ANDREW 'TOO AFRAID' TO COME BACK TO USA

■ Questions about troubled Prince's links with Jeffrey Epstein just won't go away

Prince Andrew is reportedly too afraid to visit the U.S. amid renewed calls for an FBI probe into his ties with Jeffrey Epstein.

Despite denying allegations, newly surfaced emails contradict the royal's claims of severing ties in 2010.

King Charles is also said to be getting increasingly frustrated with Prince Andrew, who still hopes for a royal comeback.

Andrew is said to be wary of setting foot in the United States amid mounting calls for the FBI to investigate his ties to the late Epstein, a convicted pedophile.

For the past six years, the 64-year-old Duke of York has remained mainly in the U.K., fearing potential arrest, civil lawsuits, or subpoenas if he travels.

Andrew's concerns have deepened following recent revelations that he maintained contact with Epstein longer than previously acknowledged, prompting fresh demands for a criminal investigation into Epstein's network.

"He is terrified if he goes to America, he could

be arrested, face civil action or be subpoenaed," a source told The Sun.

Once known as "Air Miles Andy" for his frequent jet-setting, the disgraced royal has drastically scaled back on international trips, only visiting Bahrain in recent years.

"Since the scandal erupted, he's avoided his usual golf trips to Spain and other vacations abroad, opting instead to stay where he feels safe," the insider added.

Spencer Kuvin, an attorney representing Epstein's victims, has urged the U.K. government to hand over Andrew for questioning. He argued that the monarchy should sever all ties with the disgraced duke.

"The British monarchy should be embarrassed. He should be fully separated from the monarchy and the public should never be subsidizing someone who has either such bad judgment to be friends with this man or

could have been involved with him," Kuvin stated.

He further insisted that the U.S. government should pressure Andrew to cooperate.

"The president should require his new FBI director to fully investigate Andrew's conduct. The government should turn him over for that and demand he volunteer himself to be a part of it," he noted.

Kuvin also called on King Charles to take action, saying, "The king should do that. Andrew should be held accountable by the monarchy."

Andrew has consistently denied all allegations against him, maintaining that he has no recollection of ever meeting Virginia Giuffre, one of Epstein's many victims.

However, in February 2022, Andrew and Giuffre reached an out-of-court settlement, with the duke admitting no wrongdoing but expressing regret over his association with Epstein.

Remote island school seeks to distance itself from Prince

A school named after the Duke of York will be re-branded to something less "controversial".

Prince Andrew school, the only secondary school on the remote British overseas territory of St Helena, is asking its students to suggest something more "neutral".

The decision stems

from "recent public controversy" and "negative media coverage", a statement from the government of St Helena said.

Buckingham Palace was informed of the move, it is understood.

The tiny island sits in the south Atlantic Ocean 1,165 miles (1,874km) west of mainland Africa,

and has a population of approximately 4,000. It is known for being the site of Napoleon Bonaparte's second period of exile after his defeat at the Battle of Waterloo.

The school's headteacher, Philip Toal, said: "While we respect history, we must also be mind-

George and Mildred star Brian Murphy dead at 92

Actor Brian Murphy, best known for sitcoms *Man About The House* and *George And Mildred*, has died aged 92.

He passed away at his home in Kent on Sunday with his wife – Hi-de-Hi! actress Linda Regan – by his side, said his agent Thomas Bowington.

Brian had been filming a comedy before Christmas and was due to start production on a road movie in June in which he was to star alongside Linda as a husband and wife duo.

Thomas said the actor suffered “a sudden attack” – developing a pain in his back around three weeks ago. After getting a check-up he was told he had cancer in his spine

and shoulders.

His agent remembered him as a “sprinkler of joy on stage, screen and in life” and as a person who was “joyful, warm, kind and caring to everyone”.

‘great actor’

Hi De Hi! star Jeffrey Holland called Murphy a “wonderful actor”. The sitcom’s Vicki Michelle added: “So so sad to hear of the passing of Brian Murphy.

“Great actor and gorgeous friend, always fun. My heart goes out to Linda and family. Such a wonderful couple.”

Murphy met Linda in 1990 when they starred in a play as husband and wife. They wed in 1995. The actress, who played

Hi De Hi! yellowcoat April, said: “I was lucky to have in my lifetime found my soulmate Brian who I will love forever.”

The actor came to the public’s attention playing landlord George Roper in ITV’s *Man About The House*, which began airing in 1973. The late Yootha Joyce played his wife Mildred.

The show was controversial for the time because it featured two single women living with a man. When the show ended in 1976 Brian and Yootha starred in the spin-off, *George And Mildred*, which ran for five series. He also starred as Alvin Smedley in *Last Of The Summer Wine*.

Born on September 25, 1932 on the Isle of Wight, he trained at The Royal Academy Of Dramatic Art after completing National Service with the RAF. Brian started his career in the 1950s with the Theatre Workshop, and appeared in both the stage and 1962 film version of the comedy *Spar-*

rows Can’t Sing. He also performed in First World War musical satire *Oh, What a Lovely War*.

The star appeared in ITV sitcom *The Incredible Mr Tanner* in 1981 and BBC’s *L For Lester* in 1982.

