I thought I was dying - Rushdie

Sir Salman Rushdie has told a court that he thought he was dying after being stabbed repeatedly on stage two years ago, leaving him blind in one eye.

The renowned British-Indian author gave evidence at the trial of his alleged attacker, 27-year-old Hadi Matar, who has pleaded not guilty to charges of assault and attempted murder.

Proceedings are taking place at a New York state court a few miles from where Sir Salman was attacked on 12 August 2022 as he was about to give a talk on how the US was a haven for exiled writers.

'very ferocious'

The attack occurred after Sir Salman spent years in hiding because of threats to his life after his novel *The Satanic Verses* was published in 1988.

Prosecutors, who have not specified a motive for the stabbing, called Sir Salman to the stand as the first witness on Tuesday morn-

ing, asking him to recall the moments before and after the attack.

The 77-year-old told the jury that on the day in question, he had been sitting on stage ready to address an audience at the prestigious Chau-tauqua Institution.

It was shortly after Sir Salman was introduced that he said he noticed a person rushing at him from his right-hand side.

He described the attacker as wearing dark clothes and a face mask, and said he was struck by the individual's eyes, "which were dark and seemed very ferocious".

Sir Salman said he felt the first blow to his right jaw and neck, and thought at first that he had been punched. Then he saw blood pouring on to his clothes.

"At that point he was

hitting me repeatedly, stabbing and slashing," the author said, adding that the incident unfolded in a matter of seconds.

Sir Salman told the court he was struck a total of 15 times, with wounds to his eye, cheek, neck, chest, torso and thigh.

"no vision"

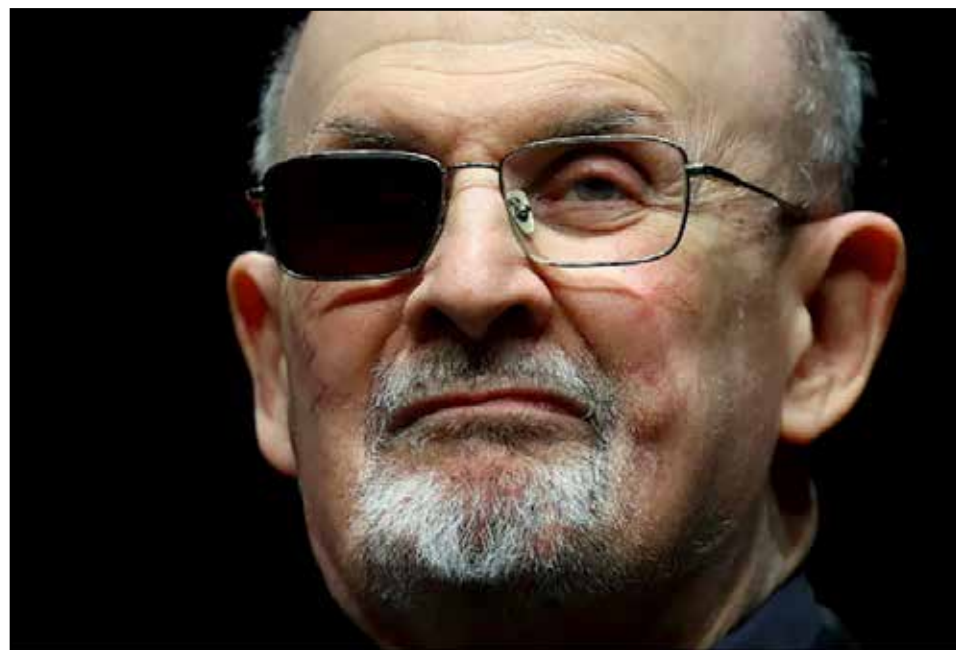
His left hand was also stabbed when he attempted to defend himself.

The knife wound to his eye was the most painful, he said.

At one point, he took off his glasses, which concealed his right eye with a dark lens, to reveal the extent of the injury.

"As you can see, that is what is left of it," he told the jury. "There's no vision in the eye at all."

As Sir Salman, who

wore a dark suit, delivered his testimony, Mr Matar often had his head down, with the two never appearing to make eye contact.

Sir Salman's wife, Lady Rushdie, cried from her seat in the second row as her husband recounted the incident.

