUR Svengali Lord Mandelson was forced into an embarrassing U-turn this week over his earlier blistering criticism of Donald Trump.

Mandelson, who made his name as Labour's director of communications in the late 1980s and is widely credited with helping get Tony Blair first elected, has been named the next UK Ambassador to Washington DC...which makes his earlier description of Trump as reckless and "a bully," highly inconvenient.

But this week, the man formerly dubbed "The Prince of Darkness" by the UK tabloids was all sweetness and light, conceding that his past remarks were "ill-judged and wrong." His diplomatic shift is seen as a significant move in securing his appointment, as Trump's approval is a necessary step in the formalization of his role.

Speaking in an interview with Fox News, Mandelson acknowledged that his perception of Trump has evolved. He stated that Trump had won "fresh respect" from him, and he expressed confidence that the former

president would approve his appointment. "I think that President Trump will look at my credentials and consider what's best for the relationship going forward," Mandelson said, hopefully.

Departure

Mandelson's recent comments mark a stark departure from his earlier criticisms. In 2019, during an interview with an Italian journalist, he labeled Trump "reckless and a danger to the world." A year prior, he had told the Evening Standard that Trump was "a bully." These statements aligned with broader European concerns about Trump's leadership style and policies at the time. However, in his latest interview, Mandelson suggested that these remarks were made in a politically charged environment and do not reflect his current view of Trump.

"I made those remarks six years ago in 2019, led rather along this by an

Italian journalist," he explained. "It was a time in Britain, by the way, with very fraught politics, and there was high emotion about many things in Britain at that time." He added that attitudes towards Trump have since evolved, both personally and politically, and he now sees the former president's leadership in a different light.

Approval

As part of the diplomatic appointment process, Mandelson's credentials must be formally presented to Trump, who is expected to approve the selection. Given Mandelson's past statements, there had been speculation about whether Trump would block the appointment. Some of Trump's allies had even suggested that he might take the unusual step of rejecting Mandelson's diplomatic credentials.

Chris LaCivita, Trump's co-presidential campaign manager, was particu-

larly vocal in his opposition, previously stating that Mandelson should "stay home" and calling him "an absolute moron" due to his past criticisms of Trump. Despite such remarks, Mandelson has reportedly received his "agrément" from the US government - a crucial step indicating that his appointment has been accepted by Washington.

The final stage in the process will be Mandelson's formal presentation of his "letter of credence" to Trump. This ceremonial step is expected to take place in Washington, D.C., next week, solidifying his status as the UK's new ambassador to the

United States.

Outwardly at least, the Starmer government seems untroubled by the possibility that Mandelson's appointment could be blocked. While some members of the Conservative Party have been wary of how Trump might react, there has been no indication from the White House that Mandelson's appointment will face any formal resistance.

A spokesperson for the UK Foreign Office stated, "Lord Mandelson is HMA-designate, and the formal diplomatic process is ongoing." The US State Department has also been contacted for comment but has not provided any

official statement regarding the appointment.

Mandelson's public acknowledgment of his previous misjudgments about Trump goes further than many other UK officials who have criticized the former president in the past. UK Foreign Secretary David Lammy, for instance, has generally deflected questions about his previous critiques of Trump by pointing out that many senior Republicans had also criticized him at various times. Mandelson, however, has taken a more direct approach by explicitly recanting his past statements and emphasizing

Chancellor backs third runway for Heathrow

■ **Reeves vows to kick-start sluggish economy and claims 'growth corridor' will create 'Europe's Silicon Valley'**

Rachel Reeves has backed a third runway at London's Heathrow Airport as part of a fresh plan to get the UK's sluggish economy growing.

In a speech to business leaders, the chancellor said Heathrow expansion, delayed for decades over environmental concerns, would "make Britain the world's best connected place to do business".

She told the BBC she wanted to get a planning application "signed off" before the next election.

Reeves also backed expansions at Luton and Gatwick airports, as well as a "growth corridor" between Oxford and Cambridge, which she claimed could be "Europe's Silicon Valley".

The Tories welcomed the plans, most of which leader Kemi Badenoch said had been stolen from her party.

But she claimed any prospect of growth would be "destroyed" by the government's Employment Rights Bill, which she said would place more burdens on business.

In her speech in Oxford, Reeves sought to inject some optimism and con-

fidence into the economy, which has taken a battering in recent months as growth has flatlined.

She hit back at Conservative claims that her "job destroying" Budget was to blame, insisting she had "no alternative" but to increase employers' National Insurance to restore stability.

'huge potential'

She did not explicitly rule out further tax increases in the spring - but insisted the government had "begun to turn things round" and was determined to go "further and faster" to boost growth.

She described the UK as a country of "huge potential" which had been "held back" for "too long" because politicians lacked the "courage" to challenge the status quo.

"Low growth is not our destiny, but growth will not come without a fight, without a government willing to take the right decisions now to change our country's future for the better," she added.

The government has made growth its top priority because so many of its other plans - to improve public services and living standards, as well

as its chances of winning the next election - depend on it.