In 1993, he starred in the first major stage

version of *The Invisible Man*, based on the science fiction classic by HG Wells.

In the noughties, he portrayed Maurice in *The Booze Cruise* alongside Martin Clunes and from 2011 he appeared in *The Cafe*.

Murphy is survived by his wife and two sons.

‘Dangerous Fool’ jailed for 14 years

- “Unauthorised, unqualified and uninformed junior soldier” spied for Iran
- Daniel Khalife motivated by “a selfish desire to show off”, says judge

A BRITISH soldier turned traitor who escaped from jail by clinging to the bottom of a food truck was this week jailed for 14 years and three months after spying for Iran.

Daniel Khalife was labelled a “dangerous fool” by judge Mrs Justice Cheema-Grubb who added that he had been motivated by “a selfish desire to show off”.

Khalife, 23, who was

originally from Kingston, south-west London, had been serving in the Army for four years when he “exposed military personnel to serious harm” by collecting sensitive information and passing it to agents working for Iran.

nationwide man hunt

He was paid for the material, some of which he forged, and told his handlers he would stay

in the military for more than 25 years to spy for them. The details included a written list of personnel, including SAS troops.

Khalife, who has an Iranian mother and Lebanese father, was recruited by Iran via Facebook weeks after he joined the Royal Corps of Signals.

Security officials are unsure exactly what he passed on via encrypted app Telegram as he de-

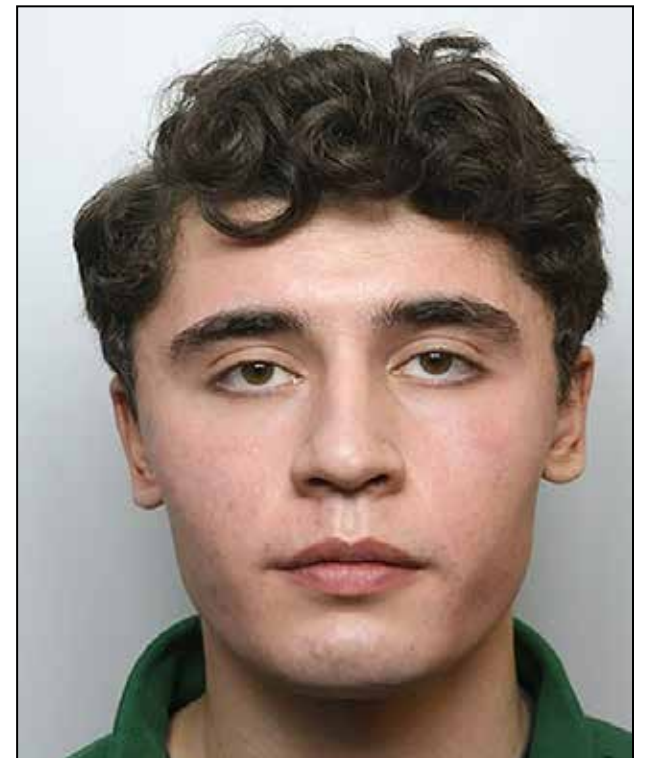
leted it all.

Khalife triggered a nationwide hunt after escaping from Wandsworth Jail – where he was being held on remand for spying – and going on the run for three days in September 2023. His jail term includes 12 years for spying plus two years and three months for breaking out. He must also pay £10,000 towards trial costs.

The judge told Khalife at Woolwich Crown Court: “You had the makings of an exemplary soldier.

“However, through the repeated violation of your oath of service you showed yourself to be, instead, a dangerous fool.

“That you started on this dangerous and fantastical plan demonstrates your immaturity and lack of wisdom. That you thought it was

appropriate to insert yourself – an unauthorised, unqualified and uninformed junior soldier – into communication with an enemy state is perhaps the clearest indication of the degree of folly in your failure to understand at the most obvious level the risk you posed.”

Jurors rejected Khal-

ife’s claim that he had been undertaking a “double agent” mission after being told his Iranian heritage would bar him from his dream role in British intelligence.

Khalife’s lawyer accepted that his “hapless” operation bore more resemblance to cartoon sleuth dog Scooby-Doo than James Bond.

ful of how past associations impact the present and future.

“Choosing a new name allows us to honour the contributions of our students and community without the burden of controversial ties.”

New figures show stabbings now the leading cause of teenage deaths in UK

Teenage homicide victims in England and Wales are far more likely to have been stabbed to death than any other age group, new statistics suggest.

In 2023-24, 53 of 64 homicide victims aged between 13 and 19 - or 83% - were killed with a sharp instrument, according to figures published by the Office for National Statistics (ONS) on Thursday.

That is significantly higher than the proportion of knife homicides for all age groups, which was 46% for the same period.

This year there have already been a number of fatal stabbings of teenagers, such as the killing of 15-year-old Harvey Willgoose at his school in Sheffield on Monday.

The ONS data covers the 12 months to March 2024, and does not include knife homicides that have occurred since.

The latest figures continue an upward trend in the percentage of teenage homicides reported to involve a bladed article, compared to 56% in 2013-14.

A total of 262 knife homicides were recorded in 2023-24 for all age groups, of whom 40 were aged under 18, the ONS figures show.