He has been worried about his safety since the publication of *The Satanic Verses*, his sur-

realist, postmodern novel that was inspired by the life of the Muslim Prophet Muhammad.

While it met acclaim and awards in the Western world, many Muslims considered it blasphemous and some countries banned it. Iran's religious leader issued a fatwa calling for the author's death due to the book.

That fatwa - a reli-

gious decree - caused Sir Salman to face countless death threats. He was forced into hiding for nine years and only began travelling again when Iran said it would not enforce the law.

Two weeks before the attack, the author had told a German magazine that he was living a "relatively normal" life as the threats had diminished.

Mandelson lauds 'strong relationship' as he is confirmed as new British ambassador

■ Former Labour Spin Doctor has walked back strident previous anti-Trump comments

Lord Mandelson has said that his previous criticism of Donald Trump was "ill-judged and wrong" after he was officially confirmed as the new UK ambassador to the US.

The Labour political veteran was attacked in December by Trump loyalists for once describing him as a "bully" and a "danger to the world".

However, Mandelson has since back-tracked on his views. He said that although he did not believe that the UK would support Trump

on all of his policies, Britain must respect his "strong and clear mandate for change" and "understand what drives him".

Mandelson, 71, made the comments in an interview with the BBC on Monday after his diplomatic credentials were confirmed by the US state department.

He replaces Dame Karen Pierce as Britain's ambassador to the US. She built close ties with Trump during his first term and became well known in Washing-

ton for her colourful tailor-made suits.

Mandelson, who served in several Labour governments, faces an arduous task in winning over the White House.

Chris LaCivita, one of Trump's campaign aides, described Mandelson as "an absolute moron" in December.

Questions have also been raised in Washington over his close links to China. Last month, US senators were reported to have handed a dossier to the FBI that outlined details of Mandelson's

meetings from 2013 to 2019 with Chinese officials and businessmen.

Downing Street dismissed the report and has backed Mandelson to deepen Britain's ties to the White House, after speculation that his appointment as ambassador would be rejected by Trump.

Speaking on Monday, he said that there was already a "strong relationship between our government and a very warm personal relationship between [Trump] and our prime minister".



UK gives cautious response to Tump's steel tariffs

■ Trade Minister promises a "cool and clearheaded" approach

Donald Trump's decision to slap tariffs on imports of steel from the UK will not trigger a "knee-jerk" response from the Government despite warnings about the devastating impact on the industry.

Trade minister Douglas Alexander said the Government would adopt a "cool and clearheaded" approach rather than rushing into retaliatory measures.

The steel industry body said Mr Trump's

announcement had taken a "sledgehammer to free trade".

Ministers are holding talks with the industry before the commencement of the tariffs on US steel imports from March 12.

Mr Alexander told MPs: "What British industry needs and deserves is not a knee-jerk reaction, but a cool and clearheaded sense of the UK's national interest based on a full assessment of all the implica-

tions of the US actions."

He added that the UK had a "strong and balanced trade relationship" with the US.

"We stand ready to work with President Trump to find solutions that work for both the United Kingdom and the United States," he added.

Britain exported 166,433 tonnes of steel to the US in 2023, the last full year for which figures are available.

Figures from trade body UK Steel showed

that in 2024 some 162,716 tonnes were sent to the US, but that does not yet include data from December.

UK Steel warned the tariffs "would be a devastating blow to our industry".

Mr Trump said the tariffs are "the beginning of making America rich again".

Mr Trump has argued that the measures are necessary to protect the US steel industry and national security.

But UK Steel dismissed the president's claim that steel imports from Australia, the EU, Japan, and the UK rose from 18.6% in 2020 to 20.7% in 2024 because it ignored the demand-lowering impact of the Covid-19 pandemic.

Feral pigs found and culled in Cairngorms

Feral pigs spotted on the loose in the Cairngorms National Park have been captured and humanely culled, Forestry and Land Scotland (FLS) has said.

The animals were seen near Uath Lochans, an area of woodland and small lochs near Kingussie, south of Avie-

more, on Monday.

The Cairngorms National Park Authority (CNPA) said earlier this week the pigs were "relatively domesticated" and appeared to have been illegally abandoned.

The group of animals was initially spotted about five miles away

from where four lynx were dumped in the park before later being caught. FLS said eight pigs were captured.

The park authority was working with public agency FLS to catch the pigs.