Ministers insist advances in aviation mean a third runway would not break its carbon reduction rules - but it is still being fiercely resisted by environmental campaigners and Labour's London Mayor Sadiq Khan.

redevelopment

Reeves said she wants a planning application for a third runway at Heathrow "signed off" before the next election, which must happen by 2029.

She said she wanted to "get going sooner than that" on the next phase of an East-West rail project that will eventually connect Oxford directly to Cambridge, via Milton Keynes and Bedford.

"I want spades in the ground. I want people to see in their areas, things happening, growth happening, their children and their grandchildren in the future having the opportunity to work in high-skilled high-paid jobs contributing to the economy with more money in their pockets," she said.

Earlier she claimed the new Oxford and Cambridge "growth corridor", which includes new reservoirs to address water shortages in the area and investment in high tech industries, would add up to £78bn to the UK econo-

my by 2035.

Other projects announced include a major redevelopment of Old Trafford, the area around a new stadium for Manchester United, and a plan to bring Doncaster/Sheffield airport back into use and boost industry at East Midlands airport.

Trade unions welcomed the Heathrow announcement and the airport's chief executive Thomas Woldbye described the chancellor's speech as "the bold, responsible vision the UK needs to thrive in the 21st century".

Abramovitch may owe UK taxman £1bn

Former Chelsea owner Roman Abramovitch may owe the UK up to £1 billion after a botched attempt to avoid tax on hedge fund investments.

Already sanctioned by the UK, like many other Russian oligarchs, Mr Abramovitch - a long-term ally of Vladimir Putin - is now believed to be living between locations in Russia, Israel and Turkey.

Leaked papers uncovered by the probe reveal investments worth £4.7 billion were routed through firms in the British Virgin Islands.

However, the evidence suggests they were managed from the

UK, so should have been taxed there.

It is understood some of the money that funded Chelsea FC when Mr Abramovitch, 58, owned it can also be traced to companies involved in the scheme, the joint BBC and the Bureau of Investigative Journalism found.

The oligarch's lawyers said he "always obtained independent expert professional tax and legal advice" and "acted in accordance with that advice".

Mr Abramovitch denies having any knowledge of or being personally responsible for any unpaid tax.

Top Tory: Reform's gains could 'bring an end to the two party system'

A SENIOR Conservative fears Nigel Farage's Reform UK could make huge gains in May's local elections and the age of "two-party politics" may be over.

Former Tory chairman Sir Brandon Lewis issued a warning to colleagues after a series of polls suggested his party is currently in a three-way tie with Reform and Labour, with roughly equal levels of public support. He said Labour had suffered a series of "own-goals" in power but the Conservatives led by Kemi Badenoch "don't have long" to convince voters that they are the party with "a serious and tangible offering" for government.

'huge gains'

Sir Brandon said: "Conservatives need to reconnect with voters by pursuing policies that are true to traditional values. Regional elections are likely to be difficult for all mainstream parties. Reform could make huge gains and cause big losses, even in places where they do not win outright. No sensible politician can afford to ignore Reform or its supporters."

"There is a very real possibility we are seeing the beginning of the end of the two-party system."

Sir Brandon was chair while Theresa May was PM and served as Northern Ireland Secretary under Boris Johnson. He stood down as an MP last year.

■ New submarine undergoes name change ‘to avoid upsetting the French’

The King was reportedly behind the decision to veto a new Navy submarine being called HMS Agincourt to avoid upsetting the French over their historic defeat.

Charles torpedoed the vessel's original name, approved by Queen Elizabeth in 2018, and the £1.5-billion sub is now to be called HMS Achilles.

His Majesty was understood to be concerned that naming the under-construction hunter-killer sub after the 1415 battle would remind the French of their defeat to the British. It had previously been approved by the late Queen Elizabeth, it is understood.

The decision was branded “woke nonsense” by former defence secretary Grant Shapps, according to multiple reports.

The name change was announced last week and followed reports of concern within the Ministry of Defence that the original name for the vessel may have offended the French.

battle honours

Agincourt refers to a battle England won against France, as part of the Hundred Years' War, which was immortalized by Shakespeare in his play, Henry V.

The move was also called “woke” and “pathetic” by another former Tory defence

minister, Sir Gavin Williamson. It's not clear whether Sir Gavin or Shapps were aware that King Charles supported efforts to find another name.

Both the Palace and the MoD declined to comment on his involvement.

Discussions about renaming the submarine - which is being built in Barrow, Cumbria - started more than a year ago - while Shapps was still in office.

One defence source suggested the King had initiated those discussions.

The names of ships and submarines are put forward by the Royal Navy's Ships' Names

and Badging Committee and then approved by the monarch.

HMS Agincourt was the name agreed under Queen Elizabeth II, but defence sources say King Charles wanted another name and has given his approval to HMS Achilles instead.

The Royal Navy said “the name was pro-

posed by the Royal Navy Ships' Names and Badging Committee and approved by his Majesty the King”.