The figures show:

Homicides involving a bladed article reached a decade high in 2023-24

Male victims were more likely to be stabbed

to death than females, at 50% compared to 35% respectively

In the 262 recorded knife homicides, the type of weapon used were: a kitchen knife (42%), an unidentified sharp instrument (17%), a machete (7%), and a combat or military-style knife (5%)

The government said last year it would halve knife crime in a decade, and in September zombie-style knives were banned in England and Wales, making it an imprisonable offence to own, make, transport or sell them.

Actor Idris Elba - who has made a documentary on the solutions to knife crime - said last week that while banning the sale of blades such as zombie-style knives is a positive step, early intervention is also necessary.

He told the BBC that domestic knives could also be made less dangerous.

"Not all kitchen knives need to have a point on them, that sounds like a crazy thing to say," he said, adding, "but you can still cut your food without the point on your knife, which is an innovative way to look at it."

Home Secretary Yvette Cooper said on Tuesday that she was considering a ban on kitchen knives with a pointed end as part of the government's crackdown.

Trans doctor left 'upset and afraid' by nurse, tribunal hears

■ Scottish medic suspended after telling Kirkcaldy doctor "a man couldn't be in the changing room"

A transgender doctor was left feeling "distressed" and "afraid" after being told by a nurse not to use the women's changing rooms at work, an employment tribunal has heard.

Dr Beth Upton - a trans woman - described being confronted by Sandie Peggie on Christmas Eve 2023, who was said to have stated that "a man couldn't be in the changing room" at Victoria Hospital in Kirkcaldy.

Dr Upton told the tribunal the incident was "quite scary".

unlawful harassment

Ms Peggie was suspended by NHS Fife in January 2024 pending an investigation after she argued that sharing the changing room with Dr Upton amounted to unlawful harassment under the Equality Act. Dr Upton began gender transition in January 2022, uses the pronouns she/her, and had been "fully out in all aspects of my life" since August 2022, including at work.

The medic said an NHS manager had agreed that "as my identity is as a woman, that I should use the women's changing facilities."

Dr Upton said there had been three previous incidents with Ms Peg-

gie where the nurse indicated that "she didn't want to be in the same space I was in", before being confronted by her on Christmas Eve.

Dr Upton had completed a shift and went to the changing rooms with two colleagues, before Ms Peggie later walked in.

After the other staff members left the room, Ms Peggie said it was "inappropriate" for Dr Upton to be in the women's changing room and that she felt intimidated as a result.

'really distressed'

Ms Peggie then made a remark which Dr Upton took to be a comparison to the case of Isla Bryson, a transgender rapist who attacked two women while known as Adam Graham and was

initially remanded to a women's prison.

Dr Upton told the tribunal that Ms Peggie had also "asked me what my chromosomes were" and that other staff members were also uncomfortable with the doctor using the female changing room.

Dr Upton added: "I felt really distressed, really awful. I've never had somebody say things like that to me before."

Dr Upton said the comments from Ms Peggie were "very hurtful" and based on "misinformation" about trans people and that her comments had been hurtful and demeaning.

The doctor added: "It was deeply uncomfortable and upsetting to have somebody saying such unpleasant and accusatory things to you. I

felt unsafe and upset."

After the incident Dr Upton burst into tears before speaking to a senior colleague, who had been understanding and offered support.

The doctor returned to work on 28 December, but was "quite anxious and nervous" about doing so due to the incident with Ms Peggie.

The doctor described earlier incidents where Ms Peggie had left the changing room when Dr Upton entered.

This left Dr Upton feeling "saddened" and "unfairly judged", but not wanting to put in a formal complaint to avoid making a fuss.

The doctor's gender identity had otherwise been "respected" by colleagues, the tribunal was told.

The tribunal continues.

SAS use of lethal force which killed four 'unjustified', inquest rules

The use of lethal force by SAS soldiers was unjustified when they opened fire killing four IRA men in an ambush at Clonoe in County Tyrone, an inquest ruled on Thursday.

Kevin Barry O'Donnell, 21, Sean O'Farrell, 22, Peter Clancy, 21, and Patrick Vincent, 20, died in February 1992, minutes after they had carried out a

gun attack on Coalisland police station.

The soldiers opened fire as the men arrived at St Patrick's Church car park in a hijacked lorry which had a heavy machine gun welded to its tailgate.

Security forces had intelligence the car park would be used and 12 soldiers were in position behind a hedgerow.

In response to the ruling, Downing Street said "addressing the issues of the past must be done in a way that commands the support of families, survivors and, importantly, the families of those killed serving the state".

A spokesperson added that "any veteran who served during the Troubles is provided legal sup-

port where appropriate".

The four armed IRA men were killed about 20 minutes after firing 60 shots at Coalisland police station - no-one was injured in the attack.

SAS soldiers opened fire without warning when the lorry drove in - firing more than 500 rounds.

In statements at the

time, the soldiers stated the use of lethal force was justified to protect their lives and those of their colleagues from the danger the IRA unit presented.

However, coroner Mr Justice Michael Humphreys found the use of lethal force cannot have been reasonable.

He said there was no

attempt to arrest the four IRA men, even as they lay wounded.

Mr Justice Humphreys said the experienced soldiers lying in wait at the church would have known the men would need to dismount the machine gun and in that scenario the ability to arrest them would have im-

proved.