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Taking a swipe at Trump, Harry criticizes 'weak moral character in the world'

PRINCE Harry has criticised the "weak moral character in the world" in what's being widely seen as a sly dig at Donald Trump.

The Duke of Sussex spoke out in a speech at the opening ceremony of the Invictus Games in Vancouver – just hours after the US President insulted his wife Meghan.

Addressing hundreds of ex-servicemen and women taking part in Canada, he said: "At this moment, when there is no shortage of crises, no absence of uncertainty, no lack of weak moral character in the world, the values you embody, the way you carry yourselves – not only at the Invictus Games, but each and every day – your courage, your resilience, your humanity, illuminate a path forward for us all."

Saturday's ceremony also featured a perfor-

mance by pop star Katy Perry.

It came on the day Mr Trump said he wouldn't be deporting Harry despite the fact he admitted in his memoir to previously using drugs.

He added that Harry had "enough problems" with his wife, who he described as "terrible".

Megan, 43, showed her support for her husband with an enthusiastic kiss.

The Invictus Games is a nine-day sporting event created by Harry in 2014 for wounded, injured and sick servicemen and women.

'historic'

It will host more than 500 competitors this year and include winter sports for the first time.

The Duchess of Sussex toasted freezing athletes with an ice-cold beer before speaking to wounded, injured and

sick military veterans in the Games' first winter sports event/

Wrapped up in a £1,250 Calina maxi jacket, black beanie and boots, Meghan, 43, remarked on the bracing Arctic weather as she sipped her beer.

In a black Invictus Games logo jacket, beaming Harry, 40, also enjoyed a beer and told competitors to enjoy the experience while taking part in "measured risk".

He added: "We just want you to have the best time. Everybody needs to look after themselves, please.

"This is our first Winter Games. It's historic!"

The Invictus Games was launched by Harry in 2014.

'ginger friend'

Harry, who was welcomed to the stage by Canadian crooner Michael Buble, joked with

the crowd and thanked his "ginger friend", the Whistler resort's mayor Jack Crompton.

He asked: "Are there any other gingers in the house?". As cheers rose up, he replied: "Wonderful!"

After a fly-past by two Royal Canadian Air Force CF-18 fighter jets, the Prince called on

Meghan to take his hand as they waved and left the stage in Whistler Village.

And in a reference to Michael as he watched Meghan's surprise laugh, Harry joked: "Now she's going to sing."

Meanwhile, the Sussexes are said to be on a quest to become "huge stars in Africa" – with an

invitation to visit Ghana later this year.

That's despite the fact that a working member of the Royal Family is reportedly already heading to the West African state in 2025.

Speaking at the welcoming event, Michael, 49, called the Invictus competitors "real superheroes".

non-native species and illegally released.

United legends gather to remember Denis Law

■ Sir Rod Stewart's floral tribute note summed up the grief of generations of football fans

SIR Rod Stewart's floral tribute note summed up the grief of generations of football fans as they said goodbye to Denis Law: "You are, and always will be, my footballing hero."

Dubbed "The King" at Old Trafford, Law was one of the greatest stars in Manchester United's history and the club's third all-time top scorer with 237 goals in 404 appearances from 1962 to 1973.

The Scottish striker died last month aged 84, the last of the iconic United Trinity: Sir Bobby Charlton died aged 86 in 2023 and George Best passed away in 2005 at 59.

As stars of the game entered Manchester Cathedral among 750 guests for Law's funeral on Tuesday, his hearse slowly passed the Theatre of Dreams and its statue of Law with arm aloft between his pals Best and Charlton.

Of hundreds of floral tributes taken to the cathedral and laid outside Old Trafford, one that struck a chord with Scotland fans was sent by Celtic supporter Sir Rod, 80 – its Saltire design a tribute to Law's joint-record 30 goals in 55 Scottish internationals by the only Scot to win the Ballon d'Or.

Aberdeen-born Law began his career with

Huddersfield Town and also had two periods with United's rivals Manchester City, again in a 10 shirt, plus a spell in Italy with Torino.

He was sold for a British record fee three times during his career. His family revealed the father of five had died after a "tough battle" with Alzheimer's and vascular dementia, saying he was "finally now at peace".

Paying tribute at the funeral, ex-United boss Sir Alex Ferguson declared: "He would fight his granny for a goal. He had so much courage. A skinny guy standing by all those big defenders.