The Navy said HMS Achilles was particularly appropriate as this year marked the 80th anniversary of the end of World War Two, in which an earlier HMS Achilles received battle

honours.

The original name, HMS Agincourt, was first announced in 2018, by Sir Gavin.

It would have been the sixth Royal Navy vessel to bear the name of the famous victory, where English longbow routed the previously invincible French heavily armored-knights.

Palace confirms Beatrice has given birth to a daughter

Princess Beatrice gives birth to daughter Athena Princess Beatrice has given birth to her second child, named Athena, Buckingham Palace has announced.

Athena was born several weeks prematurely and weighed 4lb 5oz, but is said to be healthy and doing well.

The new baby, the second child of Beatrice and her husband Edoardo Mapelli Mozzi, was born a week ago on 22 January at the Chelsea and Westminster Hospital in London.

The King and Queen and other members of the Royal Family were said to be delighted at the ba-

by's safe arrival, said the Palace.

Beatrice had been due to give birth in early Spring, but in December had received medical advice not to travel long distances.

So instead of spending Christmas overseas with her husband's family as planned, Beatrice and her

husband and children had spent Christmas with the Royal Family at Sandringham.

The official photo issued of the new baby Athena shows her wrapped in a blanket, with her hand covering her face, presumably because of concerns about privacy.

In a social media post, her father Edoardo said: “She is tiny and absolutely perfect” and the family was “completely besotted with her”.

Athena, is the grand-

child of Prince Andrew, the Duke of York, and Sarah, the Duchess of York. She becomes 11th in line to the throne.

“She is already so adored and I'm incredibly blessed to be a granny once again. So proud of Edo, Beatrice and the rest of my little 5-a-side team,” posted the duchess on social media.

The statement from Buckingham Palace gave the baby's full name as Athena Elizabeth Rose Mapelli Mozzi, born last Wednesday at 12.57pm.

Beatrice, aged 36, and her daughter are both doing well, said the Palace, and the family are spending time with Athena's older siblings Wolfie - Mr Mapelli Mozzi's son from a previous relationship - and Sienna.

Beatrice tied the knot with property tycoon Edoardo, 41, in a secret lockdown wedding in 2020, attended by her late grandparents.

He is the son of ex-Olympic skier Count Alessandro Mapelli Mozzi, 73.

Charles moved to tears at Auschwitz memorial

■ King joins other heads of state at ceremony marking 80th anniversary of liberation of Nazi death camp

King Charles was moved to tears this week after becoming the first British monarch to visit the Auschwitz-Birkenau Nazi concentration camp in Poland.

The monarch appeared to shed a tear while he listened to the stories of those who survived the former Nazi concentration camp as he sat with other world leaders to mark 80 years since its liberation.

Survivors were applauded as they entered the ceremony before addressing invited guests including France's President Emmanuel Macron, German Chancellor Olaf Scholz, Spain's King Philip VI and Queen Letizia, Ukraine's president Volodymyr Zelensky and King Willem Alexander

and Queen Maxima of the Netherlands.

Laying a wreath inside the site the King was visibly moved with aides saying he was determined to see the reality of what went on there with his own eyes.

'deeply personal'

Taken to Block 5, accompanied by an experienced guide, Charles saw the piles of shoes exhibited in a stark reminder of the industrialized murder of Jews, and other enemies of the Nazis.

A source close to the King told the BBC his visit to the camp on Monday evening was a "deeply personal pilgrimage" for the monarch and something he found "poignant and profound."

He laid a wreath at the

death wall where those condemned were executed.

Earlier, the King was welcomed by dignitaries as he landed on a Royal Air Force plane at Krakow Airport before visiting the Jewish Community Centre (JCC) in the city.

'violence and hate'

There, he met Holocaust survivors and heard from volunteers and members about the JCC's support for people as part of its mission to rebuild Jewish life in the city.

The King said that the 'evil' of the Holocaust should ensure the world will never again 'be a bystander in the face of violence and hate'.

Describing his visit to Poland as a 'sombre



Charles described the memorial as 'poignant and profound'

and sacred moment', Charles remembered the six million victims of the 'hatred and violence' of Hitler's Nazi regime, pointing out that the anniversary was a timely reminder.

Over a million people, including Jews,

Poles, Soviet prisoners of war and other nationalities, were murdered by the Nazis at Auschwitz-Birkenau during World War Two.

King Charles, 76, was photographed listening intently to Auschwitz survivors recall their

stories of surviving the Nazi death camp.

The service was held in front of the gates of the former Nazi concentration camp which reads: "Arbeit Macht Frei." This directly translates to "work sets you free".

Chinese student in London was 'persistent sexual predator' and 'rapist', court told

■ Zhenhao Zou accused of drugging and raping ten women

A PhD student who was studying in the UK appears to be "a smart and charming young man" but is in fact "a persistent sexual predator, a voyeur and a rapist", a jury has been told.

Zhenhao Zou, a Chinese national, is on trial at Inner London Crown Court accused of drugging and raping 10 women.