The coroner said the operation "was not planned and controlled in such a way as to minimize to the greatest extent possible the need for recourse to lethal force".

However, he said the soldiers chose not to wait but to stand up and begin shooting.

Two of those killed, Mr O'Donnell and Mr O'Farrell, were shot in the back while running away and had bullets fired into their faces as they lay on the ground.

"No attempt was made by the soldiers to arrest any members of

the PIRA unit, even as they lay seriously injured and incapacitated either on the ground or in the lorry," the judge stated.

"The soldiers did not have an honest and genuinely held belief that the use of force was necessary to defend themselves or others."

Mr Justice Humphreys added that state agencies had "perpetuated falsehoods" about the incident, having claimed at the time there had been a gun battle.

In fact, the IRA men had not fired on the soldiers.

He referred to a Ministry of Defence document which had mentioned the operation as "an excellent security forces success".

The Gedling Inn, in Nottinghamshire, came up with the promotion to spread the word after it started to televise local Premier League games at the venue.

But the incentive backfired after Forest scored seven without reply against Brighton on Saturday - and almost 300 free beers were handed over the bar.

Landlady Beccy Webster said: "When the final whistle went, I just said 'phew!'"

The Main Street venue had only decided on the offer on the day of the game.

Miss Webster, who has run the pub for six years, said they had only just started televising the game when they decided on "a crazy offer".

dreams did we imagine they'd score seven goals.

"I was upstairs feeding my baby when I heard the first goal go in, then the second quickly afterwards, and I had just come downstairs when the third went in - I

She said: "People were singing, and people were respectful with the offer - lots of people were still

buying drinks, people stayed for food, and lots of people have been asking if we'll be having any more offers on!

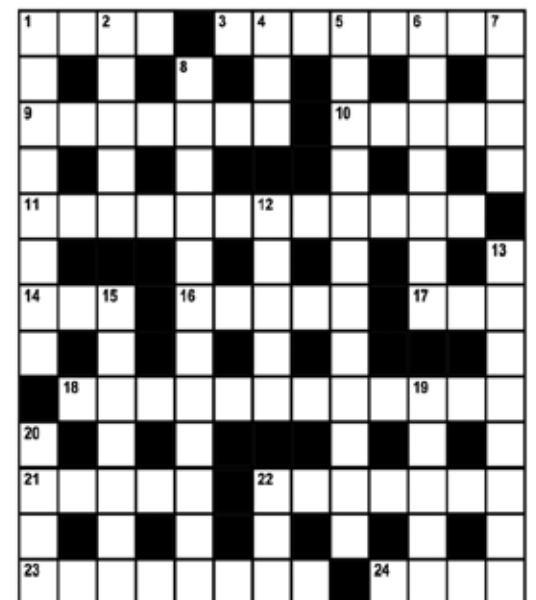

For the last two defendants, leave of court shall hereby be requested from his Honorable Court to serve summons by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in such places and for such time as the court may order, and a copy of the summons and order of the court shall be sent by registered mail to their abovementioned last known address, or in any other manner the court may deem sufficient, pursuant to extraterritorial service under Section 17 of Rule 14 of the 2019 Revised Rules of Civil Procedure.”

From the foregoing, plaintiff entreats this Court’s permission to serve summons by publication outside of the Philippines with respect to defendants David Holcombe and Asuncion A. Crelencia.

In this regard, Solis v. Solis-Laynes, et al. is highly instructive, thus:

Section 15, Rule 14 of the Rules of Civil Procedure provides:

“Section 17. Extraterritorial service. – When the defendant does not reside and is not found in the Philippines, and the action affects the personal status of the plaintiff or relates to, or the subject of which is, property within the Philippines, in which the defendant has or claims a lien or interest, actual or contingent, or in which the relief demanded consists, wholly or in part, in excluding the defendant from any interest therein, or the property of the defendant has been attached within the Philippines by personal service as under Section 6; or by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in such places and for such time as the court may order, in which case a copy of the summons and order of the court shall be sent by registered mail to the last known address of the defendant, or in any other manner the court may deem sufficient. Any order granting such leave shall specify a reasonable time, which shall not be less than sixty (60) days after notice, within the defendant must answer.

Breaking down said provision, there are only four instances wherein a defendant who is a non-resident and is not found in the country may be served with summons by extraterritorial service: (1) when the action affects the personal status of the plaintiff; (2) when the action relates to, or the subject of which is property, within the Philippines, in which the defendant claims a lien or an interest, actual or contingent; (3) when the relief demanded in such action consists, wholly or in part, in excluding the defendant from any interest in property located in the Philippines; and (4) when the defendant non-resident’s property has been attached within the Philippines.

In the above instances, extraterritorial service of summons may be effected under any of three modes: (1) by personal service out of the country, with leave of court; (2) by publication and sending a copy of the summons and order of the court by registered mail to the defendant’s last known address, also with leave of court; or (3) by any other means the judge may consider sufficient.”