"Trying to place Denis in the pantheon of all-time greats is a challenge. But it is made easier by Pele.

"He was asked if there was a British player who could get in the [great] Brazil team. He said Denis Law – which is a fantastic tribute."

Sir Alex said Law "loved Scotland and he loved beating England".

He added: "He once lined up before a game against England. He loved Nobby Stiles and Nobby worshipped him.

"Nobby came bounding down the tunnel and wished Denis all the best. Denis gave him a withering look and let off a volley of abuse Nobby never forgot."

Law's daughter Diana Buckley said her "inspirational" father had had the personal strength to achieve greatness despite being born with sight problems: "Despite all life threw at this skinny, squinty-eyed boy, he looked adversity in the eye but didn't blink."

Referring to Charlton and Best, she said: "There's an Englishman, Irishman and a Scotsman in heaven smiling down. I'd like to think they've started a team with all the others and Mum on the sidelines making them a cup of tea."

Ms Buckley told how when Law was growing up, his father worked

five days a week and there was little material wealth but his upbringing was "emotionally rich" and football became his passion. He would join friends in the street "even when there wasn't an actual ball", learning to play "with one eye closed" due to his squint.

United's coach Ruben Amorim joined fans and famous faces from football for the service, including current players such as Bruno Fernandes and Harry Maguire.

Old Trafford heroes Brian Kidd, Alex Stepney, Sammy McLroy and Willie Morgan were at Law's funeral, as was his former City colleague Mike Summerbee.

Other greats of the game present included Bryan Robson, Wayne Rooney, Gary Nev-

ille, Paul Scholes, Peter Schmeichel, Ruud van Nistelrooy and Law's fellow Scottish legend Sir Kenny Dalglish.

Former goalkeeper Stepney, 82, quipped that Law, Charlton and Best would now be "picking the team!" in heaven.

While ex-United forward Brian McClair, 61, said Law gave him some tongue-in-cheek advice when he arrived at Old Trafford in 1987. McClair, who had previously played for Motherwell and Celtic, said: "Denis said to me, 'Don't score hat-tricks because they'll expect that every game. Just score two'."

Sir Alex called Law "the best Scottish player of all time".

The United hero added: "He summarised a Scotsman, the fighting ele-

ment, he could fight in an empty house! An incredible human being."

Kidd, who won the European Cup with United in 1968 and played alongside Law, said: "When Denis won the Ballon d'Or in 1964, I signed as an apprentice for United.

"His humility was superb. You wouldn't believe he was a superstar. Down to earth, such a lovely person. The Trinity epitomise what Manchester United is all about. Great people have been the backbone of the club."

Outside the cathedral fans lined up to see the coffin which arrived in a hearse with the floral message "Law 10" to the sound of bagpipes playing Flower of Scotland.

Sir Rod's rendition of Angel was played at the end.

Long jail term for man who claimed he was 'play-fighting' after fatally stabbing daughter

A FATHER who had claimed he was just "play-fighting" when he fatally stabbed his daughter in the heart has been jailed for at least 15 years.

Scarlett Vickers, 14, collapsed and died when the knife was stuck four inches into her chest by dad Simon as her mother cooked spaghetti nearby.

Vickers, 50, had denied murder and manslaughter, insisting the family had been "muck-

ing around" last June.

He told the Teesside Crown Court jury: "We were horse-playing. I must be the unluckiest man in the world."

But he did not mention his violent past, including a conviction for wounding with intent and being sentenced to two years' detention in 1993. Jurors found him guilty of murder by a majority verdict.

Scarlett's mother Sarah Hall, 44, insists she is standing by her part-

ner of 27 years, saying he loved their only child and would never deliberately harm her.

'mucking about'

Her mum Elaine said: "They doted on her. If Sarah thought he had done anything to her, she'd have been out. It's definitely just been an accident because there's no way he would have harmed her. She's lost her daughter and now she hasn't got Simon."

Jurors heard Vickers

had drunk four glasses of wine and smoked half a cannabis joint that evening at home in Darlington, Co Durham. He accepted causing Scarlett's wound but claimed to have had no knowledge of touching the 12in green-handled knife.