The substances alleged to be involved in the offences are MDMA, butanediol, ketamine and alprazolam, which is also known under the brand name Xanax.

The 27-year-old denies all 35 charges he faces including 11 counts of rape, three counts of voyeurism, 12 of possession of extreme pornography, one of false imprisonment and eight of possession of a controlled drug with intent to supply.

The court heard Mr

Zou, from Elephant and Castle in south London, first came to the UK from China in September 2017 to study at Queen's University in Belfast and also studied for a master's degree at University College London from 2019 through to 2021 before beginning a PhD at the same university.

'totally vulnerable'

Outlining the prosecution's case, Catherine Farrelly KC said the accused was "a persistent sexual predator; a voyeur and a rapist".

"To the outside world, he undoubtedly presents as a smart and charming young man," Ms Farrelly told the court.

"The prosecution's case at this trial is that he would meet women, he would stupefy them, either with drugs or with alcohol, and, once they were significantly under

the influence of those drinks or drugs, he would then rape them."

Ms Farrelly explained to the jury several recordings would be shown during the trial, which the prosecution alleges were "the defendant's souvenirs of many rapes that he had committed; items that he kept for his own private sexual gratification so that he could watch, at his leisure, his rapes of these women who he had rendered unconscious and totally vulnerable to his will".

She added "most of the rapes in this case were only discovered by police after they had attended the defendant's home address, searched it, seized various items from it and then examined them".

Police have identified two of the alleged victims but not the remaining eight, the court was told.

It is claimed that there

are video recordings relating to nine of the 10 alleged rape victims, for which Mr Zou is charged with possessing extreme pornographic images. The jury heard there were also two other recordings in which the male involved cannot be identified.

Ms Farrelly told the jury the first woman to make allegations against Mr Zou contacted police in May 2023 to claim he had raped her after not

allowing her to leave his flat.

She did not pursue the allegation at that point but later in February 2024 investigators found a social media post in which the woman gave her account of what had happened, jurors were told.

Ms Farrelly told the court that when contacted by detectives, the woman said they had been drinking wine together at his flat in May 2023 and the woman "began to find the

defendant odd".

She tried to leave but Mr Zou told a friend who popped in that she was too drunk to walk and he could not let her go, the court heard.

When the woman tried to run out of the flat, he dragged her back by her clothes and later pressured her to drink a big glass of vodka, jurors were told. The woman claims he raped her while she was unconscious.

Owner of killer XL bully dog jailed for three years

A MAN whose XL bully dog escaped and killed his neighbour has been jailed for three years.

Christopher Bell, 45, ran out of his house barefoot to chase Ian Langley, 54, for breaking his window.

Newcastle Crown Court heard Bell left the door open, allowing his two XL bully dogs to join the chase.

The animals overtook their owner and the larger one, Titan, knocked Mr Langley to the ground and latched on to his neck, causing unsurvivable injuries in Shiney Row, near Sunderland, in October 2023.

Bell was eventually able to pull the dog off Mr Langley and drag him back to his house before returning to the scene and calling emergency services.

Mr Langley's son Jayke Langley said: "My father Ian Langley was not only loved by everyone in the community, he was also my role model and best influence in my life."

Since the ban on the dogs was introduced, police have seized more than 4,500 dogs – but cash-strapped forces fear the move has sent their costs rocketing by 500%.

They are expecting the grim news by the end of the financial year.

It is illegal to own an

XL bully in England and Wales without an exemption certificate, which requires the dog be neutered, microchipped, kept on a lead and muzzled in public.

In addition, owners cannot breed, sell, or give them away.

Mark Hobrough, National Police Chiefs' Council senior officer for dangerous dogs, said: "Since the introduction of the ban on XL bullies, police services have had to quickly adapt.

"We have taken positive action to respond to thousands of calls from the public and are doing everything we can to remove these dangerous dogs from our communities.

"Undoubtedly, the ban and our response has driven down the number of dog attacks and we are pleased the public continues to support us by reporting suspected XL bully dogs in their local area. However, the demand has been and continues to be simply huge.

"We are facing a number of challenges in kennel capacity, resourcing and ever-mounting costs. As of today, we have not received any additional funding to account for this."

Mr Hobrough added: "Vet bills and the cost of kennelling across policing

has risen from £4million in 2018 to currently more than £11million – and this is expected to rise to as much as £25million by the end of April 2025. That's a predicted 500% increase."

Police took in and destroyed 848 dangerous dogs from February to September last year at an estimated cost of £340,000.

These XL bullies, a breed which originated in the US, were given up last year by owners who had not obeyed the ban or taken advantage of the compensation scheme.

In the same period, 4,586 suspected illegal dangerous dog breeds were seized. Their owners and breeders now face criminal convictions, fines and imprisonment.