Also relevant is the case of Heirs of Morales v. Morales Agustin which enunciated that:

“The partition of real estate is an action quasi in rem. Jurisprudence is replete with pronouncements that, for the court to acquire jurisdiction in actions quasi in rem, it is necessary only that it has jurisdiction over the res. In the case of Macasaet v. Co, Jr., the Court stated that jurisdiction over the defendant in an action in rem or quasi in rem is not required, and the court acquires jurisdiction over an action as long as it acquires jurisdiction over the res that is the subject matter of long action.

In case of De Pedro v. Romanson Development Corporation, the Court clarified that while this is so, “to satisfy the requirements of due process, jurisdiction over the parties in rem and quasi in rem actions is required. Thus, regardless of the nature of the action, proper service of summons is imperative and that a decision rendered without proper service of summons suffers a defect in jurisdiction.”

Applying the foregoing jurisprudential principles in the instant case and considering the plaintiff’s Complaint and her supporting Judicial Affidavit, setting forth the fact that defendants David Holcombe and Asuncion A. Crelencia do not reside and are not found in the Philippines, and the action relates to, or the subject of which is, property within the Philippines in which the defendant has or claims a lien or interest actual or contingent, where the relief demanded consists wholly or in part, in excluding the defendant from any interest therein, this Court finds plaintiff’s entreaty to be meritorious and thus, hereby GRANTS leave of court and allows, at the expense of the plaintiff, the service of summons on the said defendants by publication once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the United States of America (U.S.A.) or, in particular, in the State of California.

Let copies of the summons and the Complaint, as well as this Order, be sent by registered mail to the last known addresses of defendants DAVID HOLCOMBE and ASUNCION A. CRELENCIA.

Defendants DAVID HOLCOMBE and ASUNCION A. CRELENCIA are hereby directed to file their respective Answers within sixty (60) calendar days from date of last publication.

Finding also the instant Complaint to be compliant with 2019 Amendments to the 1997 Revised Rules of Civil Procedure, the Branch Clerk of Court is hereby directed to issue Summons to be remaining defendants.

COMES NOW, plaintiff through undersigned counsel and unto this Honorable Court, most respectfully avers: THAT-

A. THE PARTIES

1. Plaintiff ANA CASILDA A. APACIBLE is of legal age, Filipino, single, and a resident of 3544-A Lingayen St., Brgy. 605, Zone 60 Sta. Mesa, Manila 1016, where she may be personally served with orders, notices, decisions, resolutions and other court processes;

2. Defendant heirs of Teresita A. Seda are GALICANO A. SEDA, of legal age, Filipino, and a resident of 3544 Lingayen St. Sta. Mesa, Manila 1016 and VINCENT A. SEDA, is of legal age, Filipino, and a resident of 38 Cadena de Amor St. Andrea I Village, Brgy. Panapaan VI, Bacoor, Cavite 4102, where they could respectively be personally served summons, orders, notices, decisions, resolutions and other court processes;

3. Defendant heir of Lourdes A. Holcombe is DAVID HOLCOMBE, of legal age, American Citizen, and a resident of 1770 Wright St. Pomona, California 91766 U.S.A.;

4. Defendant ASUNCION A. CRELENCIA, is of legal age, Filipino citizen, and a resident of 1911 Denison St. Pomona, California 91766 U.S.A.;

5. For the last two defendants, leave of court shall hereby be requested from this Honorable Court to serve summons by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in such places and for such time as the court may order, and a copy of the summons and order of the court shall be sent by registered mail to their abovementioned last known addresses, or in any other manner the court may deem sufficient, pursuant to extraterritorial service under Section 17 of Rule 14 of the 2019 Revised Rules of Civil Procedure.

B. NATURE OF THE ACTION

9. This is an action for judicial partition involving a parcel of land, together with the improvements existing thereon, situated at No. 3544 Lingayen St. corner Bataan St., Brgy. 605, Zone 60, Sta. Mesa (formerly Sampaloc), Manila, with an area of 383.50 square meters, covered by Transfer Certificate of Title No. 002-2023000347, in the Registry of Deeds of the City of Manila, a true electronic copy of which is attached herewith marked as ANNEX “A” and made an integral part hereof; and more particularly described as follows:

A parcel of Land (Lot. No. 11 Block No. 6 of the subdivision plan Psd-23306, being a portion of the Lot No. 4-C-1-L-3-W of the subdivision plan Psd-21291, GLRO Record No. 7680), situated in the district of Sampaloc, City of Manila. Bounded on the NW. by street Lot No. 1 of the subdivision plan; on the SE. by Lot No. 2 and 3, Block No. 6 of the subdivision plan; on the SW and W by street Lot No. 6 of the subdivision plan. . . x x x . . . containing an area of Three Hundred and Eighty-Three Square Meters and Fifty Square Decimeters (383.50) more or less. . .

10. The subject property is currently declared for tax purposes in the Department of Assessment of the City of Manila, with an assessed value of the land at Php. 633,640.00 and market value of Php. 6,336,400.00. A building (house) standing thereon is also declared for tax purposes, with an assessed value of Php. 280,450.00 and market value of Php. 934,823.75 for the current year. Certified true copies of the Tax Declarations, are attached herewith, marked as ANNEXES “B” (land) and “C” (building), respectively, and made integral parts hereof.

11. In as much as the total assessed value of the subject property exceeds Php. 400,000.00, the jurisdiction of this civil action is with the Regional Trial Courts of the City of Manila, where the subject property is located, pursuant to Republic Act (R.A. 11576).