The court saw footage of Vickers being booked into custody after being arrested for attempted murder – he was later re-arrested for murder after Scarlett was pronounced dead at hospi-

tal. He was heard saying: "I just want to know how my daughter's doing. We were mucking about, playing in the kitchen, and for some reason this has gone really weird."

'wholly inconsistent'

Vickers told the jury she may have accidentally come on to the knife. But forensic evidence proved the wound was "too deep" to have been caused accidentally. Home Office pathologist

Dr Jennifer Bolton said it would be "practically impossible" for a thrown knife to have done that and it must have been "held tightly" so that it went into Scarlett.

Following the guilty verdict, senior crown prosecutor Anna Barker said that Vickers's claim was "wholly inconsistent" with the forensic evidence: "The wound sustained by Scarlett could only have been caused if the knife used had been firmly gripped."

Honored at last, tragic George, whose death brought an end to child chimney sweeps

■ George Brewster's death in 1875 heralded sweeping changes to child labour in multiple industries

A blue plaque to commemorate a Victorian child chimney sweep has been unveiled at the place of his death.

George Brewster, 11, became trapped in the chimney of a former pauper asylum at Victoria Park in Fulbourn, Cambridgeshire, in 1875, and could not be saved.

He is thought to be the last of what were known as "climbing boys" to have died in England - and the youngest recipient of a blue plaque.

His story was brought to light by amateur historian Joanna Hudson, who said seeing the plaque unveiled was "an amaz-

ing feeling, it's been such a long time in the planning".

She added: "Today is the 150th anniversary of his death and it was so important that we hit that anniversary, so I am so pleased."

George's death that year prompted a new law stopping children from being used as chimney sweeps.

George was apparently "forced by his master" to climb and clean the narrow chimney of the building, according to Ms Hudson, who has campaigned for years for recognition of his legacy.

He was unable to get out and 15 minutes later a wall was pulled down to get to him but he died shortly after.

The 7th Earl of Shaftesbury read about his death and pushed a bill through Parliament putting an end to children being used as chimney sweeps.

Ms Hudson, from Pampisford, Cambridgeshire, said George's death was also part of a much greater transformation

of British industrial society, that heralded the end of all child labour practices in other industries such as farming, mining and in factories.

Just a year later, in 1876, it was recommended that education be made compulsory in the UK for all children, before being fully enforced in 1880.

After the plaque was unveiled in Victoria Park where George died, Ms Hudson said: "He was the catalyst for the change in the child labour law.

"It was his legacy that he got this blue plaque and we really want to use this to get his name out there so that all children today know about George Brewster."

Lawson Wright, chair of the Guild of Master Chimney Sweeps, who was also present at the unveiling, said: "Nowadays sweeps have all the access to protective equipment we could need and if they have to work inside a chim-

ney they are properly set up with breathing equipment - so we're all very well protected."

Ms Hudson said she had checked with both English Heritage and Historic England and neither were aware

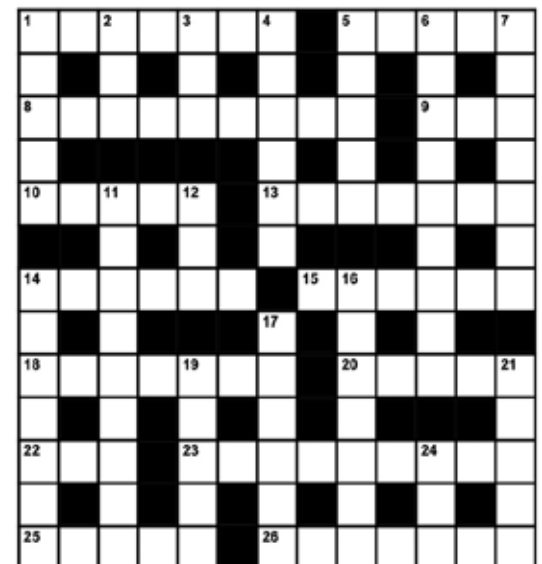
of a child as young as George being honoured with a blue plaque.

She said she would like to move forward with the idea of a permanent memorial to George in Cambridge, where he lived.