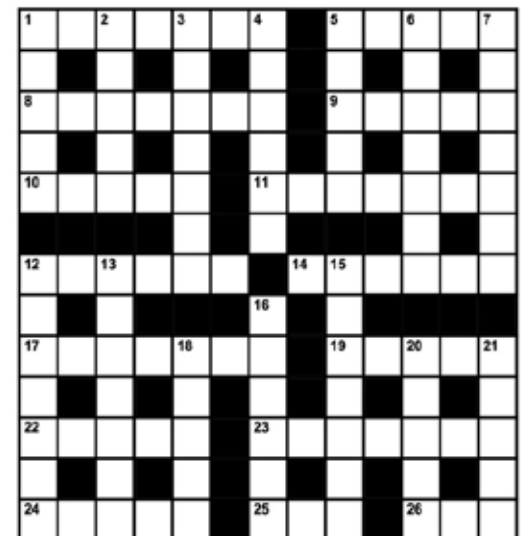

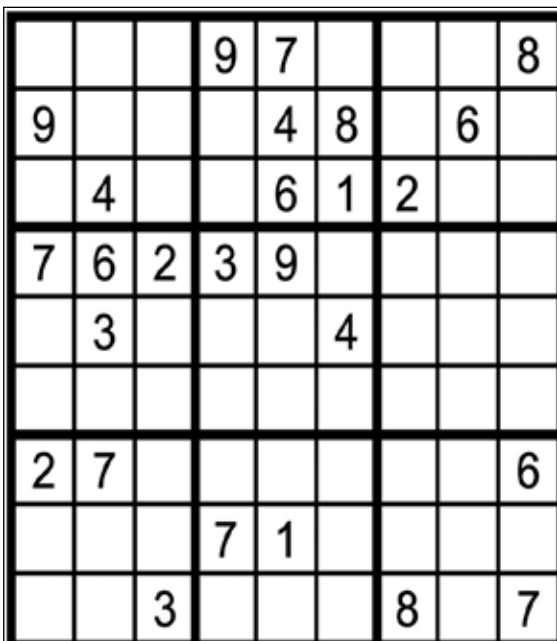

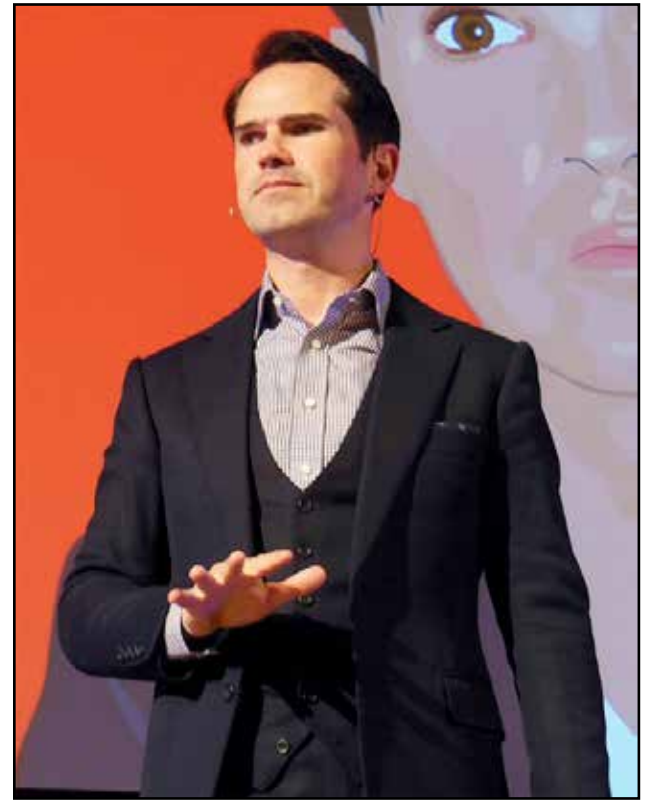

Extraterritorial service. – When the defendant does not reside and is not found in the Philippines, and the action affects the personal status of the plaintiff or relates to, or the subject of which is, property within the Philippines, in which the defendant has or claims a lien or interest, actual or contingent, or in which the relief demanded consists, wholly or in part, in excluding the defendant from any interest therein, or the property of the defendant has been attached within the Philippines by personal service as under Section 6; or by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in such places and for such time as the court may order, in which case a copy of the summons and order of the court shall be sent by registered mail to the last known address of the defendant, or in any other manner the court may deem sufficient. Any order granting such leave shall specify a reasonable time, which shall not be less than sixty (60) days after notice, within the defendant must answer.

Breaking down said provision, there are only four instances wherein a defendant who is a non-resident and is not found in the country may be served with summons by extraterritorial service: (1) when the action affects the personal status of the plaintiff; (2) when the action relates to, or the subject of which is property, within the Philippines, in which the defendant claims a lien or an interest, actual or contingent; (3) when the relief demanded in such action consists, wholly or in part, in excluding the defendant from any interest in property located in the Philippines; and (4) when the defendant non-resident’s property has been attached within the Philippines.

In the above instances, extraterritorial service of summons may be effected under any of three modes: (1) by personal service out of the country, with leave of court; (2) by publication and sending a copy of the summons and order of the court by registered mail to the defendant’s last known address, also with leave of court; or (3) by any other means the judge may consider sufficient.”