12. As shown in the certificate of title, the registered co-owners of the subject property are as follows:

(1.) Teresita A. Seda, married to Soriano E. Seda, both of legal ages, Filipino Citizens;
(2.) Lourdes A. Holcombe, married to David Holcombe, both of legal age, Filipino Citizens;

(1) and (2) with 1/2 share);
(3A.) Asuncion Apacible, married to Enriquee Crelencio, both of legal age, Filipino citizens;

(3B) Ana Casilda A. Apacible, of legal age, single, Filipino citizen; and;
(3C) Dolores Apacible, of legal age, single, Filipino citizen;

(3A) thru (3C) with 1/2 share;

C. ANTECEDENT FACTS

13. The property is originally owned by the late spouses Alejandro Apacible, Sr., who passed away in 1983, and Corazon C. Apacible, who passed away in 1992.

14. Alejandro, Sr. and Corazon, were survived by their seven (7) children, namely: Asuncion A. Crelencia, Teresita A. Seda, Lourdes A. Holcombe, Elpidio C. Apacible, Alejandro C. Apacible, Jr., Manuel C. Apacible and Dolores C. Apacible.

15. The estate of the late Alejandro Apacible, Sr. was the subject of intestate proceedings with Spec. Proc. No. 1571 before the Regional Trial Court Branch XI in Balayan, Batangas, which rendered a Decision, dated 24 September 1990, approving an "Agreement and Complete Project of Partition" among the heirs.

16. Later, the heirs of Alejandro, Sr. and Corazon also executed exchange of shares involving other pieces of property, which eventually resulted in the subject Sta. Mesa property being allotted as follows:

1/2 of the property belonging to: 1/2 of the property belonging to:

Teresita A. Seda Asuncion A. Crelencia
Lourdes A. Holcombe Alejandro C. Apacible Jr.
Dolores C. Apacible

17. Meanwhile, Alejandro C. Apacible Jr. passed away on 12 February 2014, without leaving any will, and was survived by his widow Nenita A. Apacible and his daughter, herein plaintiff, ANA CASILDA A. APACIBLE.

18. Nenita A. Apacible waived all her rights and interest over the herein subject property in favor of plaintiff, ANA CASILDA A. APACIBLE. Thus, all the rights and interests of Alejandro C. Apacible Jr. thereto were transferred to his daughter, plaintiff, ANA CASILDA A. APACIBLE.

19. From the foregoing, plaintiff ANA CASILDA A. APACIBLE is a pro-indiviso co-owner of the property, with a share of one-third (1/3) of one-half (1/2) share over the subject property, representing the shares of her late father, as reflected in T.C.T. No. 002-2023000347 in the Registry of Deeds of the City of Manila (ANNEX "A").

20. Meanwhile, Teresita A. Seda who owns half of the one-half (1/2) in the subject property, passed away way back 23 November 2003 in Dasmariñas, Cavite and is survived by his two (2) sons namely herein defendants GALICANO A. SEDA and VINCENT A. SEDA.

21. While Lourdes A. Holcombe, the owner of the other half of the one-half (1/2) of the subject property, had also passed away on 28 May 2016 in the County of San Bernardino, California, U.S.A. and is survived by her spouse, herein defendant DAVID HOLCOMBE, but considering that she had no issues, the rest of the defendants as her collateral relatives, siblings, nephews and nieces, are likewise her heirs.

22. On the other hand, defendants ASUNCION A. CRELENCIO and DOLORES C. APACIBLE owns the remaining two-thirds (2/3) of the other one-half (1/2) of the subject property.

23. The plaintiff desire that the above-mentioned real property should be partitioned between the plaintiff and the defendants and that she be able to recover at least her 63.92 square meters, representing her one-third (1/3) of one-half (1/2) share over the subject property.

24. Plaintiff invokes Article 494 of the Civil Code of the Philippines which states that: Article 494. No co-owner shall be obliged to remain in the co-ownership. Each co-owner may demand at any time the partition of the thing owned in common, insofar as his share is concerned. . . x x x . . .

25. There are also no qualifying circumstances that should prevent the partition of the subject property.

26. The plaintiff had repeatedly requested from the defendants for a meeting to amicably agree on the partition of the subject property and even submitted a proposed subdivision survey plan after engaging the services of a geodetic engineer for her to get her rightful share, but her requests were refused and went unheeded as she was advised to just institute the proper judicial proceedings. A copy of the subdivision plan is attached herewith, marked as ANNEXES “D” and made integral part hereof.

27. Up to the present, the above-mentioned real property had not been partitioned among the parties and plaintiff is yet to get her rightful share thereto.

28. As defendants acted in gross and evident bad faith in refusing to satisfy the plaintiff’s valid, just and demandable claim for partition of the subject property and she was compelled to incur expenses to protect her interests, plaintiffs in this complaint also seeks to recover attorney’s fees and expenses of litigation in the amount of not less than Php. 800,000.00.