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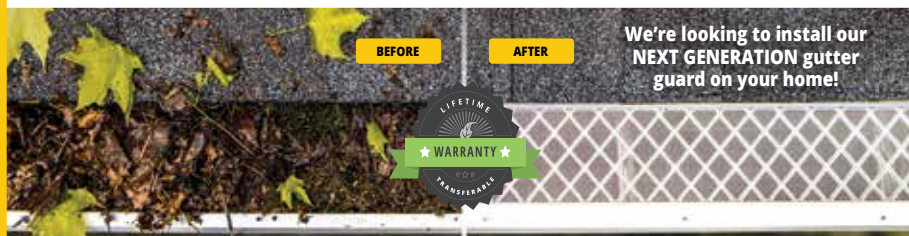

Maeda keeps Celtic hopes alive

Daizen Maeda's deft header kept Celtic's hopes of reaching the Champions League last 16 alive, despite the Scottish Premiership side falling to defeat against Bayern Munich in Glasgow on Wednesday.

Japan international Maeda, whose suspension for the first leg was only overturned on Monday, hauled Bren-

dan Rodgers' side back into a tie which appeared beyond them after goals either side of the break for Bayern.

Michael Olise's outrageous strike on the stroke of half-time set Vincent Kompany's side on their way to a much-deserved win after a dominant performance.

The Hammer-smith-born France international hammered a

ferocious shot high past Kasper Schmeichel after cutting in from the right and leaving Greg Taylor for dust.

It was the sickest of sucker-punches for Celtic, but it lifted Bayern, who roared out of the traps in the second half.

England captain Harry Kane was left, inexplicably, unmarked at the back post to volley in his 29th goal in 29 games

this season and seventh in this competition.

Kane supplied warning shots in the first half, smashing into the side netting and forcing Schmeichel into a superb save - though he was ruled offside - but Celtic didn't take heed.

The Bundesliga leaders did of their earlier warning, though. They had been stunned inside 30 seconds when former Bayern youngster Nicolas Kuhn shifted inside and swept past Manuel Neuer from 25 yards.

However, an offside flag halted the cacophonous celebrations inside Celtic Park after the offside Adam Idah was deemed to have obstructed Neuer's view.

It proved a precursor to a frustrating evening for Celtic but one from which they emerge with their hopes of reaching the last 16 still, just, alive ahead of Tuesday's second leg.

Celtic's first defeat in the competition this season was a drubbing in Dortmund. A match where they fell behind to a German giant and folded.

But as this campaign

has continued, they've grown in quality and character. The latter of those was especially on show here.

Once again they came under intense pressure from feted European side, but this time they didn't buckle.

Maeda flashed a ball across the face after darting in front of Neuer, while Reo Hatate also had a sight of goal, as Rodgers' side attempted to yank themselves back into the tie.

For a few moments, Arne Engels even thought he might have an opportunity from the

spot when he was caught by Dayot Upamecano but, after a lengthy VAR wait, that possibility disappeared.

It could have been so very different had Idah shimmied out of the path of Kuhn's strike inside the first minute, but even the start in itself was a sign of progress.

Celtic didn't start scared or respectful - they kicked off with intent.

It's still a mountain to climb in Munich next week, but they head out with a hint of hope instead of fearing another hiding in Germany.

Havertz out for rest of season

■ Striker suffers injury in training

Arsenal say forward Kai Havertz will miss the rest of the season after sustaining a hamstring injury during the team's Dubai training camp.

The Premier League club say the 25-year-old will require surgery and is expected to continue his rehabilitation into pre-season for the 2025-26 campaign.

Havertz's absence will leave the north Londoners without a recognised striker for the remainder of this season.

The club issued the following statement: "We can confirm that Kai Havertz has sustained a hamstring injury during a training session in Dubai last week.

"Subsequent assessments and specialist reviews have confirmed that the injury will require surgery, which will take place in the coming days.

"Soon after surgery, Kai will begin his recovery and rehabilitation programme, which is expected to extend into pre-season preparations for next season.

"Everyone at the club is fully focused on supporting Kai to ensure he is back to full fitness as soon as possible."

Manager Mikel Arteta is likely to be asked about Havertz's injury lay-off at Friday's news conference before his side take on Leicester City on Saturday.

Striker Gabriel Jesus has also had surgery on an anterior cruciate ligament (ACL) injury, while star forward Bukayo Saka has had surgery on a hamstring injury sustained in December.

Gabriel Martinelli injured his hamstring last week in the Carabao Cup defeat at Newcastle

and is reportedly out for "more than one month".