Also relevant is the case of Heirs of Morales v. Morales Agustin which enunciated that:

“The partition of real estate is an action quasi in rem. Jurisprudence is replete with pronouncements that, for the court to acquire jurisdiction in actions quasi in rem, it is necessary only that it has jurisdiction over the res. In the case of Macasaet v. Co, Jr., the Court stated that jurisdiction over the defendant in an action in rem or quasi in rem is not required, and the court acquires jurisdiction over an action as long as it acquires jurisdiction over the res that is the subject matter of long action.

In case of De Pedro v. Romanson Development Corporation, the Court clarified that while this is so, “to satisfy the requirements of due process, jurisdiction over the parties in rem and quasi in rem actions is required. Thus, regardless of the nature of the action, proper service of summons is imperative and that a decision rendered without proper service of summons suffers a defect in jurisdiction.”

Applying the foregoing jurisprudential principles in the instant case and considering the plaintiff’s Complaint and her supporting Judicial Affidavit, setting forth the fact that defendants David Holcombe and Asuncion A. Crelencia do not reside and are not found in the Philippines, and the action relates to, or the subject of which is, property within the Philippines in which the defendant has or claims a lien or interest actual or contingent, where the relief demanded consists wholly or in part, in excluding the defendant from any interest therein, this Court finds plaintiff’s entreaty to be meritorious and thus, hereby GRANTS leave of court and allows, at the expense of the plaintiff, the service of summons on the said defendants by publication once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the United States of America (U.S.A.) or, in particular, in the State of California.

Let copies of the summons and the Complaint, as well as this Order, be sent by registered mail to the last known addresses of defendants DAVID HOLCOMBE and ASUNCION A. CRELENCIA.

Defendants DAVID HOLCOMBE and ASUNCION A. CRELENCIA are hereby directed to file their respective Answers within sixty (60) calendar days from date of last publication.

Finding also the instant Complaint to be compliant with 2019 Amendments to the 1997 Revised Rules of Civil Procedure, the Branch Clerk of Court is hereby directed to issue Summons to be remaining defendants.

COMPLAINT

COMES NOW, plaintiff through undersigned counsel and unto this Honorable Court, most respectfully avers: THAT-

A. THE PARTIES

1. Plaintiff ANA CASILDA A. APACIBLE is of legal age, Filipino, single, and a resident of 3544-A Lingayen St., Brgy. 605, Zone 60 Sta. Mesa, Manila 1016, where she may be personally served with orders, notices, decisions, resolutions and other court processes;

2. Defendant heirs of Teresita A. Seda are GALICANO A. SEDA, of legal age, Filipino, and a resident of 3544 Lingayen St. Sta.Mesa, Manila 1016 and VINCENT A. SEDA, is of legal age, Filipino, and a resident of 38 Cadena de Amor St. Andrea 1 Village, Brgy. Panapaan VI, Bacoor, Cavite 4102, where they could respectively be personally served summons, orders, notices, decisions, resolutions and other court processes;

3. Defendant heir of Lourdes A. Holcombe is DAVID HOLCOMBE, of legal age, American Citizen, and a resident of 1770 Wright St. Pomona, California 91766 U.S.A.;

4. Defendant ASUNCION A. CRELENCIA, is of legal age, Filipino citizen, and a resident of 1911 Denison St. Pomona, California 91766 U.S.A.;

5. For the last two defendants, leave of court shall hereby be requested from this Honorable Court to serve summons by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in such places and for such time as the court may order, and a copy of the summons and order of the court shall be sent by registered mail to their abovementioned last known addresses, or in any other manner the court may deem sufficient, pursuant to extraterritorial service under Section 17 of Rule 14 of the 2019 Revised Rules of Civil Procedure.

Bulo, Victoria, Tarlac 2313, where they could respectively be personally served summons, orders, notices, decisions, resolutions and other court processes;

B. NATURE OF THE ACTION

9. This is an action for judicial partition involving a parcel of land, together with the improvements existing thereon, situated at No. 3544 Lingayen St. corner Bataan St., Brgy. 605, Zone 60, Sta. Mesa (formerly Sampaloc), Manila, with an area of 383.50 square meters, covered by Transfer Certificate of Title No. 002-2023000347, in the Registry of Deeds of the City of Manila, a true electronic copy of which is attached herewith marked as ANNEX “A” and made an integral part hereof; and more particularly described as follows:

A parcel of Land (Lot, No. 11 Block No. 6 of the subdivision plan Psd-23306, being a portion of the Lot No. 4-C-1-L-3-W of the subdivision plan Psd-21291, GLRO Record No. 7680), situated in the district of Sampaloc, City of Manila. Bounded on the NW. by street Lot No. 1 of the subdivision plan; on the SE. by Lot No. 2 and 3, Block No. 6 of the subdivision plan; on the SW and W by street Lot No. 6 of the subdivision plan. . . x x x . . . containing an area of Three Hundred and Eighty-Three Square Meters and Fifty Square Decimeters (383.50) more or less. . .