D. EVIDENCE TO BE PRESENTED

29. TESTIMONIAL EVIDENCE (SOLE WITNESS): Plaintiff ANA CASILDE A. APACIBLE. Pursuant to Rule 7 of the 2019 Amendments to the Rules on Civil Procedure, PLAINTIFF is attaching herewith her judicial affidavit, to form an integral part hereof, to prove the material allegations of this complaint, the fact of co-ownership over the subject property and her right to demand partition over the same. She will identify the pertinent documents and testify on other related matters in support of her complaint.

30. DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE. Plaintiff shall also present the following documentary evidence in support of her complaint, to wit:

c.) That the defendants be made to pay the plaintiff the amount of at least Php. 800,000.00 as attorney’s fees, filing fees and expenses of litigation.

Other reliefs, just and equitable under the premises are also prayed for.

EPL teams splash almost £400m in transfer window

Premier League clubs spent around £370m in the winter transfer window, significantly up on the £100m paid out last year, with Manchester City spending almost as much as the other 19 top-flight teams combined.

While spending is up, it is still way down on the 2023 record of £815m.

The £50m signing of midfielder Nico Gonzalez from Porto just before Monday's 23:00 GMT deadline took Manchester City's total spending to around £180m, according to as manager Pep Guardiola was given the backing to try and improve the defending champions' current form.

City's is the second-highest spend in a winter window ever, behind Chelsea in 2023, who spent £275m.

As is seemingly the case for many recent transfer deadline days, things were quiet until towards the end.

By 18:00 GMT - five hours before the window closed - just two deals had been done in the Premier League and both involved Brighton.

The first of those was the loan move of striker Evan Ferguson from the Seagulls to West Ham for the rest of the season, before Brighton later signed 19-year-old forward Stefanos Tzimas from Nuremberg for £20.8m.

A quiet transfer deadline day needs a saga with twists and turns, and that was provided by Axel Disasi.

The Chelsea defender initially wanted to stay and fight for his place but was told it would be better to leave.

Both Aston Villa and Tottenham emerged as suitors but Spurs quickly went cold on signing the France international after feeling he didn't want to join.

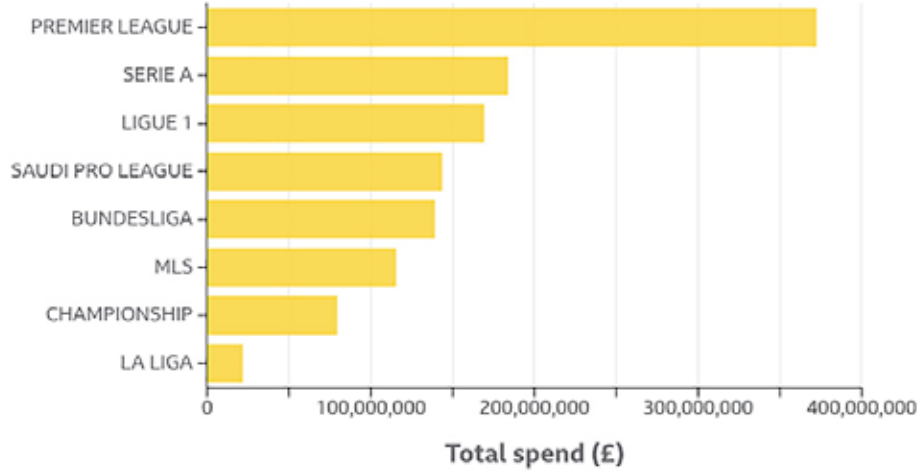
His agents then, seemingly out of nowhere, appeared to convince Disasi that Spurs was better but they ultimately lost out to Villa, with a loan deal agreed with the club, although the move had yet to be confirmed by the 23:00 GMT deadline.

Villa also added Spain midfielder Marco Asensio on loan from Paris St-Germain in the final few hours of the win-

Rashford and Amorim 'didn't see eye to eye'

Manchester United manager Ruben Amorim says Marcus Rashford left the club because he couldn't get the attacker to see eye-to-eye with him.

On Sunday, Rashford, 27, joined Aston Villa on loan until the end of the season having not featured for United since expressing his desire for a "new challenge" in December.

Villa have the option to make the deal permanent for £40m, which would bring an end to Rashford's near-life long association with United.

"I couldn't get Marcus to see the way you're supposed to play football and to train the way I see it," Amorim said.

"Sometimes you have one player that is really good with one coach, and the same player with another coach is different.

"I wish the best to Rashford and to [Villa manager] Unai Emery, and they can connect because he's a very good player."

£81.3m, joining Real Betis on loan, while **Marcus Rashford** left to join Villa on loan.

Of the Premier League signings that were made in the winter window involving a fee, the average age of the signed players was just 20.5.

Bournemouth signed 19-year-old left-back **Julio Soler** and centre-back **Matai Akinboni**, 18, while Brighton's three signings - **Tzimas**, **Diego Gomez** and **Eiran Cashin** - are 19, 21 and 23 respectively.

Manchester United's main winter window signing was 20-year-old Dorgu, while defender Ayden Heaven is 18.

Meanwhile, Manchester City's four new arrivals have an average age of 20.5.

Asked whether Rashford said that he did not agree with Amorim's ideas about football, Amorim said: "You know, like me, that it's not the way that occurs.

"It's something that you feel as a coach and as a player. It's quite normal. It happened with a lot of coaches.