Havertz has made 34 appearances this season and is the club's top scorer with 15 goals and five assists.

The addition of Havertz to that injury list will leave Arteta seriously short of goal scorers after the club were unable to sign attacking reinforcements in the January transfer window. The Spanish boss said he was "disappointed" with the lack of activity with an offer for Aston Villa's Ollie Watkins rejected.

Rumours linking

them to Newcastle's Alexander Isak, Wolves' Matheus Cunha, Leipzig's Benjamin Sesko and Brighton's Evan Ferguson went nowhere.

Criticism had already been levelled at Arse-

nal even before these injury problems with many pundits and fans suggesting they needed a striker to maintain hopes of competing for a trophy.

Arteta said last week

that Havertz might have to start every game for the rest of the season, adding that his other options would be wingers Leandro Trossard, Raheem Sterling and Ethan Nwaneri.

Arsenal flew out for warm-weather training last Thursday after being knocked out of the EFL Cup by Newcastle in the semi-final. They were not involved in this weekend's FA Cup fixtures following their third-round defeat by Manchester United.

Last season, after a similar break, Arsenal went on to win 16 of their next 18 games.

They are second in the Premier League, seven points adrift of leaders Liverpool.

As tempers flared, Abdoulaye Doucoure taunted the Liverpool fans and was confronted by Liverpool substitute Curtis Jones, with players from both sides squaring up before the pair were sent off.

It all meant Goodison Park went out with a bang, with both Everton and Liverpool ending

on 41 wins apiece in derbies played in this atmospheric old arena.

Everton took the lead after 11 minutes in an emotionally-charged atmosphere when Jarrad Branthwaite's free-kick caught Liverpool cold and Beto slid a composed finish past Allison.

Liverpool's response was instant as Alexis Mac Allister equalised with a glancing header from Mohamed Salah's cross within five minutes.

In a Goodison cauldron, with temperatures rising by the second, Salah pounced on Branthwaite's clearance to score with 17 minutes left as Everton cursed their fortunes after Doucoure had missed a glorious headed chance.

Then Goodison Park got one final moment of derby drama that will live long in the memory as Tarkowski lashed home in front of the Gwladys Street end.

Liverpool remain seven points clear at the top of the Premier League - but it was Everton who

were more satisfied with the result.

From a final Goodison Park derby that looked like ending in disappointing defeat, Everton showed the revived spirit and character brought by the return of David Moyes as manager to provide a climax

of genuine sporting theatre.

Moyes has rejuvenated Everton - Beto in particular, with the striker showing a composure rarely seen previously - and they even overcame the first-half loss of key man Iliman Ndiaye to injury.

Yet another Real comeback leaves sad City at the brink

Manchester City are fighting for Champions League survival and a place in the last 16 after Jude Bellingham's injury-time winner settled a tense play-off first leg in Real Madrid's favour Tuesday night.

Pep Guardiola's side rediscovered more of their true form early on at Etihad Stadium as Jack Grealish and Josko Gvardiol combined to set up Erling Haaland for a confident finish after 19 minutes.

Grealish, who had made a fine start, then went off injured and after Haaland hit the bar shortly after the break, Real took control.

Real let City off the hook by failing to take their chances until Kylian Mbappe scrambled home a close-range finish

on the hour.

They continued to squander opportunities, including two for Bellingham, and were punished when Haaland put City back in front from the spot after 80 minutes following Dani Ceballos' foul on Phil Foden.

Real, however, hit back with four minutes left, former City man Brahim Diaz equalising - before Bellingham finally hit the target, sliding in from close range to leave the holders as firm favourites to reach the knockout stage in next week's second leg at The Bernabeu.

Manchester City's big Champions League night started with flashes of the old form re-emerging, only to end in bitter disappointment as the failings that have

characterised their disappointing season surfaced once more.

With Grealish probing and Haaland providing the cutting edge, City made the perfect start. It was a bitter blow when the former went off injured after half an hour.

Real had already started to pose a threat through the pace of Mbappe and the trickery of Rodrygo and Vinicius Junior, but the pivotal moment for City came when Haaland's deflected shot bounced back off the bar. A two-goal lead might have made a significant difference.

And in that agonising conclusion, City went from thinking they might take a lead to The Bernabeu, to settling for a draw, then suffering the pain of defeat.