10. The subject property is currently declared for tax purposes in the Department of Assessment of the City of Manila, with an assessed value of the land at Php. 633,640.00 and market value of Php. 6,336,400.00. A building (house) standing thereon is also declared for tax purposes, with an assessed value of Php. 280,450.00 and market value of Php. 934,823.75 for the current year. Certified true copies of the Tax Declarations, are attached herewith, marked as ANNEXES “B” (land) and “C” (building), respectively, and made integral parts hereof.

11. In as much as the total assessed value of the subject property exceeds Php. 400,000.00, the jurisdiction of this civil action is with the Regional Trial Courts of the City of Manila, where the subject property is located, pursuant to Republic Act (R.A. 11576).

12. As shown in the certificate of title, the registered co-owners of the subject property are as follows:

(1.) Teresita A. Seda, married to Soriano E. Seda, both of legal ages, Filipino

Citizens;

(2.) Lourdes A. Holcombe, married to David Holcombe, both of legal age, Filipino

Citizens;

(1) and (2) with 1/2 share);

(3A.) Asuncion Apacible, married to Enriquee Crelencio, both of legal age,

Filipino citizens;

(3B) Ana Casilda A. Apacible, of legal age, single, Filipino citizen; and;

(3C) Dolores Apacible, of legal age, single, Filipino citizen;

(3A) thru (3C) with 1/2 share;

C. ANTECEDENT FACTS

13. The property is originally owned by the late spouses Alejandro Apacible, Sr., who passed away in 1983, and Corazon C. Apacible, who passed away in 1992.

14. Alejandro, Sr. and Corazon, were survived by their seven (7) children, namely: Asuncion A. Crelencia, Teresita A. Seda, Lourdes A. Holcombe, Elpidio C. Apacible, Alejandro C. Apacible, Jr., Manuel C. Apacible and Dolores C. Apacible.

15. The estate of the late Alejandro Apacible, Sr. was the subject of intestate proceedings with Spec. Proc. No. 1571 before the Regional Trial Court Branch XI in Balayan, Batangas, which rendered a Decision, dated 24 September 1990, approving an "Agreement and Complete Project of Partition" among the heirs.

16. Later, the heirs of Alejandro, Sr. and Corazon also executed exchange of shares involving other pieces of property, which eventually resulted in the subject Sta. Mesa property being allotted as follows:

Teresita A. Seda

Asuncion A. Crelencia

Lourdes A. Holcombe

Alejandro C. Apacible Jr.

Dolores C. Apacible

17. Meanwhile, Alejandro C. Apacible Jr. passed away on 12 February 2014, without leaving any will, and was survived by his widow Nenita A. Apacible and his daughter, herein plaintiff, ANA CASILDA A. APACIBLE.

18. Nenita A. Apacible waived all her rights and interest over the herein subject property in favor of plaintiff, ANA CASILDA A. APACIBLE. Thus, all the rights and interests of Alejandro C. Apacible Jr. thereto were transferred to his daughter, plaintiff, ANA CASILDA A. APACIBLE.

19. From the foregoing, plaintiff ANA CASILDA A. APACIBLE is a pro-indiviso co-owner of the property, with a share of one-third (1/3) of one-half (1/2) share over the subject property, representing the shares of her late father, as reflected in T.C.T. No. 002-2023000347 in the Registry of Deeds of the City of Manila (ANNEX "A").

20. Meanwhile, Teresita A. Seda who owns half of the one-half (1/2) in the subject property, passed away way back 23 November 2003 in Dasmariñas, Cavite and is survived by his two (2) sons namely herein defendants GALICANO A. SEDA and VINCENT A. SEDA.

21. While Lourdes A. Holcombe, the owner of the other half of the one-half (1/2) of the subject property, had also passed away on 28 May 2016 in the County of San Bernardino, California, U.S.A. and is survived by her spouse, herein defendant DAVID HOLCOMBE, but considering that she had no issues, the rest of the defendants as her collateral relatives, siblings, nephews and nieces, are likewise her heirs.

22. On the other hand, defendants ASUNCION A. CRELENCIO and DOLORES C. APACIBLE owns the remaining two-thirds (2/3) of the other one-half (1/2) of the subject property.

23. The plaintiff desire that the above-mentioned real property should be partitioned between the plaintiff and the defendants and that she be able to recover at least her 63.92 square meters, representing her one-third (1/3) of one-half (1/2) share over the subject property.

24. Plaintiff invokes Article 494 of the Civil Code of the Philippines which states that: Article 494. No co-owner shall be obliged to remain in the co-ownership. Each co-owner may demand at any time the partition of the thing owned in common, insofar as his share is concerned. . . x x x . . .