"The important thing is that I'm here saying that was my decision, like Ty [Malacia] and Antony was my decision to do these loans, and to keep some players even without any transfers."

When asked if there is any chance Rashford could return to Old Trafford in the summer, Amorim said he is focussed on the current season because "we are fighting for our jobs until the summer".

Amorim admitted it was his decision to take

the "risk" of not signing more players in the January transfer window.

The Red Devils completed two signings in the window, with left-back Patrick Dorgu, 20, arriving from Italian side Lecce and centre-back Ayden Heaven, 18, signing from Premier League rivals Arsenal.

However, having allowed Rashford and Antony to leave on loan to Villa and Real Betis respectively, many expected United to bring in at least one player in attack.

Amorim said before the window closed that the club were "trying everything" to strengthen the squad but they failed to make any further additions.

"We are taking a risk but we want a different thing in the team, different profiles. It was my decision to do that," said

was untested at the other end.

The second half started much the same and once Salah had dispatched his penalty to give Liverpool the lead for the first time in the tie, the home supporters were already chanting about their trip to Wembley.

Goals for Szoboszlai and Van Dijk were just reward for a dominant performance and Liverpool have the opportunity to make it back-to-back EFL Cups when they face a confident Newcastle side at Wembley next month.

They looked lacklustre in what was a poor showing for a semi-final and questions will once again be raised about the club's management, ownership and ambition.

Protests have been directed at the club's owner Daniel Levy in recent weeks but Spurs did bring in reinforcements in the January transfer window and this performance once again brings into sharp focus Postecoglou's future at the club.

sphere, with the Toon Army urging their side on at deafening volume, Newcastle delivered the decisive blow after 52 minutes following a nightmare moment for Arsenal keeper David Raya.

Raya inexplicably tried to find Declan Rice, who was shadowed by Fabian Schar. He stole possession away from Rice, leaving Anthony Gordon with a simple finish to send Newcastle back to Wembley.

And the Geordie hordes will be hoping to make up for losing against Manchester United in the EFL Cup final two years ago, as well as claiming a first domestic honour since the 1955 FA Cup.

Newcastle went into this second leg surrounded by nerves, despite holding that healthy 2-0 advantage in front of their own fanatical fanbase.

The unease was created by two home defeats against Bournemouth and Fulham, while Arsenal looked to be hitting their stride with a 5-1 thrashing of Premier League champions Manchester City at Emirates Stadium on Sunday.

They were also without the influential Joeinton, ruled out by the knee injury he suffered in the weekend loss against Fulham. In the end, his power and threat was not missed.

Newcastle needed a fast start, ideally accompanied by a goal, to sweep away the anxiety lingering in this thunderous environment. The dream opening duly arrived.

And it was the talisman Isak who was the inspiration, running Arsenal ragged, as he did at Emirates Stadium, in those early stages, having a crisp finish disallowed for a marginal offside then being heavily involved in Murphy's opener.

The only question was whether Newcastle could keep up the breathtaking

pace and intensity, but when the tempo did die down they were able to exert a measure of control that ensured they always remained in charge of the destiny of this semi-final.

Gordon's goal was the clincher, the catalyst for a long period of celebration as Newcastle moved towards a successful finale.

Newcastle's jubilant, Wembley-bound fans waited until victory was assured before taunting Arsenal manager Mikel Arteta for comments made in the aftermath of the first leg.

Arteta complained that Arsenal had difficulties with the ball being used in the competition, although Newcastle's players did not appear to have any similar problems.

And it came back to bite him as chants of "Mikel Arteta It Must Be The Ball", as the Gunners subsided tamely to defeat.

Arsenal and Arteta can have no complaints here, as they have been comprehensively outplayed by Newcastle over the two legs.

■ CARABAO CUP: Slot's side clinch final spot in stunning style

Holdovers Liverpool booked their place in the final of the Carabao Cup against Newcastle as they thrashed Tottenham on Thursday night.

With a 1-0 deficit to overturn from the first leg of their semi-final, the Reds got the job done at a lively Anfield against a Spurs side who looked devoid of ideas.

Liverpool were on top from the start and went ahead on 34 minutes when Yves Bissouma gave the ball away in midfield and Mohamed Salah played a clever cross for Darwin Nunez, who missed his effort before Cody Gakpo drilled in.

The visitors, who had held hope of ending a 17-year trophy drought after what has been a miserable Premier League campaign, struggled to get going and barely threatened the 10-time winners of this competition.

Salah fired in from the spot just five minutes into the second half after Nunez was wiped out by

goalkeeper Antonin Kinsky.

The home supporters saw that as their cue to begin the Wembley chants as Tottenham looked sapped of energy.

Dominik Szoboszlai stamped out any chances of an already unlikely comeback when he slotted home from Conor Bradley's cross before a textbook Virgil van Dijk header from a corner ensured Liverpool will defend their crown at Wembley on Sunday, 16 March.

Liverpool are flying under head coach Arne Slot and triumph in the EFL Cup would present the Dutch manager with a first piece of silverware at Anfield - with his side also sitting six points clear at the top of the Premier League, still in the FA Cup and cruising through to the Champions League last 16.

And while this would be seen as the least important of those four trophies, it could mark the beginning of a spectacular season for