25. There are also no qualifying circumstances that should prevent the partition of the subject property.

26. The plaintiff had repeatedly requested from the defendants for a meeting to amicably agree on the partition of the subject property and even submitted a proposed subdivision survey plan after engaging the services of a geodetic engineer for her to get her rightful share, but her requests were refused and went unheeded as she was advised to just institute the proper judicial proceedings. A copy of the subdivision plan is attached herewith, marked as ANNEXES “D” and made integral part hereof.

27. Up to the present, the above-mentioned real property had not been partitioned among the parties and plaintiff is yet to get her rightful share thereto.

28. As defendants acted in gross and evident bad faith in refusing to satisfy the plaintiff’s valid, just and demandable claim for partition of the subject property and she was compelled to incur expenses to protect her interests, plaintiffs in this complaint also seeks to recover attorney’s fees and expenses of litigation in the amount of not less than Php. 800,000.00.

D. EVIDENCE TO BE PRESENTED

29. **TESTIMONIAL EVIDENCE (SOLE WITNESS): Plaintiff ANA CASILDE A. APACIBLE.** Pursuant to Rule 7 of the 2019 Amendments to the Rules on Civil Procedure, PLAINTIFF is attaching herewith her judicial affidavit, to form an integral part hereof, to prove the material allegations of this complaint, the fact of co-ownership over the subject property and her right to demand partition over the same. c.) That the defendants be made to pay the plaintiff the amount of at least Php. 800,000.00 as attorney’s fees, filing fees and expenses of litigation.

Other reliefs, just and equitable under the premises are also prayed for.

YOUNG SPURS GET IT DONE!

Europa League: Late strikes see Ange's boys through to last 16
■ Mainoo shines as as United also book their spot

Tottenham's young starlets delivered in style on Thursday night, scoring three late goals to ensure the North London side progressed to the last 16 of the Europa League.

After no wins in seven in the Premier League, Ange Postecoglou's team struggled against Swedish qualifiers Elfsborg in the Europa League for over an hour.

The loss of yet another player to injury did not help the mood inside Tottenham Hotspur Stadium as substitute Radu Dragusin joined the club's spiralling casualty list.

Then 20-year-old Dane Scarlett headed Spurs ahead before 19-year-old Damola Ajayi - just three minutes and 39 seconds into his debut - produced a confident finish to make it 2-0.

Tottenham were already heading for a win and a place in the last 16 when Mikey Moore produced the finish of the night, a low shot after a clever run right before the final whistle.

It was a lovely moment.

At 17 years and 172 days old, London-born Moore became the youngest English player to score in major men's European competition, breaking Jimmy Greaves' record (17 years 245 days), set in

October 1957.

Greaves, who became a Spurs legend, was a Chelsea player at the time of his goal.

Moore has been with Spurs since the age of seven.

"A fan just said to me then - just play the kids, we don't need to buy anyone," former Tottenham striker Peter Crouch told TNT Sports.

Tottenham fans have not had too much to shout about recently, but the sight of Scarlett, Ajayi and Moore all scoring their first senior goals for the club lifted the atmosphere.

"I just said it was made in Tottenham tonight," said Spurs boss Postecoglou afterwards.

"It's brilliant for the club and I'm sure there are academy coaches and players who won't sleep tonight because they are pretty excited.

"We kind of knew we would have to rely on some young players tonight, and all the way through this campaign to be honest.

"I thought they stood up really well. The whole group played well but we were going to need some young boys to make an impact and not just the three goalscorers."

Manchester United also advanced straight to the last 16 as Kobbie

Mainoo scored one and assisted another to help Ruben Amorim's side to a win at FCSB.

After a relatively drab first 60 minutes in Bucharest Mainoo's low pass found wing-back Diogo Dalot, who was unmarked at the back post to comfortably tap United ahead.

Eight minutes later the England midfielder got on to the scoresheet by side-footing home Alejandro Garnacho's cut-back.

Amorim opted to start Mainoo in a more advanced position and the midfielder rewarded the Portuguese's call with his first goal of the season, having not hit the net since United's win in last season's FA Cup final.

"I enjoyed it," the 19-year-old told TNT Sports after full-time. "I am just happy to be on the pitch for Manchester United."

The visitors end the competition's league phase in third, and will play one of Real Sociedad, Galatasaray, AZ Alkmaar or FC Midtjylland in a last-16 tie in March.

They avoid a two-legged play-off round in February, which after the match Amorim said would be "really important" to give his players more time to train and

"build connections".

Rangers upset the odds to earn an impressive top-eight finish in the Europa League after Vaclav Cerny's second-half strike proved decisive against Union Saint-Gilloise.

A direct route to the last 16 seemed very unlikely until deep into the

second half at Ibrox given the necessity for results elsewhere to go the Scottish Premiership side's way, but those all fell perfectly into place.

Philippe Clement's team will now face one of Bodo/Glimt, Anderlecht, Twente or Fenerbahce in March depending who progresses from their

play-off fixtures.

Rangers - who started the night in 13th place having played four of the eventual top seven - had a straightforward assignment. Win and see how the cards fell.

They did that, despite a number of scares, to earn an incredible outcome.
